Police on Tuesday opposed the bail application of one of the alleged shooters involved in the firing on actor Salman Khan's residence, claiming that he and his accomplice intended to kill the Bollywood actor.

If accused Vicky Gupta was released on bail, he might inform gangster Lawrence Bishnoi, the alleged mastermind of the shooting, about the investigation so far and

crucial evidence could be destroyed, police said.

Gupta was in touch with gangster Lawrence Bishnoi and his brother Anmol before the attack. The prosecution said Gupta was part of the conspiracy to attack the actor's house.

Gupta has moved a bail plea before the special court claiming "he was actually influenced by the character of Lawrence Bishnoi from the electronic, print and social media, and was magnetically attached to the principles fol-

He claimed that Bisnoi had been dragged in the case unnecessarily. "It is apparent on the face of record, that the applicant did not receive any call from Lawrence Bishnoi nor any middle-man had instigated the applicant to talk with Lawrence Bishnoi, as he is wrongly inducted in the present case, and did not have

any role to play in the present matter."

The prosecution, however, said that Gupta was involved in the crime along with the other arrested and absconding accused. The prosecution further highlighted that Gupta purchased the motorcycle used in the crime at the behest of absconding accused Lawrence and Anmol.

The prosecution said that a day before the attack, Gupta had spoken to a few witnesses and shared his plans. Thus, the prosecution said, he was very much aware about everything and participated in the act.

Actor's neighbour files case against his Galaxy tenants

Police in Bandra recently filed an FIR against the MD of Legend Leasing and Finance and her husband for committing criminal breach of trust and causing property damage.

In his complaint to the police, Pradip Almadhi, 69, said Divya Kushwaha and Jayanta Roy had rented his flat in Galaxy Apartment complex in Bandra (West). Before vacating, Kushwaha and her husband allegedly removed equipment from the flat and damaged items in it.

Actor Salman Khan also lives in the same building.

In 2019, Almadhi signed a rental agreement with Legend Leasing and Finance. The agreement, covering the period from January 2019 to January 2022, allowed Kushwaha and Roy to live in the flat.

Until September 2020, the couple were paying Rs2.25 lakh per month as rent. However, they later failed to

make rent payments. As a result, Almadhi requested that they vacate the flat and settle the outstanding rent.

Kushwaha assured Almadhi that the rent would be paid but refused to vacate. Consequently, Almadhi approached the Rent Control Authority. The authority directed Kushwaha to pay the rent and vacate the flat. Kushwaha challenged the authority's decision in the Bombay High Court. The case eventually reached the Supreme Court, which ordered Kushwaha to vacate the flat by July 31, 2024.

Additionally, the court mandated that the remaining rent amount of Rs75.26 lakh be paid to Almadhi within eight weeks. Kushwaha handed over the flat to Almadhi on July 10, 2024, but did not pay the outstanding rent.

Upon regaining possession of the flat, Almadhi discovered that several items were missing. There was also extensive damage to the flat.

Father moves HC, seeks to be heard

The father of a woman, who died in 2021 after falling from her Pune residence's balcony, has approached the Bombay High Court claiming that he should be heard before any order is passed in the PIL by BJP leader Chitra Wagh in which it is alleged that minister Sanjay Rathod was linked to her death.

In February 2021, several photographs of a tribal woman with Rathod and 12 audio clips went viral. The woman later died by suicide. At the time, the MVA was in power. Rathod, who was an MLA from Digrao constituency, had to resign then. Wagh then approached the HC seeking registration of an FIR. She had sought a probe by a special investigation team or transfer of the case to CBI. However, after the split of

Shiv Sena in 2022, Rathod joined the Eknath Shinde faction and is currently in government with Wagh's party.

order was passed. His advocate Pranav Badheka mentioned the application before a bench of Chief Justice DK Upadhyaya and Justice Amit Borkar seeking an urgent hearing. He said that the father was not seeking any relief but the family's name was being maligned.

Badheka said: "The applicant (father) has no grouse or

complaint against anybody. This PIL is politically motivated. The applicant has four daughters and every time the issue comes up in the media they face issues in their matrimonial homes."

The HC has kept the plea for hearing on September 2.

Last week, Wagh's PIL had come up for hearing before the same bench when her advocate sought to withdraw the plea. The judges had then expressed displeasure over "game" being played through PILs.

Public prosecutor Hiten Venegaonkar had informed the bench that around the time of the suicide, Rathod was in Nagpur. The police had taken Rathod's voice samples and the phone was sent to the Forensics Science Laboratory (FSL). The FSL stated that the voice in the clip was "similar" to that of Rathod, but was not "identical". Hence, he was given a clean chit.

NCLT levies ₹60,000 fine on Bombay Local Pictures

The National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) has imposed a compounding fee of Rs30,000 each on Sonya Khan and Feroz Abbas Khan, directors of Bombay Local Pictures Private Limited, after the company failed to present its financial statements at the annual general meetings (AGMs) for the financial years 2010-11, 2011-12 and 2012-13.

The NCLT stated that the total fee of Rs60,000 would serve as a sufficient deterrent to prevent the repetition of such defaults in the future.

The compounding application was filed by the directors acknowledging that they had not presented the statements to the company's members during the AGMs.

The application said that the registrar of companies had not issued any show-cause notices to the company or its directors for non-compliance with Section 210 of the Companies Act, 1956. However, recognising the oversight and in a bid to uphold corporate governance, the board decided to pursue the compounding of the offence.

The directors explained that the delay in holding the AGMs within the required time frame, and the subsequent violations of Section 210(1), were accidental and inadvertent, asserting that neither the company nor its directors had any malicious or fraudulent intent.

Man jailed for 3 years for assaulting TC

A sessions court has sentenced a 25-year-old labourer to three years' imprisonment for manhandling a ticket checker. While sentencing the man, the court said such offences were against the society in general, and such attitudes must be dealt with a stern hand.

Tinku Mohammad Khan, a resident of Navi Mumbai, was caught without a ticket at

Seawood Railway Station at 9.30am on February 18, 2021.

It is claimed that when the ticket checker asked Khan for an ID, he produced two cards: the Aadhaar card was in the

name of Tinku Mohammed, son of Mohammed Kayyum, CBD Belapur, Navi Mumbai, while the election card mentioned his name as Rinku Mohammed Kayyum, son of Mohammed Kayyum, resident of Thana Chandra, Tehsil Lambhava, District Sultanpur.

The ticket checker took the accused to a railway police chowki. On the way, the accused started abusing and manhandling him. Constables quickly arrived at the scene and took Khan to the station.

"Considering the nature of the offence, wherein property of the railway has been misused without valid ticket, railway pass or a platform ticket, and when inquired by the TC about it, not only the accused manhandled the TC but even dared to use criminal force... thus deterring a public servant from discharging his official duty. In such a case no lenient view is possible considering the age of the accused and use of muscles power," the court said.

Accommodation crisis for new postgraduate students at TISS

As new PG students gathered for their orientation programme at the Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS), Mumbai, on Monday, they were allegedly hit with an unexpected announcement: hostel allotments would only be provided after they make a payment of Rs38,000 (Rs18,000 for accommodation and Rs20,000 as dining hall charges).

Earlier, the institute allowed the students to pay the charges in two instalments. Sources said that from this year TISS will begin the accommodation process after a full and final payment. This has led to frustration among students, many of whom travelled to the campus without prior hostel allotment. Earlier, students were allotted hostels with the instalment option before they arrived.

As per a varsity payment document, "If admitted to hostel, charges of Rs18,000 need to be paid in two equal



instalments of Rs9,000; first being with the semester fee at the time of joining hostel and other instalment as per the schedule to be announced by the institute."

From this year, TISS Mumbai had announced that first-year students from the Other Backward Castes (OBC), Economically Weaker Section (EWS), and general categories must have a family income of up to Rs1 lakh to qualify for hostel accommodation, while SC and ST candidates must have a family income of up to Rs2.5 lakh. Earlier, the cap for the OBC, EWS, and general categories was Rs2.5 lakh and Rs4.5 lakh for the SC and ST categories.

"First they reduced the cap, which already made it very difficult for many to get accommodation. Now they're asking us to pay everything upfront," said a student who's taking admission this year. Another student, whose parents' income in 2023-24 period was a little over Rs2.5 lakh, said, "I have no choice but to take a PG accommodation which is very costly in Mumbai."

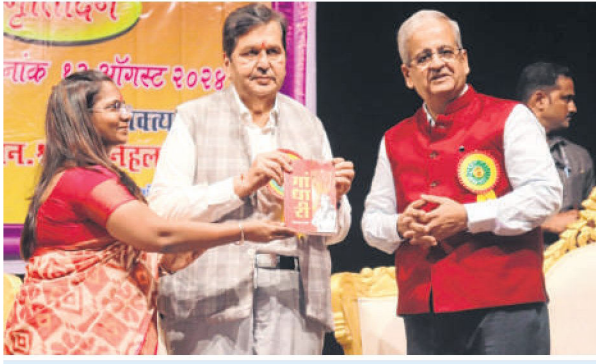
