JP probe demand a sham, Cong wants stock market to crash: BJP on Hindenburg issue

NEW DELHI, AUG 12 /- The BJP on Monday rejected the Congress' demand for a JPC probe into Hindenburg's allegation against the SEBI chairperson, saying it is a sham with an eye on weakening the Indian economy and destroying investment in the country.

BJP leader and former Union Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad reiterated the party's view that the short-selling firm's charge and the Opposition's call for market regulators are part of a wider conspiracy. While India is being globally seen as a safe, stable and promising market, the Congress party wants to project that the Indian investment scenario is not safe, Prasad alleged, suggesting that the

Opposition party was seeking on the "chits" provided by foreign entities to damage economy.

Billionaire investor George Soros is an investor in Hindenburg and he is known for running propaganda against the government led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

Prasad said, the Congress wants stock market, which has given good returns to scores of small investors, to crash, he said. "After being elected, the Congress, its allies and its closest ally in the toolkit gang have conspired together to usher in economic anarchy and instability in India," he told reporters.

The 10-year-old rule of the Congress between 2004 and 2014 was marked by

several alleged scams, he questioned why such critical reports were not brought out then. The senior BJP leader alleged: "The Congress party leadership is involved in creating economic anarchy based on this fictitious report."

He, however, asserted that investors have come to realise the "conspiracy" and rejected the attempts to jolt the market. Have appealed to CM Shinde to convene all-party meet to discuss Maratha-OBC quota dispute: Pawar

PUNE, AUG 12 /- NCP (SP) president Sharad Pawar on Monday said he has appealed to Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde to convene an all-party meeting to discuss the controversial Maratha and Other Backward Classes communities.

Talking to reporters, Pawar said steps should be taken to ensure the social fabric of the state remains good and there is no bitterness between communities. The NCP (SP) chief addressed the media after activist Ramesh Keri Patil of the Maratha Kranti Thorakars met him at his residence in Pune, seeking to know his stand on the quota issue. Pawar said he accepted a memorandum given by Keri Patil. He said he had a meeting with the Chief Minister recently and suggested that he convene an all-party meeting to discuss the dispute. "I am suggesting that he convenes a meeting of all political parties to discuss the issue of quota. He should invite leaders from both aspirants and anti-quota opposition, will also attend and cooperate," Pawar said. Shinde should invite activists Manju Jirange, who has led the Maratha quota stir in the state, and OBC leaders such as state minister Chhatrapati Bhujale.

The veteran politician pointed out that there is a roadblock as the Supreme Court has already decided that the 50 per cent quota ceiling cannot be breached while giving reservation, and said the onus is on the Centre to draft policy accordingly. The Centre's policy needs to change, and if it takes the lead, the Opposition will cooperate, he said. The NCP (SP) criticised Maharashtra Navnirman Sena (MNS) chief Raj Thackeray for accusing him of causing riots and caste-based differences in the state and questioned why he was not invited to the meeting. He termed retired senior Congress Party Member of Parliament (MP) leader and former minister Anil Deshmukh "irresponsible".

"As his (Singh) conduct was inappropriate, action was initiated against him," he said. On the Waof (Amendment) Bill introduced in the Lok Sabha, Pawar said a joint parliamentary committee has been formed to review the draft bill, and it will submit its report in six months. (PTI)

Sultapur special judge on leave, hearing not held in defamation case against Rahul

SULTAPUR, AUG 12 /- Hearing in a defamation case involving senior Congress leader Rahul Gandhi could not be held in the MP MLA court in Sultapur on Monday as the special judge was on leave.

Rahul's advocate Kashi Prasad Shukla said as Special Judge Shubham Verma was on leave, no hearing could take place. August 23 has been fixed as the next date of hearing, he added. On July 26, the Congress leader appeared before the MP MLA court in his defamation case against him and said it would be gain "cheap sympathy". According to Shukla, the court in MP 13 had issued a notice to the special judge, said he never made a statement against anyone that could lead to a case of defamation against him. The court had fixed August 12 as the date of hearing.

Local BJP leader Vijay Mishra had filed a complaint on August 4, 2018, against Gandhi for his alleged objectionable comments against Union Home Minister Amit Shah at a press conference in Bengaluru in May of that year during the Karnataka assembly elections. (PTI)
