mandatory for utilities and com-panies setting up towers to "en-sure fencing and deploy security guards while also installing a lock system to ensure that mautho-rised persons do not dimb up the towers" and also need to put up boards on the towers stating that "prohibitory orders are in place against unauthorised persons in-tendiment on the towers." The ending to climb the towers." Th notification states that those violating the orders will be punished under Section 223 (disobeying orders in place) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.


