MMRDA Fines Contractor Rs 1 Crore After Cracks Appear on Mumbai Trans Harbour Link Ramp

Air India Flight AI129 to London Returns to Mumbai Due to Technical Issue

Mumbai, August 14

The Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) has levied a Rs 1 crore fine against the contractor responsible for the Mumbai Trans Harbour Link (MTHL) after cracks appeared on the approach ramp at Shivaji Nagar. These cracks emerged just six months after the road's opening to traffic and were detected during an inspection in the third week of June 2024. In response to an RTI query from activist Anil Galgali, the MMRDA confirmed the fine, noting that the potholes and fissures were found on the temporary road connecting Ramp 5 of the bridge, rather than on the main



bridge itself. The issues were promptly repaired, and a show-cause notice was issued to Strabag. As per RTI information, on June 22, 2024, MMRDA's Chief Engineer, D. M. Chamliwar, formally notified the contractor of the deficiencies, stating that although the road work was completed

ensure the quality of the footpath meets the required standards. RTI activist Galgali suggested that MMRDA should conduct inspections of all projects every six months to identify and correct any quality-related issues promptly. He supported the fine but also advocated for blacklisting Strabag to prevent future lapses. The Atal Setu, which connects Sewri in Mumbai with Chirle in Navi Mumbai, has become a crucial link for around 30,000 vehicles daily, significantly easing travel to South Mumbai. Constructed at a total cost exceeding Rs 17,840 crore, the 21.8 km long bridge—16.5 km of which spans the sea—holds the distinction of being India's longest sea bridge.

1.4 Million Govt Employees to go on Indefinite Strike Over Pension Dispute

Starting August 29, around 1.4 million government and semi-government employees in Maharashtra will go on an indefinite strike. This comes in response to the state administration's failure to implement a reformed pension program. Last year, the government formed a committee led by retired IAS officer Subodh Kumar to address concerns over the new pension scheme (NPS). Following the committee's report, Chief Minister Eknath Shinde announced a revised NPS in March 2024. The revised

scheme guarantees employees a pension fixed at 50% of their last drawn basic salary plus a dearness allowance. However, more than five months have passed since the announcement, and the government has yet to send out any official communication regarding the updated NPS. On Tuesday, August 13, the Maharashtra State Gazetted Officers Federation (MSGOF) announced its intention to strike on August 29. The MSGOF represents Class 1 and Class 2 government employees. Vinod Desai, president of MSGOF, confirmed the strike. The strike includes over 840,000 zilla parishad employees and 567,000 state government employees. It will

include bureaucrats and teachers. The strike is expected to put force on the ruling government, which is already dealing with the Maratha-OBC reservation issue. Sources suggest that the employees intend to continue strike until the government issues the notification for the updated NPS. It has also been reported that during a meeting with the chief secretary in June, MSGOG was told that the notification would be released within one to two months. However, with August half past and the model code of conduct for assembly elections expected to take effect soon, the union argues that the government must act immediately.

Panel set up in Maharashtra's Palghar to address land right issues of tribals

A committee has been set up in Palghar district of Maharashtra to address the issues relating to joint forest rights of tribal people and expedite resolution of their pending claims, the district administration has said. Antar Singh Arya, chairman of the National Commission for Scheduled Tribes (NCST) made the announcement about the panel to be chaired by district collector Govind Bodke, after an inspection tour of the district on Monday and Tuesday,



an official release here said. The chairman held a meeting of all the stakeholders on Tuesday and reviewed the projects meant for tribals in the district, it said. During the two-day tour, Arya and other commission members visited several villages and ashram schools to assess their present condition and expressed concern over the quality of facilities and amenities provided to students in these schools. Following this, the district administration has been given

a one-month deadline to enhance conditions at the ashram schools, and to ensure that each student has access to a bed and other essential amenities. A follow-up inspection is scheduled for next month to evaluate the improvements, the release said. The district collector has been instructed to submit a detailed report on food samples from ashram schools which have been sent to a laboratory for testing.

Three con men rob a passenger while boarding a Vashi bus

A passenger from Navi Mumbai and his two friends were boarding a Vashi bus at the Vashi bus stop on Vallipier Road in Kalyan West around 9 p.m. on Monday night. At this time, while boarding the bus, three con men quarreled with a passenger and snatched his mobile, worth INR 12,000, from him. Until

now, there were cases of theft of belongings from the passengers in the Kalyan West bus depot of the State Transport Corporation and looting of the belongings from the hands of the passengers outside the depot. There is an atmosphere of fear among the passengers due to the increasing number of thieves in the Kalyan West Railway Station area day by day. Police said Hetaraj Prajapati (22) works in Kalyan and lives in the Sanpada area

of Navi Mumbai. On Monday around 9 p.m., the complainant, Hetaraj, and his two accomplices were boarding a Navi Mumbai Transport Corporation Vashi bus at the Vashi bus stop on Vallipier Road. While boarding the bus, the three con men started a fight with Hetaraj, asking why he pushed them while boarding the bus. The three of them started beating Hetaraj. While Hetaraj was telling them sensibly, they were using the language of bullying.

NCP (SP) questions surveillance on Maha Yuti leaders

The Sharad Pawar-led NCP (SP) on Wednesday asked the BJP-led Maha Yuti government to clarify whether they have mounted surveillance on top leaders of the Maha Vikas Aghadi. The statement follows the alleged hacking of phone and WhatsApp of Baramati MP Supriya Sule, who is the NCP (SP) Working President. Over the past five years, MVA leaders had been flagging the issue of surveillance mounted on them. "It is imperative that the Maharashtra Home Ministry clarify whether any surveillance is being conducted on Shiv Sena (UBT) head Uddhav Thackeray, NCP (SP) Working President Supriya Sule, NCP (SP) Maharashtra President Jayant Patil, Maharashtra Congress President Nana Patole or any other opposition leaders.



Such actions, if true, would be a grave violation of democratic principles," NCP (SP) chief spokesperson Mahesh Tapase said. Tapase alleged that Sule, who has recently emerged victorious in a hard-fought

electoral battle, might be under the watch of government agencies. Tapase accused the BJP of resorting to desperate measures to undermine Supriya Sule after failing to defeat her electorally. "The BJP, which was determined to defeat Supriya Sule, finds itself in an uncomfortable position after her electoral success. In an attempt to weaken our party, they engineered a split in the NCP by luring Ajit Pawar to their side," Tapase said.

Mumbai Hit-And-Run Horror: SUV Kills Sleeping Rickshaw Driver On Restricted Beach Area

New Delhi:

A 36-year-old rickshaw driver, Ganesh Yadav, was killed after being run over by a white SUV while sleeping on Mumbai's Versova Beach along with his friend, the police said on Wednesday. The police have registered a case of culpable homicide against two individuals and arrested them. This includes the driver of the SUV, who fled the scene after the incident that took place in the early hours of Monday. Ganesh Yadav and his friend, Bablu Srivastava, had decided to sleep

on the cool sand on Versova Beach to escape the extreme heat in their room. They were sleeping in an area that was out-of-bounds for all vehicles. However, Bablu was awakened from his sleep by the noise of screeching brakes and people screaming. To his horror, he saw that a white SUV had run over his friend Ganesh. Bablu saw two men exit the vehicle, attempt to check on Ganesh, and then flee when he did not respond. Versova Police arrived promptly at the scene after receiving information

about the incident and rushed Ganesh to Cooper Hospital, where he was pronounced dead. The police registered a case under various sections of the IPC. The suspects, identified as Nikhil Jawale (34) and his friend Shubham Dongre (33), were arrested within hours of the crime, according to a senior police officer. Their blood samples are being tested for further investigation. The suspects were presented in Andheri Court and remanded in police.

Sperm or egg donor has no legal right on child

A sperm or egg donor has no legal right on the child and cannot claim to be its biological parent, the Bombay High Court held on Tuesday while allowing a 42-year-old woman visitation rights to her five-year-old twin daughters. The woman, in her plea, said her daughters, born via surrogacy, were living with her husband and

younger sister, who was the egg donor. The petitioner's husband had claimed since his sister-in-law was the egg donor, she had a legitimate right.
