Chennai, Sep 3: There is no doubt that Vijay's upcoming film, GOAT (The Greatest of All Time), is undoubtedly the biggest theatrical release of 2024 for Tamil cinema. The film, which is the penultimate film of Vijay before he takes the political plunge, is expected to shatter all previous box-office records, most of which were created by the star's previous films. Sathyaraj reunites with Rajinikanth for 'Coolie'

Chennai, Sep 3: Actor Sathyaraj was a mainstay as one of the antagonists in many films starring the likes of Rajinikanth and Kamal Haasan. In fact, Sathyaraj and Rajinikanth have acted together in six films, the last of which was Mr Bharath in 1986. After 38 years, these two superstars will be sharing screen space in Lokesh Kanagaraj's upcoming big-budget actioner, Coolie.

The makers revealed this casting update in their ongoing series of character announcements on social media. Sathyaraj is set to play

the role of Rajasekhar, and it is speculated that he would be playing the friend of Rajinikanth in the film, which is a marked change from the usual villain roles he has played in the 'Superstar' films of the 80s.

Apart from Sathyaraj, the movie also stars Nagarjuna, Shruti Haasan, and Soubin Shahir.

Coolie, which marks the maiden collaboration between Lokesh and Rajinikanth, is also said to star Kannada superstar Upen, and it is this announcement that is expected later today.



The collaboration between Rajinikanth and Sathyaraj takes even more prominence considering many of the 'almost' moments this happened, including Shankar's Sivaji. Also, Sathyaraj has many a time openly criticised Rajinikanth for few of the latter's political opinions. However, it seems that the duo have left bygones be bygones, and are working in what is turning out to be one of the most-anticipated films of Indian cinema.



Madhya Pradesh to develop 50 offbeat destinations

MP, Sept 3: As many as 50 new offbeat tourist destinations will be developed in Madhya Pradesh, state Tourism and Culture principal secretary Sheo Shekhar Shukla told PTI on August 31. He was speaking at a business session on the day two of the 39th annual convention of Indian Association of Tour Operators.

"Fifty new offbeat destinations are being developed in the state to cater to tourists who want to stay away from crowded places and seek peace," Shukla said. Earlier, Union Minister for Culture and Tourism Gajendra Singh Shekhawat had said during the IATO inaugural function on Friday that the growth rate of the tourism

industry in India was expected to touch 20%, hence more destinations were needed. Shukla, meanwhile, said that over 40,000 women were being trained in the tourism sector in the state. Madhya Pradesh has been taking strides in attracting tourists to more destinations apart from popular hotspots like Khajuraho, Jabalpur and Pachmadi.

It's ambitious Cheetah project at the Kuno National Park is proof of the state's efforts to boost tourism. However, in a setback, one of the Namibian cheetahs named Pawan died in the wild recently. The latest cheetah fatality at KNP was reported weeks after a five-month-old cub of African cheetah, Gamini, died on August 5.

Sporting activities to resume in Darjeeling

Darjeeling, Sept 3: The tourism department of the Gorkhaland Territorial Administration (GTA) is set to resume adventure tourism and sporting activities in Darjeeling and Kalimpong hills from the middle of next month.

River rafting in the Teesta, daylong mountain hikes on old hilly routes and jumping from the slopes of the mountains for a short aerial stroll through paragliding are some of the activities that have been planned.

"After the monsoon break, all adventure tourism and related activities in the hills of Darjeeling and Kalimpong will begin from September 15. This time, we will introduce some new attractions for adventure enthusiasts in the hills," said Dawa Gyalpo Sherpa, the chief coordinator of adventure tourism in the GTA.

The new attractions include paragliding from Rohini (near Lepchagaon) to Giddey Pahar of Kurseong and a 10km "White Orchid Trail" through the Old Military Road in Kurseong.

As of now, tourists can take a paragliding trip from St. Paul's to Lebong in Darjeeling. Members of the Teesta Rangeet River Rafters' Welfare Association, which functions under the GTA's tourism department, are gearing up to resume river rafting in the Teesta.

October last year, rafting It resumed in April but a few days because of had stopped in the river. was discontinued after inclement weather.

High-octane thriller Dhruva's 'Martin' to release on Oct 11

Dhruva Sarja's high-budget Kannada action thriller Martin is set to release on October 11.

Arjun has penned the story of Martin, while it's helmed by A. P. Arjun. The film features Sarja in a powerful role against the Pakistan Army and promises intense action scenes.

Martin is a big step up for Dhruva Sarja as he aims to ride the new "pan-India" wave. Arjun, Dhruva Sarja, Uday K Mehta

The movie revolves around an Indian prisoner locked up in a Pakistani jail, promising high-octane action sequences and a generous dose of chest-thumping patriotism.

Martin is produced by Uday K Mehta and Suraj Uday Mehta. The film, which will be released in multiple languages, is set to hit the screens worldwide on October 11. Mani Sharma has



composed the music for the movie while Ravi Basrur of KGF fame has done the background score. Talking about the release date of the film, Arjun said, "It's a big

release (Vettaiyan), but we planned this (Martin) long before that. We could have considered changing the release date if this film was just coming out in a single language. It's multilingual, and the

producers have planned its release across the country. Also, it involves a lot of business considerations. It's a huge process. I believe after watching Rajini sir's movie, people will also enjoy this film."

Suriya opens up on Kanguva release plans

Coimbatore, Sep 3: On August 31st, the grand audio launch of Karthi's new film, 'Meiyazhagan,' took place in Coimbatore. The event was marked by the presence of Karthi's brother, Suriya, who used the occasion to discuss the release plans for his highly anticipated magnum opus, 'Kanguva'. Originally slated for an October 10th release, the film was set to go head-to-head with Superstar Rajinikanth's 'Vettaiyan'. During his speech

at the event, Suriya expressed his admiration for Rajinikanth, stating, "Superstar Rajinikanth is the identity of Tamil cinema. He began his acting career around the time I was born and has been the face of Tamil cinema for over 50 years. I think it's best if Superstar's film comes out first." Following his remarks, reports suggest that the release of 'Kanguva' may now be pushed to mid-November. Reflecting on the effort behind 'Kanguva,' Suriya



added, "Kanguva is like a child. Please pray for the movie. A lot of effort went into the movie over the past two and a half years, with over 1,000 people

working tirelessly under challenging conditions." 'Kanguva' is a fantasy action film directed by Siruthai Siva, featuring music by Devi Sri Prasad.
