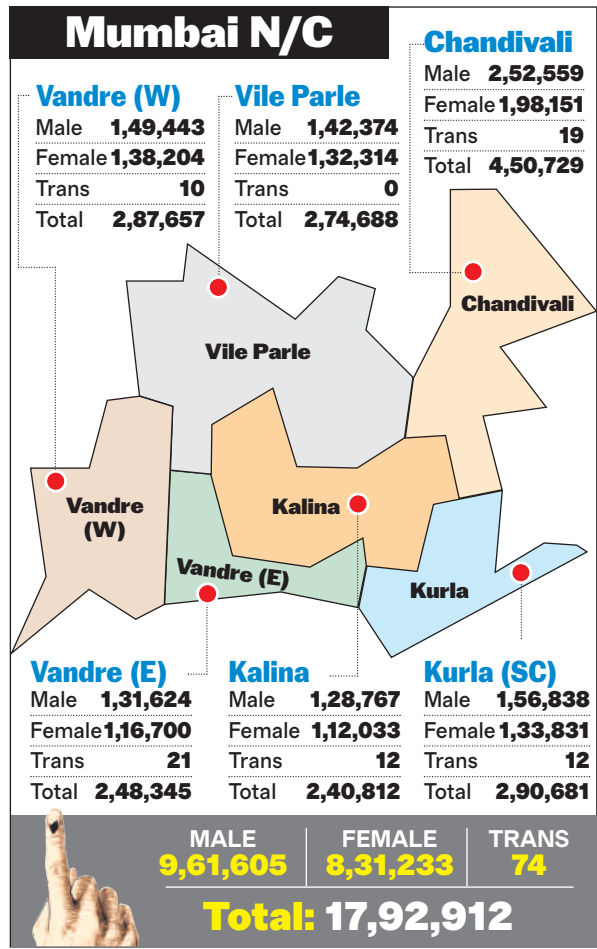

Citizens' welfare forum seeks better transport, roads

Modern suburban trains, more AC locals, expansion of BEST services and a dedicated BMC department for managing footpaths are some of the key demands raised by Mumbai North Central District Forum (MNCDF) in its charter for the state polls. It requested for stringent regulations to control noise and air pollution, tackle traffic violations and illegal parking practices, with focus on effective cleanliness drive.

ernance, budget allocations and resource management with publicly available reports on key projects. It also sought a unified and effective grievance redressal system by integrating various government platforms into a unified website. Furthermore, it also demanded an improved governance structure with a "forwarding authority" within each government agency to redirect complaints with a review system and expansion of e-governance services.

Batting for better public transport service, the charter also pressed upon the need of improving roads, finding solutions for waterlogging and better connectivity to business hubs. It further highlighted pedestrian safety with a demand of a new department within the BMC to look after footpaths. The charter also stressed upon filling vacancies in public hospitals and modernising them, while seeking one tertiary care hospital in every ward.

MNCDF also turned the spotlight on key issues like safety and security. It especially focused over enactment of the Advocates Protection Act to ensure their protection from any harm, while discharging duty.

Will miffed Congress workers, Byculla Muslims shun polls?

As the two Shiv Senas are set to face off on November 20 in the Byculla assembly seat, rumours have sprung up about a boycott of the Sena (UBT) candidate by Muslims and Congress workers unhappy that the Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) did not allot the seat, which has a significant Muslim population, to the Congress.

Many Congress leaders were in the fray for the seat, including ex-MLAs Yusuf Abrahani and Madhukar Chavan, the latter representing the seat in 2009-2014 and 1999-2004.

Local cable television and social media have reported about a secret meeting by angry Muslim and Congress voters to boycott Sena (UBT) candidate Manoj Jamsutkar who is contesting against Yamini Jadhav, the sitting MLA who is now with the Eknath Shinde-led Shiv Sena.

Though the local media named Chavan as one of Congress leaders who had attended the "secret meeting" at an undisclosed location a few days ago, Chavan denied this and said he is supporting Jamsutkar. "There are a group of four-five people who have called for a boycott of the UBT candidate. We have to change the government, and for this we have to stand together,"

said Chavan. Chavan said he had been in the reckoning for the seat, as were 10 to 12 other people. "I was the only Maratha candidate," added Chavan. "We are helping Jamsutkar. What the voters have in their mind will be revealed on November 20."

About 42% of Byculla's voters are Muslim. Another 13% are from other minority groups like Dalits, Christians, and Jains. The constituency has not re-elected an MLA since 2004 when the seat was called Chinchpokli.

Abrahani, who had called for a meeting to protest against the MVA decision to allot the seat to Sena (UBT), said, "After I gave a boycott call, I got calls from the Congress high command and the UBT. It was agreed that Congress did well in the parliamentary elections because of support of UBT voters. According to our formula, the seat went to UBT because the sitting MLA was from the party," said Abrahani. "My argument is that this is a seat with 42% Muslim voters. If a Muslim cannot contest from this seat, where do they go?" said Abrahani. He added that he called a meeting of Congress workers to assuage them. "There were 200 people at the meeting. We asked them to work for the MVA since the seat has already been allotted. Our point is that this is a Muslim seat," he said.

Now Shinde's turn to take a back seat on BJP posters

Chief Minister Eknath Shinde seems to have been "downsized" by the Bharatiya Janata Party as its posters for the Assembly elections feature only a passport-sized photo of Shinde, although the party claims they are contesting the election under his leadership.

The BJP's posters feature CM Shinde's passport-sized photographs despite hailing his electoral leadership

Previously, some posters had gone viral for Deputy CM Ajit Pawar's photo being missing from them. Now, with such a small image of the sitting chief minister, there is growing speculation about what message the BJP intends to convey.

The Congress argues that the BJP is trying to keep Shinde in line. Congress President Nana Patole said that while BJP claims Shinde will stay as chief minister, the real face of the party is Deputy CM Devendra Fadnavis. Patole added that while the party banners include symbols of all three parties, only Modi and Fadnavis are highlighted, with Shinde barely visible.

SENA VS SENNA | Yamini Jadhav slams Uddhav-led party; sure of poll victory 'Shinde Sena follows Balasaheb's Hindutva which is not communal'

Yamini Jadhav, 57, the Shiv Sena (Shinde group) MLA from Byculla said that the Muslim community is upset with Sena (UBT) as the latter's MPs disappeared from the parliamentary discussion on the Waqf bill.

Jadhav, who has been a BMC corporator twice, visited The Free Press Journal's office on Friday and interacted with journalists as part of the FPJ Dialogue' series. She said that the Sena (UBT) MPs vanished from the parliament when the Muslims had pinned hopes on them with regards to the Waqf bill.

"I did not campaign just to woo Muslim voters, but the UBT candidates did, and even the community blessed them in the 2024 general elections. Hence, it was mandatory for them to speak up for the community during the parliamentary discussion on the Waqf bill. However, all the nine MPs bunked the proceedings at the

behest of their leader," said Jadhav.

Belittling the Maha Vikas Aghadi's objections to the Ladki Bahin scheme, Jadhav

said the scheme was planned much earlier than the elections and accordingly a huge sum was allocated in the state budget. She claimed that

46,000 women from her constituency have received benefits under the scheme, so far.

"I have met the beneficiaries and their emotions tell us that for the first time someone has thought about them. One of them bought her diabetes medicines with the scheme money, while another started a small business. This scheme will help household women to come out as entrepreneurs," Jadhav added.

The split in Shiv Sena has also led to a split in the Marathi votes across the state. However, Jadhav is confident that most of the electors are with her. Dubbing her rival candidate - Sena (UBT) leader Manoj Jamsutkar - as 'gaddar' or traitor, she underscored that he first jumped from Sena to NCP then moved to Congress before switching to MNS. "He came back to (undivided) Sena only because he was not getting a chance to contest elections. He was again planning to jump to the BJP, thinking he won't get a ticket. However, the party split turned out to be in his favour in this matter," said Jadhav.

She also slammed Sena (UBT) for sidelining seniors like Ram Sawant, Baban Gaonkar and Ramakant Rahate and fielding those "who were very young into politics".

Talking about the works in her constituency, Jadhav said that her vision is to enforce

cluster redevelopment in accordance with the new amendment in the housing policy, which allows redevelopment even if the owner opposes it. She said that she will try to remove the obstacle of the minimum area for redevelopment by decreasing the cap from 4,000 sq mt to 3,000 sq mt. "This will boost cluster redevelopment across the city," Jadhav asserted.

She said that due to her efforts, the Navy will get an office and a jetty estimated to be worth Rs60 crore on Mumbai Port Trust land.

Talking about the recent controversy over her distribution of burqas, Jadhav said that she was proud of it and will distribute them next year again. "I distributed Paithni sarees to Hindu women and on the next day I distributed burqas. I don't care if a few people from the BJP did not like it. I know how to respect the multi-faith population," Jadhav added.

She claimed that her distribution of burqas is different from Sena (UBT)'s appeasement of minorities, alleging that the latter does not care about Muslims. "We follow Balasaheb's Hindutva which is not communal. We had a Muslim minister in the state government during his leadership and even the BJP has had Muslim ministers in the state and the Centre," she said.

पाकिस्तान के एजेंडे को बढ़ावा न दे कांग्रेस : मोदी



प्रधानमंत्री ने नाशिक में शिवाजी महाराज की प्रतिमा को नमन किया

प्रधानमंत्री नरेंद्र मोदी ने शुक्रवार को जोर देकर कहा कि दुनिया की कोई ताकत जम्मू-कश्मीर में अनुच्छेद 370 को वापस नहीं ला सकती। 'इंडिया' गठबंधन पर निशाना साधते हुए उन्होंने कहा कि कांग्रेस और उसके सहयोगी दलों को पाकिस्तान के एजेंडे को बढ़ावा नहीं देना चाहिए और अलगाववादियों की भाषा नहीं बोलनी चाहिए। प्रधानमंत्री ने महाराष्ट्र के धुले में एक रैली को संबोधित करते हुए आरोप लगाया कि कांग्रेस एक जाति को दूसरी जाति के खिलाफ खड़ा कर रही है। लोगों को एकजुट रहने के लिए आगाह करते हुए उन्होंने कहा, 'एक हैं, तो सेफ (सुरक्षित) हैं'। महाराष्ट्र में 20 नवंबर को होने वाले विधान सभा चुनाव के लिए अपनी पहली रैली को संबोधित करते हुए मोदी ने कहा कि दलितों

और आदिवासियों को भड़काने के लिए 'इंडिया' गठबंधन कोरी किताबों को संविधान के रूप में पेश कर रहा है। उन्होंने कहा, 'जम्मू कश्मीर में केवल डॉ. आंबेडकर के संविधान का पालन किया जाएगा। आपने टीवी पर देखा होगा कि कैसे जम्मू कश्मीर विधानसभा में अनुच्छेद 370 को वापस लाने का प्रस्ताव रखा गया और जब भाजपा विधायकों ने विरोध किया, तो उन्हें बाहर निकाल दिया गया। देश और महाराष्ट्र को यह समझना चाहिए।' मोदी ने कांग्रेस पर जातियों और समुदायों को बांटने का खतरनाक खेल खेलने का भी आरोप लगाया और कहा कि यदि अनुसूचित जाति, जनजाति और पिछड़ा वर्ग एकजुट रहेंगे तो कांग्रेस की राजनीति समाप्त हो जाएगी। नेहरू के समय से ही कांग्रेस और उनके परिवार ने

आरक्षण का विरोध किया था और अब उनकी चौथी पीढ़ी के युवराज जाति विभाजन के लिए काम कर रहे हैं। लोगों को समझना चाहिए कि 'एक हैं तो सेफ हैं'।

उन्होंने कहा कि आने वाले पांच वर्षों में महाराष्ट्र को प्रगति और विकास की नई ऊंचाइयों पर ले जाया जाएगा। उन्होंने कहा, 'केवल महायुति ही सुशासन दे सकती है। महाविकास अघाड़ी ऐसी गाड़ी है जिसमें कोई पहिया नहीं है, कोई ब्रेक नहीं है और ड्राइवर की सीट पर बैठने की लड़ाई है। अलग-अलग तरह के हॉर्न सुनाई दे सकते हैं।' उन्होंने कहा, 'लोगों को याद रखना चाहिए कि महायुति आगे तार गति आहे... महाराष्ट्र की प्रगति आहे (यदि महायुति है, तो महाराष्ट्र की प्रगति और विकास सुनिश्चित है)।'

शाह का कांग्रेस पर वार

केंद्रीय गृह मंत्री अमित शाह ने कहा कि महा विकास आघाड़ी के शासन के दौरान विकास के मामले में राज्य की 'रैकिंग' गिर गई थी, लेकिन अब महायुति सरकार के तहत यह प्रत्यक्ष विदेशी निवेश (एफडीआई) आकर्षित कर रहा है।

महाराष्ट्र के सातारा जिले के कराड में रैली को संबोधित करते हुए शाह ने कांग्रेस नेता राहुल गांधी को 'झूठ की फैक्ट्री' करार दिया और आरोप लगाया कि वह अग्निपथ योजना के बारे में गलत सूचना फैला रहे हैं।

न्यायमूर्ति चंद्रचूड़ की विदाई

समाज को दिशा देने वाले फैसले लिखे

भारत के प्रधान न्यायाधीश धनंजय यशवंत चंद्रचूड़ ने शुक्रवार को अपने कार्यकाल के आखिरी दिन जैन कहावत मिच्छामी दुक्कडम का उल्लेख करते हुए कहा, 'यदि मैंने अदालत में कभी किसी का दिल दुखाया हो तो कृपया मुझे माफ कर दें।' न्यायमूर्ति चंद्रचूड़ दो साल तक इस पद पर रहे। उनके पिता वाईवी चंद्रचूड़ भी 1978 से 1985 तक देश के मुख्य न्यायाधीश रहे। इस पद पर उनका सबसे लंबा कार्यकाल रहा। उच्चतम न्यायालय में सर्वोच्च पद पर पिता और पुत्र के आसिन रहने का यह एकमात्र उदाहरण है।

9 नवंबर, 2022 को मुख्य न्यायाधीश के तौर पर नियुक्त किए गए डीवाई चंद्रचूड़ आधिकारिक तौर पर 10 नवंबर को सेवानिवृत्त होंगे, परंतु अदालत में शनिवार और रविवार का अवकाश रहेगा इसलिए आज ही उनका अंतिम कार्यदिवस था। न्यायमूर्ति संजीव खन्ना देश के अगले प्रधान न्यायाधीश होंगे।

दिल्ली के सेंट स्टीफंस कॉलेज एवं दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय (डीयू) के कैम्पस लॉ सेंटर से पढ़ाई करने वाले तथा फिर हार्वर्ड लॉ स्कूल से एलएलएम और डॉक्टरेट की डिग्री हासिल करने वाले न्यायमूर्ति चंद्रचूड़ द्वारा लिखे गए फैसलों की फेहरिस्त लंबी है। उन्हें कई सारगर्भित बयानों के लिए भी जाना जाता है। हमेशा अपनी बात कहने वाले न्यायमूर्ति चंद्रचूड़ ने 500 से अधिक फैसले लिखे, जिनमें से कुछ की आलोचना भी हुई और कई ने व्यापक प्रशंसा बटोरी। वह पांच न्यायाधीशों के संविधान पीठ द्वारा सुनाए गए ऐतिहासिक फैसले का हिस्सा थे, जिसने 'पैसिव यूथोसिया' के लिए, असाध्य रोगों से पीड़ित मरीज द्वारा तैयार किए गए 'लिविंग विल' को मान्यता दी। 'लिविंग विल' एक लिखित बयान होता है, जिसमें भविष्य में ऐसी परिस्थितियों में रोगी की चिकित्सा के संबंध में इच्छाओं का उल्लेख रहता है, जब वह सहमति व्यक्त करने में सक्षम न हो। चंद्रचूड़ कई संविधान पीठों का हिस्सा रहे और उन्होंने अयोध्या भूमि विवाद सहित कई ऐतिहासिक फैसले लिखे। उन्होंने राम जन्मभूमि-बाबरी मस्जिद भूमि विवाद मामले में, 2019 में आया सर्वसम्मति वाला फैसला लिखा था। इस फैसले ने एक सदी से भी अधिक पुराने विवादास्पद मुद्दे को सुलझा दिया और भव्य राम मंदिर के निर्माण का मार्ग प्रशस्त किया। वह उच्चतम न्यायालय के नौ न्यायाधीशों के उस पीठ का भी हिस्सा थे और सर्वसम्मति से दिए गए फैसले के प्रमुख लेखक थे, जिसने अनुच्छेद 21 (जीवन और व्यक्तिगत स्वतंत्रता) के तहत निजता के अधिकार को मौलिक अधिकार घोषित किया।

भारतीय न्यायपालिका के 50वें मुखिया को विदाई देने के लिए अदालत नंबर 1 में मौजूद वकील, जज, अदालत के अधिकारी और याचियों की उपस्थिति में न्यायाधीश चंद्रचूड़ काफी भावुक नजर आए। विदाई समारोह में न्यायमूर्ति हर्षिकेश राय ने कहा, 'न्यायमूर्ति चंद्रचूड़ उनके सहपाठी रहे हैं।' न्यायमूर्ति संजीव खन्ना ने न्यायमूर्ति चंद्रचूड़ के समोसे के प्रति प्यार, अनुशासित जीवनशैली और उनकी शानदार शख्सियत का जिक्र किया। 13 मई, 2016 को शीर्ष अदालत में पदोन्नत हुए चंद्रचूड़ का जन्म 11 नवंबर, 1959 को हुआ था। वह 29 मार्च, 2000 से 31 अक्टूबर, 2013 तक बंबई उच्च न्यायालय के न्यायाधीश रहे। इसके बाद उन्हें इलाहाबाद उच्च न्यायालय का मुख्य न्यायाधीश बनाया गया। उन्हें जून 1998 में बंबई उच्च न्यायालय ने वरिष्ठ अधिवक्ता नामित किया गया था और न्यायाधीश के रूप में उनकी नियुक्ति होने तक उसी वर्ष अतिरिक्त महाधिवक्ता बने थे। उन्होंने उच्चतम न्यायालय और बंबई उच्च न्यायालय में वकालत की। वह मुंबई विश्वविद्यालय में तुलनात्मक संवैधानिक कानून के 'विजिटिंग प्रोफेसर' थे। न्यायमूर्ति चंद्रचूड़ ने पिछले महीने भूटान में एक कार्यक्रम में कहा था कि वह अपने कार्यकाल का विश्लेषण कर रहे हैं कि 'इतिहास उन्हें किस प्रकार देखेगा? क्या मैंने चीजों को कुछ अलग तरीके से किया है? जजों एवं कानूनी पेशेवरों की आने वाली पीढ़ियों के लिए मैं कैसी विरासत छोड़ कर जा रहा हूँ।' (साथ में एंजीसियां)
