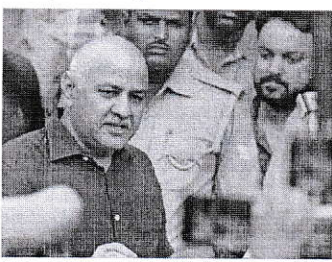

# SC gives bail to Manish Sisodia, says right to speedy trial sacrosanct

NEW DELHI, AUG 9 /--/ The Supreme Court on Friday gave bail to AAP leader Manish Sisodia who has been in jail for months, sharply pulling up the lower courts and saying his long incarceration without trial had deprived him of the right to speedy justice.



A bench of Justices B R Gavai and K V Viswanathan said in a scathing verdict it is high time trial courts and high courts recognise the principle that "bail is rule and jail is exception". "As observed time and again, prolonged incarceration before being pronounced guilty of an offence should not be permitted to become punishment without trial," the bench said while describing Sisodia as a man with "deep roots in society".

The former Delhi Deputy Chief Minister was arrested by both the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) and the Enforcement Directorate (ED) in corruption and money laundering cases linked to the alleged Delhi excise policy scam. With the apex court granting him bail in both cases, Sisodia is likely to come out of jail today after furnishing bail bond of Rs 10 lakh along with two sureties of a like amount. Listing the conditions for his bail, the judges said he will have to surrender his passport to the special trial court and not make any attempt to either influence witnesses or tamper with evidence.

Besides, he will have to report to the investigating officer every Monday and Thursday between 10-11 am. "We find that, on account of a long period of incarceration pending for a round 17 months, and the trial even not having begun, the appellant (Sisodia) has been deprived of his right to speedy trial," the bench said. "As observed by this court, the right to speedy trial and the right to liberty are sacrosanct rights. On denial of these rights, the trial court as well as the high court ought to have given due

even in straight forward open and shut cases, the court is flooded with a huge number of bail petitions. This adds to the huge pendency, keeping innocent behind bars for an indefinite period of time in the hope of speedy completion of trial would deprive his fundamental right to liberty under Article 21 of the Constitution, the judges said.

"In the present case, the appellant (Sisodia) is having deep roots in society. There is no possibility of him fleeing from the country and not being available for facing the trial."

In any case, conditions can be imposed to address the concern of the state. "It said. The bench set aside the May 21 verdict of the Delhi High Court which had dismissed Sisodia's pleas seeking bail in both these cases. (PTI)

## 'Tight slap on dictatorship': AAP slams BJP's 'politics of hatred'

Just a procedural order, doesn't absolve ex-minister of offence: Swaraj

NEW DELHI, AUG 9 /--/ The Aam Aadmi Party on Friday said the Supreme Court order granting bail to party leader Manish Sisodia is a "tight slap" on the dictatorship of the BJP-led Centre but rued that the relief came after a year's delay.

In a boost to the embattled party that is grappling with the incarceration of its senior leaders, the Supreme Court granted bail to Sisodia in corruption and money laundering cases linked to the alleged Delhi excise policy scam, noting that he has been in custody for 17 months.

Addressing a press conference, Rajya Sabha MP Sanjay Singh accused the BJP of indulging in a politics of "hatred" and "ill will", saying AAP leaders were jailed because of a "political grudge". The verdict is a "tight slap" on the dictatorship of BJP-led Union government, said Singh who was also jailed in connection to the alleged liquor scam. "This bail is a victory of judiciary and democracy," the AAP MP added.

"The Prime Minister should end this politics of keeping our leaders in jail. No evidence was found against them. Kejriwal, Sisodia and Sanyal, Jain have been kept in jail by the BJP due to ill will. There is a lot of enthusiasm among AAP workers after Sisodia's bail. Its impact will be felt in the coming elections. We hope Delhi CM Kejriwal will also be soon out of jail," he

added. AAP Delhi state convener and Delhi minister Gopal Rai, addressing the press conference, said the prayers of the people have finally been fulfilled.

"The SC bail gives a message that no dictatorship can go on indefinitely. Sisodia is known as the father of the education revolution in Delhi. The penance of the people of Delhi has been fruitless," he added. However, BJP MP Bansuri Swaraj said the Supreme Court's verdict granting bail to the former Delhi minister is a "procedural order" and this does not absolve him of the offence. Swaraj took a press conference at the BJP headquarters here that Sisodia has been granted bail because of his appeal based on "delay in trial". Swaraj alleged that the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) is involved in corruption and will be held accountable in front of the court of law sooner or later.

"Manish Sisodia's bail has been rejected seven times in court previously. This was his eighth attempt, and today his lawyers got the bail because they appealed based on delay in trial on merit. I know there must be an atmosphere of celebration at the AAP office but let me tell you what this bail actually means," he said. It does not absolve him (Sisodia) of the offence. He will still be held accountable for fooling the people of Delhi," the BJP leader said. (PTI)

# Awaiting return of 69 Indians recruited in Russian Army: Jaishankar

NEW DELHI, AUG 9 /--/ External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar on Friday said the Union government is awaiting the release of 69 Indians recruited into the Russian Army and that in many cases there are indications that the individuals were misled into joining that country's Army.

An action taken with respect to misleading of people and getting them recruited into the Russian Army, Jaishankar told the Lok Sabha that the CBI has registered a criminal case against 19 individuals and entities while evidence has surfaced against 10 human traffickers whose identities the government knows. Two of the accused were arrested on April 24 and two more on May 7. "We should not jump the gun as the Russians are not serious on this matter. I think it is important to hold the Russian government to their word and most important for us, we are not here to score points or enter into debates. We are here to get back those 69 people because Indian citizens should not be serving in the army of foreign countries," he said during the Question Hour.

The Union minister was responding to queries from AAIM members as a 400-page Ovalation action being taken against individuals who are misleading youth to join the Russian Army and whether India will stop buying discounted oil from Russia if it does not act on releasing Indians recruited into that country's army. So far, the minister said there are a total of 93 cases of Indian nationals being recruited into the Russian Army. Out of them, eight have passed away, 14 were discharged or in some manner have come back with the government's assistance and "there are 69 Indian citizens awaiting release from the Russian Army" he added.

Out of the eight who died, four were sent back to India and in two cases — one from Haryana and Punjab — DNA samples have been sent to the Russian side.

In one case from Gujarat, the family wants the boy to be cremated in Russia and in another case from Uttar Pradesh, the mortal remains are being brought back. According to Jaishankar, the problem is that the Russian authorities maintain that these Indian nationals are actually for contract services with the Russian Army. "We are not necessarily subscribing to that... I think in many cases there are reasons to indicate that our nationals were misled, that they were told that they were going for some other job and then they were deployed with the Russian Army," he said. The issue of Indian nationals recruited into the Russian Army was taken up by Prime Minister Narendra Modi during his meeting with Russia's President Vladimir Putin last month.

"We take this issue very very seriously. I have myself raised it numerous times with the Russian Foreign Minister. When the Prime Minister was in Moscow last month, he raised it personally with President Putin and got the assurance that any Indian national in the services of the Russian Army will be discharged and released," Jaishankar said. The minister was responding to

supplementaries by Congress member Adoor Prakash, who also said that five youths from his constituency were recruited into the Russian army and were later released. Adoor represents Attungal constituency in Kerala. Jaishankar also responded in detail to queries regarding instances of cyber trafficking of people who are misled and taken to South East Asian and made to work on cyber scams and related issues. "We take it very seriously and have taken up with all concerned governments at the political level. So far, 650 Indian nationals have been repatriated from Cambodia, 415 from Myanmar and 548 from Laos. "The government appreciates the gravity of the issue and this is an issue for which we have to be very vigilant and we have to track down every hard," he added. (PTI)

## SC dismisses plea seeking postponement of NEET-PG

NEW DELHI, AUG 9 /--/ The Supreme Court on Friday rejected a plea seeking postponement of the NEET-PG examination, scheduled for August 11, which claimed that candidates have been allocated cities that are highly inconvenient for them to reach. A bench comprising Chief Justice of India (CJI) D Y Chandrachud and Justices B Pradiwala and Manoj Misra said it can't put the careers of two lakh students in jeopardy for five students. "How can we postpone such an exam. Mr Sanjay Hegde, nowadays people just come asking to postpone the exam. It's not a perfect world. We are not academic experts. We as a matter of principle, we will not reschedule the exam. There are two lakh students and four lakh parents who will weep over the weekend if we postpone it. We cannot put the careers of so many candidates in jeopardy. We do not know who is behind these petitions," the bench said. Senior Advocate Sanjay Hegde, appearing for the petitioners, submitted that rescheduling the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (Postgraduate) (NEET-PG) is needed because there is one exam in the morning and one in the afternoon. The plea said many candidates have been allocated cities which are highly inconvenient for them to reach. It said the test cities were allotted on July 31 and the specific centres will be declared on August 8. The exam was initially to be held on June 23. It was postponed by the Union Health Ministry as a precautionary measure in the wake of alleged irregularities in certain other competitive exams. (PTI)

## LS adopts motion naming 21 members for JPC on Waqf Bill; will have 10 MPs from RS

NEW DELHI, AUG 9 /--/ The joint committee of Parliament to examine the Waqf (Amendment) Bill will have 31 members -- 21 from the Lok Sabha and 10 from the Rajya Sabha -- and will submit its report by the next Parliament session.

The Lok Sabha on Friday adopted a motion naming 21 of its members to be part of the committee. Kiren Rijju, who is the Minister of Parliamentary Affairs as well as Minority Affairs, moved the motion that the Waqf (Amendment) Bill be referred to a joint committee of Houses consisting of 21 members from the Lok Sabha and 10 from the Rajya Sabha. The Bill was introduced in Lok Sabha on Thursday and referred to a joint parliamentary panel after a heated debate, with the government asserting the proposed law did not intend to interfere with the functioning of mosques and the opposition calling it targeting of Muslims and an attack on the Constitution.

According to the motion moved by Rijju, the Rajya Sabha has been asked to name 10 of its members to serve on the panel and communicate the same to the Lower House. The committee will submit its report to the Lok Sabha by the last day of the first week of the next session. The 21 members from the Lok Sabha included in the panel are Jagdambaika Pal, Nishikant Dubey, Tejansvi Surya, Aparajita Sanjay, Anshu Lal, Bilal Saikh, Abhikrit Gangopadhyay, D K Aruna (all BJP), Gaurav Gogoi, Imran Masood and Mohd Javed (all Congress), Maulana Mohibullah (SP), Kalyan Banerjee (TMC), A Raj (DMK), Lavu Sri Krishna Devarayana (TDP), Dileshwar Kamat (JDU), Arvind Samant (Shiv Sena-UBT), Baiya Mama Suresh Gopinath Phare (NCP-Shardhar), Naresh Bharti (Shiv Sena), Arun Dharti (Lok Janshakti Party-Ram Vilas) and Asaduddin Owaisi (AIMIM) (PTI)
