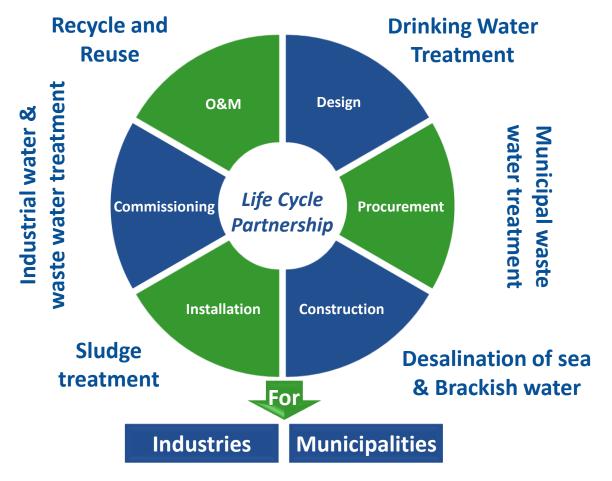

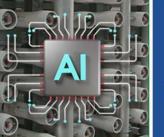

Management Commentary – Profit & Loss Statement



- New projects in Chennai and Bangladesh commencing, drives the revenue generation along with speedy execution in SIBUR, Senegal and other projects
- EBITDA margins showed continued improvement driven by execution efficiencies, mix of EP projects in line with strategy, continuous control and Value Engineering
- Net interest cost continue to remain under control with effective utilization of bank lines; Group continues to remain Net Cash for fourth consecutive year
- Consistently Growing Profitably Profit Growing faster than Revenue

Management Outlook:

- Strong Revenue Growth driven by India & MEA over the next 3-5 Years with a CAGR of 15 − 20 %
- ♦ EBITDA Margins to sustain in the 13% 15% range
- Mix of >50% International Projects, 30% Industrial Customers and 1/3 of EPC being EP Projects

- Group generated positive Operational Cash Flow of Rs. 1,335 Mn, Positive Free Cash Flow of Rs. 1,683 Mn and concluded the year on Net Cash Position of Rs. 2,356 Mn
- Group continues its strategic approach to remain "Asset Light"; Successfully inducted majority Equity Partner in 2 out of 3 HAM SPVs
- Non Current Receivable reduced YoY on account of collection of Project Retention; Current Receivables higher due to new & large International / MDB Funded Projects with significant Revenues in Q4, expected to reduce progressively through H1 and normalize by year end FY25
- Trade Payable reduction driven by deployment of necessary resources to expedite and meet the project timelines

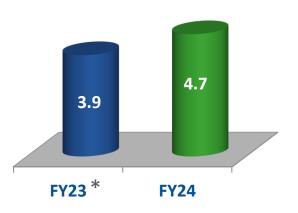
Revenue Breakup – FY 24



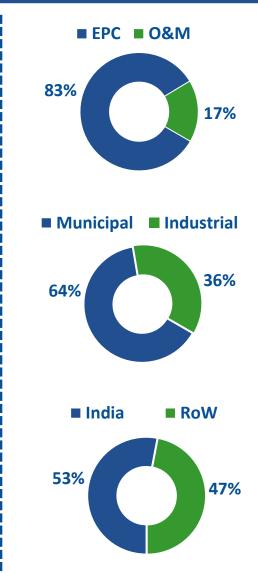

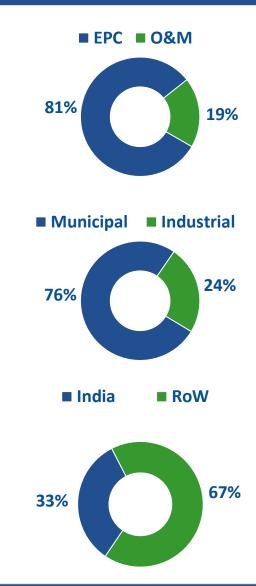
