'Disregard for Kashmiri lives', say political leaders after civilian truck driver killed in army firing incident

ACIVILIAN truck driver was killed in a firing incident involving Army personnel on the Srinagar-Jammu national highway near Sopore in Kashmir. While the Army claims he jumped a checkpoint and was chased for 23 km before firing of the truck were fired at "to deflate" them, the death has stirred up a storm after his family and political leaders questioned the official version.

According to the police, a civilian truck driver was killed when the army fired at him near Sangrama village of Sopore on the Srinagar-Baramulla national highway. Police have identified the slain truck driver as Waseem Ahmad Mir, a 32-year-old resident of Bomai village. The village is some 15 km from Sangrama, the site of the shooting.

This comes at a time when the district administration and the police in Kathua ordered inquiries after the custodial death of a Gujar youth in Kathua.

In its statement after the killing, the army's Chinara Corps said that the driver jumped a checkpoint on Wednesday when he was asked to stop.

"On 05 Feb 2025, based on a very specific intelligence input about the movement of terrorists, a Mobile Vehicle Check Post (MVCP) was established by Security Forces. One speeding

suspicious civil truck was spotted. When challenged, the truck didn't stop despite repeated warnings (and) instead accelerated further while crossing the check post," the statement said.

The troops pursued the vehicle for over 23 km, the army said. "Shots were fired aiming (at) tyres to deflate, which forced (the) vehicle to halt at Sangrama Chowk. Consequently, detailed search, the injured driver was immediately evacuated to GMC Baramulla by Security Forces where he was declared dead."

But the family of the slain driver, however, questioned the army's version of the incident and demanded that they release CCTV footage of the incident. Significantly, there are several security camps and security check posts on the stretch.

According to Mir's cousin Abdul Rashid, Mir had left home at 10 pm Wednesday with a truck full of apple boxes and was heading towards Srinagar. It was a co-driver who alerted them of Mir's death.

"If the army is telling the truth, let them share the CCTV footage with us. There is a CCTV camera installed on every security force vehicle," Mir's cousin Abdul Rashid told The Indian Express.

"They (army) are saying they chased him for 23 km. There are many (security) camps on this stretch and every camp has CCTV cameras installed on the roads... Let them show it to us to satisfy

us". He claimed there were "contradictions in the statements made by the police and the army".

"How could they chase him for 23 km when the distance between his home and the place where the incident happened is less than 16 km? The army says they chased him for 23 km but the SP sahib told us he was chased for 35 km. We also want to know when he had to go to Srinagar, why was the vehicle in the (opposite) direction, going to Baramulla. His clothes were in the dirt. We want to know if they had beaten or tortured him before killing," he said.

A doctor at the Baramulla Hospital said Mir was brought in by the Army at 1 pm. "He had a single bullet injury with both entry and exit wounds. The nature of injury suggested that he was shot at from close range," he said.

Another relative too echoed this. "The bullet had hit his armpit and had exited from the other side. If the army had aimed at the tyres or the vehicle, the bullet couldn't have hit his armpit," this relative said.

The oldest of four siblings, Mir is survived by his daily wage father, a homemaker mother, three brothers and a married sister.

Meanwhile, opposition parties have called the incident a "disregard for Kashmiri lives".

The Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) leader Iltija Mufti has also questioned the Army's version of

the incident. "...you (army) say that you chased a civilian for 24 km in a wild goose chase and then you targeted the tyres (of his vehicle)... But how was he (Mir) hit? How was he fatally killed? I want to ask the army that you seized the truck, what did you get from that truck?" she asked in a hurriedly called press conference in Srinagar.

Peoples Conference chairman Sajad Lone has termed Mir killing as a "murder". "Killing is a killing irrespective of the source or the context. The killing of the truck driver is a murder. And it being executed by security forces makes it even more heinous," Lone said, calling it "contempt and disregard for Kashmiri lives".

Reacting to the incident, Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Omar Abdullah said that he had ordered an inquiry and had taken it up with the Union government.

"I have seen the reports of excessive use of force & harassment of Makhani Din in police custody in Billawar leading to his suicide and the death of Waseem Ahmed Malla (Mir), shot by the army under circumstances that are not entirely clear. Both these incidents are highly unfortunate and should not have happened," Omar said in a post on X, adding that J&K "will never be completely normalised and free of terror without the cooperation of & partnership with the local population".

Registration under Uttarakhand UCC to 'preserve demography, enrich database': Drafting panel member

REGISTRATION UNDER the Uttarakhand's Uniform Civil Code was "solely to preserve the state's demography" and "enrich the government database", a member of the committee that drafted the legislation said Monday.

Prof Surekha Dangwal, vice-chancellor of Doon University was part of the committee that drafted the UCC Act passed as Uniform Civil Code of Uttarakhand Act, 2024. Prof Dangwal said that the state law had "no connection with Uttarakhand's domicile or permanent residence certificate". "The provision to include all individuals who have lived in Uttarakhand for at least one year is intended to safeguard the

state's demographic composition," she said in a statement.

The statement comes two weeks after the state government rolled out rules under the UCC. Among other things, the law aims to record marriages, divorces, and live-in relationships, sparking fears of possible moral policing among some sections.

According to Dangwal, UCC "does not confer any extra benefits" on domiciled individuals.

"The criteria for permanent residency in Uttarakhand remain unchanged, and this was never a subject of discussion before the UCC committee," she said. "The aim is merely to regulate personal laws to ensure that Uttarakhand's society and culture are preserved, thus securing the demographic structure of the state. Moreover, it will help keep criminal elements in check".

She also allayed fears of registrations of live-in relationships in the state. According to Dangwal, documents submitted for live-in relationship registration under UCC will be verified solely at the registrar's level.

"When a live-in relationship application is received, the registrar will electronically provide a mere record of the relationship statement to the local police station in charge through the District Superintendent of Police. Access to this record, including for the local police station officer, will be strictly under the supervision of the District SP," she said, adding that the regulations explicitly state that when sharing information with the police, the registrar must clearly mention that the details related to live-in relationship statement are being provided solely for

record-keeping purposes. This comes at a time when some right-wing outfits have said they were "aware" of the interfaith couples among registrants and were "on the lookout for dangerous cases", although authorities have denied this was the case.

Hold workshops
Meanwhile, the Uttarakhand Home Department has written to various universities asking them to organise workshops "to provide teachers, students and staff with a clear understanding of the act".

Addressing the vice-chancellors of Doon, Kumaon, Sri Dev Suman, Uttarakhand Mukta, and Soban Singh Jeena universities in the state, the home secretary Shailesh Bagoli said that the workshops need to be organised to raise awareness about the law.

Incidents of Gir lions killing domestic animals rising: Data

New Delhi: Incidents of lions killing domestic animals in Gujarat's Gir forest have steadily increased, reaching a peak of 4,385 in 2023-24, according to recent government data.

This is despite an increase in prey animals within the Gir forest—the only natural habitat of the Asiatic lion—over the past six years. Union Environment Minister Bhupendra Yadav, citing data from the Gujarat government, informed the Rajya Sabha Thursday that incidents of lions killing domestic animals rose from 2,605 in 2019-20 to 3,244 in 2020-21, 3,659 in 2021-22, 3,670 in 2022-23, and 4,385 in 2023-24.

There is a sufficient prey base for lions in Gir and the population of the prey animals has been increasing, he said. Data shows the number of prey animals in the Gir forest rose from 1,55,659 (1.55 lakh) in 2019 to 2,02,993 (2.02 lakh) in 2022 and further to 2,13,391 (2.13 lakh) in 2024. The most recent estimate in June 2020 put the Asiatic lion population in

Gujarat at 674, up from 523 in 2015. A document from the Gujarat chief wildlife warden's office shows that the lions' distribution area rose from 22,000 square kilometres in 2015 to 30,000 square kilometres in 2020. A 2022 scientific report in the Nature journal revealed that 48 per cent of the current lion population had dispersed outside the protected areas, spanning nine districts and 13 forest administrative divisions.
