MUMBAI Sharveya marches into semi-finals



Sharveya Samant lost the first game but fought back to win the next three to overcome Yash Dalvi 3-1 (6-11, 12-10, 11-7, and 11-4) in a men's quarter-final match of the Khar Gymkhana-TSTA third Ranking Table Tennis Tournament 2024 and played at the Khar Gymkhana. In other men's matches, Sagar Kasture defeated Ayush Sonawane 3-1 (11-13, 11-5, 12-10, and 11-9), and Shivam Shrivastava beat Dhruv Shah 3-0 (13-10, 11-7, and 11-8).

KOLKATA NEUFC beat Bagan to win Durand Cup

Goalkeeper Gurmeet Singh pulled off a couple of exceptional saves in the penalty shootout as NorthEast United FC overcame a two-goal deficit to stun Mohun Bagan 4-3 to win their maiden Durand Cup title after the regulation time ended with the score locked at 2-2, here on Saturday. Rubina Francis shot down India's fourth medal from the shooting range, showing tremendous calm and composure in a high-class field to clinch a bronze in the women's 10m air pistol SH1 event in the Paris Paralympics on Saturday.

Competing in a top-class field consisting of the defending champion and world record holder among others, the 25-year-old Rubina held her own to score a total of 211.1 for a third-place finish in the eight-woman final.

She had qualified for the final at seventh spot in the qualification round earlier in the day. Iran's Javanmardi Sareh won her third successive Paralympics gold with a total score of 236.8 while world record holder Ozgan Aysel of Turkey took the silver with 231.1 in a fierce competition between the two favourites.

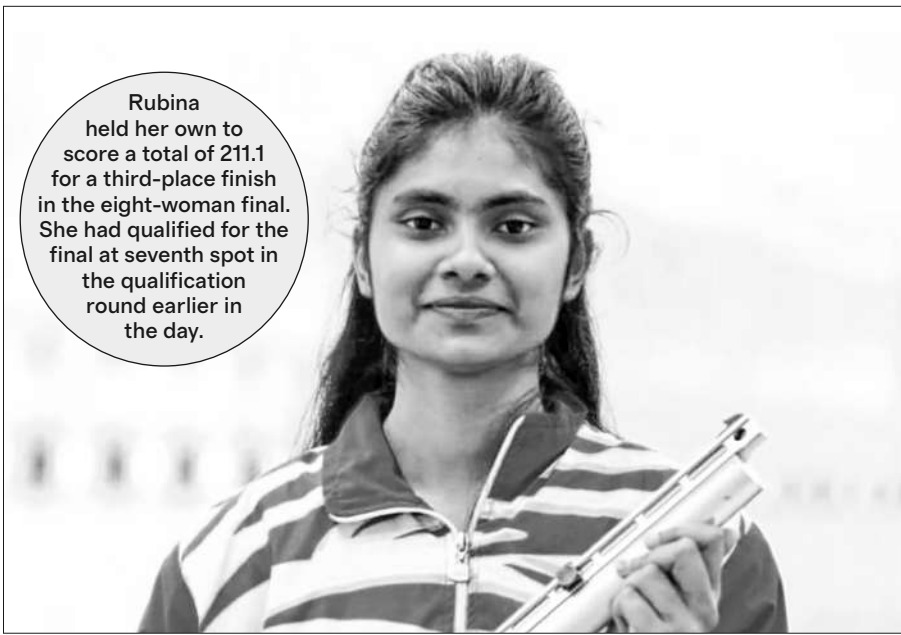
Rubina's medal was India's fourth in shooting and fifth overall at the Paris Paralympics. She is India's first woman pistol shooter to win a Paralympics medal.

She had secured the Paris Paralympics quota under the bipartite (wildcard) rule a few days before the contingent's departure for the French capital.

In SH1 class, athletes are able to hold their gun without difficulty and shoot from a standing or sitting position in a wheelchair or chair. A daughter of mechanic in Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh, Rubina was born with an impairment to her leg, and she took up the sport inspired by her admiration for legendary Indian shooter Gagan Narang's Olympic achievements.

On Friday, Avani Lekhara had created history by successfully defending her women's 10m air rifle gold medal which she had clinched in Tokyo Paralympics, with compatriot Mona Agarwal winning the bronze. Manish Narwal then added a silver medal in the men's 10m air pistol (SH1).

Earlier, Indian shooter Swaroop Unhalkar finished a dismal 14th in the men's 10m air rifle standing (SH1) qualification round to miss the eight-player final by quite a distance.



Rubina held her own to score a total of 211.1 for a third-place finish in the eight-woman final. She had qualified for the final at seventh spot in the qualification round earlier in the day.

Sarita storms to quarters in archery

Indian archer Sarita Kumari put up a commanding show to down Italy's Eleonora Sarti 141-135 in a one-sided affair and storm into the quarterfinals of the compound women's open category at the Paralympics here on Saturday. The ninth seeded Sarita, who won a team silver medal at the Asian Para Games last year, dropped just one point to take a four-point lead in the first end.

There was no looking back as she stretched the lead to five points in the second end where she shot one X (closer to the centre). Her higher-ranked Italian rival pulled off two 10s and took the third end, but Sarita remained in control and sealed the issue with two solid ends. Sarita earlier knocked out Nur Jannaton Abdul Jalil of Malaysia 138-124.

Nitesh, Sukant enter semis

Manoj, who failed to qualify for knockouts, beat Yang Jianyuan

Indian shuttlers Nitesh Kumar and Sukant Kadam qualified for the semifinals of men's singles SL3 and SL4 categories respectively after recording straight-game wins in their last group matches in the Paris Paralympics on Saturday.

Nitesh, who had won a silver medal in the Asian Para Games last year in China, beat Mongkhon Bunsun of Thailand 21-13 21-14 to notch his third successive win and top group A.

Bunsun also qualified for the semifinals as the second-place finisher from group A. In SL3 class, which is meant for players with severe lower limb disability competing on half-width court, the top two finishers from each of the two groups qualify for the semifinals.

In the group A, Tokyo Paralympics bronze medalist Manoj Sarkar, who has already bowed out of the tournament, beat Yang Jianyuan



of China 21-1 21-11. Manoj had earlier lost to Bunsun and Nitesh.

In men's singles SL4 class, meant for athletes with lower limb impairments and minor balance issues in walking or running, Sukant joined compatriot Suhans Yathiraj in the semifinals after beating Thailand's Teamarrom Siripong 21-12 21-12 to top group B. In men's SL4 competition, only the toppers from each of the four groups qualify for the semifinals.

Meanwhile, Mandep Kaur entered the quarterfinals of the women's singles SL3 category after defeating Australia's Vinot Celine Aurelie in the women's singles SL 3 event on Saturday.

Preeti's coach Satyanarayana proud of historic medal

In a monumental moment for Indian para-athletics, Preeti Pal, under the guidance of her coach Satyanarayana, made history by becoming the first Indian woman to win a medal in track at the Paralympics.

Preeti Pal clinched a bronze medal in the women's T35 100m run event. Speaking to ANI after

Preeti's remarkable achievement, an emotional Satyanarayana described the victory as his "Guru Dakshina." "This is Guru Dakshina for me. She is the first woman to win a medal in track at the Paralympics. This is an inspiration for other players. We are expecting 10-12 medals in athletics alone..." the coach said.

He expressed immense pride in his student's accomplishment.

Looking ahead, Satyanarayana is optimistic about India's prospects in athletics at the Paralympics.

Satyanarayana's dedication as a coach and Preeti's determination as an athlete have brought immense pride to the country. As India celebrates this historic moment, the future of Indian para-athletics looks brighter than ever, with expectations of more medals and milestones to come.

On Friday, Avani Lekhara struck gold in the women's 10m air rifle final at the Paris Paralympics. Shooter Mona Agarwal bagged the bronze medal at the same event. Meanwhile, Manish Narwal won silver in the men's 10m air pistol SH1 pistol final event. Preeti Pal won bronze in the 100m T35 event, the Indian para sprinter Preeti Pal said that she couldn't believe that she won the medal.
