Dear Sir/Madam,

We have come across reports in the media regarding a reported incident on February 15, 2025 of students falling sick in a government secondary school in the village nearby Company's plant at Gadepan, Kota (Rajasthan), allegedly due to chemical gas released from the plant. The news report has quoted the district administration that all students in the hospital are out of danger and their condition is stable.

In the above connection, it is clarified that the Company has investigated the matter and no leakage/release of gas or any other chemical from the plant could be established. It is understood that the incident shows a high degree of localization affecting only a small part of the school building while other nearby inhabited village areas and the plant itself reported no symptoms. All air monitoring parameters monitored by online Air Quality Monitoring Stations were within permissible limits.

The plant is in compliance of the highest safety and environmental standards and the complex is equipped with state-of-the-art online monitoring systems and indicators. The Company continues to extend all cooperation to the local administration in trying to ascertain the cause of the incident.
