Houthi missiles hit Greek ship Washington: Houthi rebels attacked a Greek carrier ship in the Red Sea, the US military said on Tuesday. The Houthi militants launched five missiles, with the Greek-owned MV Laax reporting it had been struck by three of the missiles, the US Central Command (CENTCOM) said on social media platform X.The ship was able to continue its voyage with no injuries reported. CENTCOM forces destroyed five uncrewed aerial systems launched from a Houthi-controlled area of Yemen, it added. The Islamist militia has vowed to attack ships in the Red Sea linked to Israel, in an effort to force an end to the Israeli attacks in the Gaza Strip.

The US does not believe Israel has launched a fullscale invasion of Rafah in southern Gaza, White House spokesman John Kirby has said. He spoke hours after Israeli forces reached the centre of the city and reportedly seized a strategically important hill overlooking the nearby border with Egypt.

US President Joe Biden said this month he would limit weapons supplies to Israel if it entered the "population centres" of Rafah, where hundreds of thousands of civilians are still believed to be sheltering.

Questioned about an Israeli strike and a resulting fire that killed at least 45 Palestinians – many of them women, children, or elderly at a camp for displaced people on Sunday, Kirby described images from the aftermath of the strike as "heartbreaking" and "horrific".

Israel has maintained that the strike targeted and killed two senior Hamas officials. and that it believes the fire



could have been caused by an explosion at a Hamas weapons store nearby.

Asked whether the strike had violated the limits previously set by President Joe Biden, Kirby said he had "no policy changes to speak to". 'We don't support, we won't support a major ground operation in Rafah," he said.

"The President said that, should that occur, then it might make him have to make different decisions in terms of support. We haven't seen that happen at this point. We have not seen them smash into Rafah," he added. A day after Washington

said the assault did not amount to a major ground incursion of the southern Gazan city, a report from

Cairo said that Israeli tanks conducted a second day of probing attacks across Rafah on Wednesday.

Israeli tanks advanced to the heart of Rafah for the first time on Tuesday after a night of heavy bombardment. Unlike tactics used in Israel's ground offensive in the rest of the enclave, Rafah residents said Israeli tanks mounted raids into Tel Al-Sultan in western Rafah and Yibna and near Shaboura before retreating to positions near the border with Egypt.

Hamas and the Islamic Jihad said they confronted the invading forces with antitank rockets and mortar bombs, and blew up previously planted explosives.

South Africans vote to decide ANC fate

South Africans began voting on Wednesday in the most competitive election since the end of apartheid, with opinion polls suggesting the African National Congress (ANC) will lose its parliamentary majority after 30 years in government.

Voters are electing nine provincial legislatures and a new national parliament, which will then choose the country's next president for the next five years. The election commission will announce the final results on Sunday.

The ANC, led by 66-yearold South African President Cyril Ramaphosa, will have to seek one or more coalition partners to rule the country if it gets less than 50 per cent of the national vote. The ANC has won six consecutive national elections since

This would then mark the first time the ANC will be ruling in a coalition alliance government since it was catapulted into power at the end of apartheid, 30 years ago with Nelson



Mandela at its helm.

The country's largest opposition party is the centre-right Democratic Alliance (DA) led by John Steenhusien that was formed by merging the Democratic party and the New National party.

Other opposition parties include the far-left Economic Freedom Fighters (EFF), led by former ANC vouth leader Julius Malema, and a new party, uMkhonto we Sizwe (MK), backed by former president Jacob Zuma A total of 70 parties and candidates are vving for 400 seats in the National Assembly by voting under a proportion-

NATO members in Europe are playing with fire by proposing to let Ukraine use Western weapons to strike deep inside Russia, Russian President Vladimir Putin has warned the West.

The warning comes as some NATO members recently pledged military aid to Ukraine.

More than two years into the deadliest land war in Europe since World War Two, Putin has increasingly spoken of the risk of a much broader global conflict as the West grapples with what to do about the advance of Russian troops in Ukraine.

NATO Secretary General Jens Stoltenberg told The Economist that alliance members should let Ukraine strike deep into Russia with Western weapons, a view supported by some NATO members but not by the United States. "Constant escalation can

lead to serious consequences." Putin told reporters in Tashkent. "If these serious conse-

quences occur in Europe, how

Drone debris fell on energy infrastructure in Ukraine's northwestern region of Rivne, governor Oleksandr Koval said on Telegram.

The attack triggered a defence mechanism that cut power to some localities, although it has since been restored.

Drone debris also damaged power lines in the central Kirovohrad region with repair work ongoing, its governor said. The air force shot down 11 drones over the Mykolaiv region, with no details on damage reported by the local governor.

Meanwhile, Sweden has announced \$1.3 billion military support for Ukraine.

A report from Copenhagen said Sweden would send military aid worth as much as 13.3 billion Swedish crowns (\$1.3 billion) to Ukraine, its biggest package so far, to aid the war against Russia, the Nordic country's government said on Wednesday.

The package would help strengthen the Ukrainian air defence and included Saab's Airborne Surveillance and Control (ASC) 890 aircraft.

JBIMS to accept CAT scores for MHRD programme

The Jamnalal Bajaj Institute Management Studies (JBIMS) will accept the Common Admission Test (CAT) scores for Master of Human Development Resource (MHRD), starting this academic year. The institute, which earlier took admission based on the Maharashtra Common Entrance Test (MAH-MBA CET), has decided to consider the CAT score along with it from this year onwards.

Srinivasan R Iyengar, the director of JBIMS said, "We have decided to accept CAT

scores for the MHRD programme to improve the quality of students. There's a belief that CAT brings with itself a good legacy of students." He further added that CAT also means more pan-India students will apply for the programme.

The admission process for the course will begin after the admission to the institute's flagship programme Master in Management Studies (MMS) is over. "There is a mechanism in

place to select candidates from both CAT and MAH CET exams," Iyengar added.

The institute also accepts

CAT scores for the MSc Finance programme. However, it only considers the MAH-MBA CET exam for admission into the MMS programme.

The MAH CET results were declared on May 16. The college has begun the admission process for the MMS programme after which it will start the admission process for MHRD as well as MSc Finance. The selected candidates will then have to appear for the group discussion and personal interview round, based on which a candidate will be selected for the

SIA flight dropped 178ft in 4.6 seconds

Preliminary findings released on Wednesday of an investigation into a Singapore Airlines (SIAL.SI) flight hit by severe turbulence last week showed a rapid change in gravitational force and a 54-metre altitude drop that caused injuries among passengers.

A 73-year-old passenger died of a suspected heart attack and dozens were injured after flight SQ321, flying from London to Singapore, encountered what the airline described as sudden, extreme turbulence while flying over Mvanmar.

The 777-300ER plane carrying 211 passengers and 18 crew diverted to Bangkok for emergency landing after the plane was buffeted by turbulence that flung passengers and crew around the cabin, slamming some into the ceiling.

"The aircraft experienced a rapid change in G (gravitational force) ... This likely resulted in the occupants who were not belted up to become airborne," the Transport Ministry said in a statement on the report by the Transport Safety Investigation Bureau.

"The vertical acceleration changed from negative 1.5G to positive 1.5G within 4 seconds. This likely resulted in the occupants who were airborne to fall back down," it said, citing information extracted from the flight data and cockpit voice recorders.

"The rapid changes in G over the 4.6 seconds duration resulted in an altitude drop of 178 ft (54 m), from 37,362 ft to 37,184 ft. This likely caused the injuries to the crew and passengers," it added.

Kota police rope in Meta to prevent suicide among coaching students on Apr 30. In 2023, 26 cases

The Kota police have tied up with Meta to identify students exhibiting suicidal tendencies company's social media platforms, Facebook and Instagram, allowing for their timely intervention.

Since the collaboration a week back, the police claim they have already prevented a student from Jhunjhunu from committing suicide in this coaching hub, where young people from across the country come to prepare for competitive exams.

Nine students have taken their lives this year, with the most recent case reported of suicide among coaching students were registered in the city, marking the highest number recorded so
