## 'Old trick of BJP': Akhilesh on rescheduling of assembly bypolls in UP

LUCKNOW, NOV 4 /--/ As the Election Commission on Monday rescheduled from November 13 to November 20 the assembly bypolls to all nine seats in Uttar Pradesh, Samajwadi Party chief Akhilesh Yadav alleged that this is an old trick of the BJP to avoid losing elections.

"First the Milkipur bye-election was postponed, now the date of bye-elections for the rest of the seats has been rescheduled. The BJP was never so weak," he said in a post in Hindi on X.

Yadav further said that if they (BJP) postpone it, they will lose even worse.

"The fact is that due to 'maha berozgari' (unemployment) in UP, people who go to different parts of the country for work have come to UP on Diwali and Chhath holidays. They were going to vote in the by-elections to defeat the BJP.

"As soon as the BJP understood this, it postponed the by-elections, so that people's holidays end and they go back without casting their vote," the former chief minister said, adding that this is BJP's old trick. The Election Commission rescheduled assembly bye-elections to all nine and four seats in Uttar Pradesh and Punjab, respectively, and one seat in Kerala from November 13 to November 20 in view of festivals. Parties including the Congress, BJP, BSP and RLD had urged the poll body to reschedule the polls in view of various festivals, saying that it could impact voter turnout. The BJP, BSP and RLD had said that in UP, people travel for three-four days ahead of Kartik Purnima, which will be celebrated on November 15.

When asked about the SP chief's allegations, state BJP spokesperson Manish Shukla said, "The bypoll date shift was demanded as the date coincided with Hindu festival. But Samajwadi Party has to do politics in everything. More so in this case as they are least bothered about majoritarian sentiment but about their vote bank." In UP, the nine assembly seats going to polls include Khatem (Ambedkar Nagar), Karhal (Mainpuri), Meerapur (Muzaffarnagar), Ghaziabad, Majhawan (Mirzapur), Sishamau (Kanpur City), Khair (Aligarh), Phulpur (Prayagraj) and Kundarki (Moradabad) (PTI)

## NSO organises awareness programme on surveys and statistics in Gangtok

GANGTOK, NOV 4 /--/ The National Statistics Office (NSO), Field Operation Division (FOD), Regional Office in Gangtok, organised an awareness programme on surveys conducted by NSO at the Government Senior Secondary School in Rumtek, Gangtok, Sikkim, today.

The programme aimed to educate students, teachers, and panchayat members about the various surveys conducted by the NSO and provide an overview of the Indian Statistical System.

D R Sharma, Assistant Director of NSO, welcomed participants and provided a brief overview of the Ministry's activities and the importance of NSO surveys. Tubai Dutta, Senior Statistical Officer, delivered a detailed presentation on



the Ministry's organisational structure, roles, and functions of different divisions, and the significance of data collection and large-scale surveys, such as PLFS, HCES, ASUSE, CPI, and TUS, being conducted by the Ministry.

The programme also covered career opportunities within the organization, including different categories of posts, recruitment modes, and required qualifications.

Participants' queries were addressed during an interactive session with the NSO team. Sonam Bhutia, Panchayat President of Sajong-Rumtek GPU, graced the event as the chief guest. C M Chettri, head of the school, expressed gratitude to NSO (FOD) for organizing the programme.

The event concluded with a vote of thanks from Smt. Tenzin Choden, Senior Statistical Officer. (PIB)

Mumbai was not supposed to travel several kilometres to the neighbouring Raigad district to play sports after returning from schools. The state government had also decided to shift the sports complex to Mangaon in Raigad district which was 115 kilometre away from the existing site. The bench had previously stressed on the preservation of the few remaining green lungs in cities like Mumbai and Navi Mumbai that were only witnessing a vertical growth. The land in Navi Mumbai was earmarked for the sports complex in 2003 and in 2016, but the planning authority had allotted a portion of it to a private developer for residential and commercial purposes. "It is a much-known practice. The government creeps into whatever green spaces are left and gives them to the builders," the top court had said during a brief hearing. (PTI)

## Need green spaces for kids: SC junks plea against order saying no transfer of sports complex land

NEW DELHI, NOV 4 /--/ The Supreme Court on Monday dismissed a plea of the City and Industrial Development Corporation (CIDCO), challenging a Bombay High Court order against the Maharashtra government's move to reallocate the land meant for a sports complex to private builders in Navi Mumbai. A bench comprising Chief Justice of India (CJI) D Y Chandrachud and Justices J B Pardiwala and Manoj Misra emphasised the importance of preserving green spaces in urban areas like Navi Mumbai. "We need some green spaces for our children, especially in cities like Mumbai," remarked the CJI while underscoring the diminishing availability of open areas amid urban sprawls. The CJI went on to add, "These are some of the few remaining green lungs left, and we must preserve them. Let's not say much about the CIDCO." Green areas had been given to builders for constructing malls and residential complexes, he pointed out. The CJI noted that the children of Navi

Mumbai was not supposed to travel several kilometres to the neighbouring Raigad district to play sports after returning from schools. The state government had also decided to shift the sports complex to Mangaon in Raigad district which was 115 kilometre away from the existing site. The bench had previously stressed on the preservation of the few remaining green lungs in cities like Mumbai and Navi Mumbai that were only witnessing a vertical growth. The land in Navi Mumbai was earmarked for the sports complex in 2003 and in 2016, but the planning authority had allotted a portion of it to a private developer for residential and commercial purposes. "It is a much-known practice. The government creeps into whatever green spaces are left and gives them to the builders," the top court had said during a brief hearing. (PTI)
