Seven sandalwood trees among 33 illegally felled inside BHU campus: DFO tells NGT

NEW DELHI, NOV 9 /--/ The divisional forest officer of Varanasi has informed the National Green Tribunal that seven sandalwood trees along with 26 other types of trees were "illegally" felled inside the Banaras Hindu University (BHU) campus. Forest department officials found that 161 trees were cut on the 1,300-acre campus while permission was granted for 135, the divisional forest officer (DFO) said in a reply dated October 31 that was uploaded on the NGT's website on Friday.

On July 31, while hearing a plea alleging unauthorised felling of trees at BHU, the NGT had sought a report from a joint committee comprising the

regional office of the Union Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, and the DFO.

"The university cut 26 other types of trees without permission from the forest department and this was brought to the notice of the inspector general, Lucknow regional office of the Union Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) through a letter dated October 15, 2024," the reply in Hindi said. It also "illegally" cut seven sandalwood trees, one of the most expensive species of trees, according to the reply. To compensate for the 135 trees that the university was permitted to cut, the authorities planted 1,630 plants, it said.

On the unauthorised felling of sandalwood trees, the reply said the forest department was not informed about it. "The BHU campus is surrounded by walls on all sides and the university administration has deployed security guards at all gates to monitor movement and CCTV cameras have also been installed. Despite this, the illegal cutting of trees, their illegal transportation or theft is suspicious," it said. The letter sent by the Varanasi forest conservator to the MoEFCC's regional office, which is annexed with the reply, gives further details about the felling of sandalwood trees.

The forest officials found evidence of illegal

neither has any information regarding this been given by the university administration to the forest department," the letter said. "Security guards are deployed 24 hours at the said place in the university and CCTV cameras are also installed and security arrangements have been made at every gate to prevent any material from being taken out. "Then this incident of theft is suspicious as the said sandalwood trees were cut and the entire wood disappeared overnight. No suitable effort was made by the university administration to catch the perpetrators and recover the precious wood," it said.

An FIR was lodged about the theft of "precious trees" on a complaint lodged by the university's assistant security officer at Varanasi's Lanka police station. However, the complaint did not make any mention of the sandalwood trees.

"In the said FIR, the type and price of the wood has not been recorded and

Ram temple completion delayed due to worker shortage, stone replacement: construction panel chief

AYODHYA, NOV 9 /--/ The Ram temple in Ayodhya, initially scheduled for completion by June 2025, will now likely be finished by September 2025, said Nripendra Mishra, chairman of the construction committee. Mishra cited a shortage of around 200 workers and the need to replace certain stones on the temple's first floor as primary reasons for the delay. "Currently, we are facing a labour

shortage, causing delays in construction," he said on Friday.

"The complete construction is now expected by September 2025 instead of June 2025," added Mishra, chairman of the Temple Construction Committee. He said while 8.5 lakh cubic feet of red 'Bansi Paharpur' stones have been readied for the temple boundary and delivered to Ayodhya but construction has slowed due to the reduced

workforce. In addition to the worker shortage, Mishra noted that some stones on the first floor appeared "weak and thin" and will be replaced with 'Makrana' stones to ensure durability.

A recent two-day meeting of the temple construction committee also reviewed the status of other structures associated with the temple, including the auditorium, boundary, and circumambulation path, all of which remain under construction. Mishra said that statues for the temple, including those for Lord Ram's court and six surrounding temples, are in production in Jaipur and are expected to arrive in Ayodhya by December.

"The sculptor has assured us that all statues will be completed by year-end," he stated, adding that final decisions regarding their placement within the temple complex will follow. Two statues of Ram Lalla, already accepted by the temple trust, are also set to be installed in prominent locations. Discussions continue on improving visitor flow, specifically addressing a smoother exit route for devotees after visiting the Janmabhoomi path. Mishra acknowledged the crowding issues and emphasised that these considerations are part of the planning process to enhance accessibility for visitors. (PTI)

Rahul Gandhi 'immature', Cong unlikely to progress under him, says Rijju

PUNE, NOV 9 /--/ Union Minister Kiren Rijju on Saturday said Congress leader Rahul Gandhi was "immature" and asserted no one can become a leader by running down India abroad. Addressing a press conference here, Rijju also said the Mahayuti, comprising the BJP, Chief Minister Eknath Shinde's Shiv Sena and Ajit Pawar-led NCP, will win the November 20 Maharashtra polls comfortably as the "fake narratives" of the Congress-led opposition will not work. Asked about Gandhi accusing the BJP of dividing people on caste and community lines, Rijju said it was the former who had been indulging in such acts all through his political career. "Now, he stands exposed. At a recent rally in Nagpur addressed by him, copies of the Constitution with inside pages blank were distributed. This has further exposed him," Rijju claimed. Gandhi often shows a copy of the Constitution while alleging that the BJP wants to change the Constitution and end reservations. "I respect him as he holds the constitutional post of leader

of opposition (in the Lok Sabha). However, from a political point of view, he demonstrates immaturity. The Congress has launched and relaunched him several times, but he still lacks maturity. One cannot become a leader by running down India abroad," the Union minister said.

Asked about whether Priyanka Gandhi taking the plunge by contesting the Wayanad bypoll in Kerala was a sign that she was being promoted at the expense of Rahul Gandhi, Rijju said, "With my experience in Parliament, I can say the Congress is unlikely to progress under his leadership." Water quality of Ganga in UP deteriorating due to discharge of sewage: NGT

NEW DELHI, NOV 9 /--/ The National Green Tribunal (NGT) has observed that the water quality in the Ganga in Uttar Pradesh is deteriorating because of the discharge of sewage or sullage into the river. Earlier, while considering the prevention and control of pollution in the Ganga, the green body sought compliance reports from various states, including Uttar Pradesh. In an order dated November 6, a bench of NGT Chairperson Justice Prakash Shrivastava said

according to the report from Uttar Pradesh, there was a gap of 128 million litres per day (MLD) in sewage treatment in Prayagraj district. Also, 25 untapped drains discharged untreated sewage into the Ganga in the district and 15 untapped drains discharged the sullage into the Yamuna, the bench, also comprising judicial member Justice Sudhir Agarwal and expert member A Senthil Vel, said. "We find that out of the 326 drains disclosed in the report of the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) dated October 22, 247 drains are untapped (in the state) and discharging 3,513.16 MLD of waste water into the river Ganga and its tributaries," the tribunal said.

Expressing dissatisfaction, it directed the state's chief secretary to file an affidavit disclosing the information regarding each drain across different districts, the sewage generated from those, the sewage treatment plants (STP) to which those were proposed to be connected and the timeline for making the STPs functional. "The affidavit will also disclose the short-term measures that will be adopted to prevent the discharge of untreated sewage in the river in respect of each of the districts and drain till STPs are made fully functional and 100 per cent household connectivity is achieved," the bench said.

It also took note of the CPCB report disclosing the status of 41 STPs across 16 Ganga-front towns, which said six plants are non-operational and of the 35 operational STPs, only one complied with the rules. "We also find that the water quality monitored at 41 locations clearly discloses that faecal coliform (FC) exceeds the most probable number (MPN) of 500/100 ml at 16 locations and is more than 2,500 MPN/100 ml at 17 locations.
