# Centre zeroes in on 12 spots for new industrial hubs along freight corridors

### Oppn-Governed States, Maha Part Of ₹12,000-Cr Plan

New Delhi: Gaya, Koparthy and Orvakal may have hogged the limelight due to the focus on packages for Bihar and Andhra Pradesh in the Budget, but others, including those in opposition-governed states, are part of Centre's latest push to create new industrial hubs. From Punjab and Haryana to Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Telangana and Maharashtra, govts have identified 12 locations for new industrial cities along freight and highway corridors, Rajesh Kumar Singh, secretary for industrial promotion and internal trade, told TOI. Govt has come under attack from opposition parties

for "favouring" Bihar and Andhra, with JDU and TDP as BJP's coalition partners and ignoring the interests of others—a charge that has been denied by finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman. "We will be seeking cabinet clearance for them soon. We are looking at an investment of Rs 10,000-Rs 12,000 crore for creating trunk infrastructure and will then of-

(Andhra), Tumakuru (Karnataka), Nangal Chaudhary (Haryana) and Greater Noida (Uttar Pradesh). Typically, these projects take 10-15 years to be fully developed, including allotment of land, but Singh said that in several new cases, things will move quickly as they are already around large cities. But from the initial phase when Dholera and Shendra Bidkin were sought to be developed as completely new cities, the newer projects are seen to be on a smaller scale, focusing on creating logistics hubs or industrial clusters. Some of the newer projects will be along the Amritsar-Kolkata industrial corridor, which is running woefully behind schedule given that land was not acquired by West Bengal govt. Singh also said that govt intends to correct the inverted duty structure for sectors such as leather and textiles and his department will take

up the issue with the revenue department, which handles the import duty. Inverted duty refers to the duty structure where finished products attract lower duty than inputs and raw material, creating complications for manufacturers. In the Budget, Sitharaman has made an attempt to revise some of the tariffs with inputs sought for further changes. Singh said industry consultations on the issue will be held soon. He also said that the abolition of angel tax will boost the startup ecosystem, by helping with funding, and also support foreign direct investment flows into the country. Department for industrial promotion and internal trade is also undertaking a review of the foreign direct investment (FDI) guidelines and procedures, and Singh said the idea is to ensure that the approvals, wherever required, come quickly.

# Panchaganga, Krishna flood threat fades as rainfall reduces

Kolhapur: Threat of severe flooding of Panchaganga and Krishna rivers, which would have inundated Kolhapur and Sangli districts, has faded to some extent. The intensity of rainfall in ghats and free catchment areas has reduced. Increased discharge from downstream Almatti dam has also helped. The dam on Krishna river in Karnataka is currently discharging water at the rate of 3.25 lakh cusec. As a result, levels in Panchaganga and Krishna rivers are declining rapidly. Panchaganga river level, which was recorded at 47.7 feet on Sunday morning, dropped 5 inches by Sunday evening at Rajaram barrage in Kolhapur city. Similarly, Krishna river level at Irwin bridge in Sangli city has come down below the warning level of 40 feet to 39.9 feet. Mahabaleshwar, which had received more than

# Kashmir schools suspend classes due to heatwave

Srinagar: Amid a persistent heatwave, the divisional administration of Kashmir on Sunday ordered the suspension of classes for students up to primary level in both govt and private schools on July 29 and 30. In an official order issued by the Divisional Commissioner Kashmir, V K Bidhuri, however, said that the teaching staff in those schools shall continue to attend to their duties. Bidhuri, in an order, said, "In view of the persistent heat wave prevailing in the valley, class-work for students up to the primary level in both govt and recognised private schools shall remain suspended on 29th and 30th July 2024." "However, all teaching and non-teaching staff shall continue to attend to their duties as usual," the official statement added. ANI

# 'As forest cover depletes, Andaman frogs use trash as breeding grounds'

New Delhi: Biologists have uncovered a remarkable and worrying shift in the breeding behaviour of Andamanese Charles Darwin's frog (Minervarya charles-darwini), a species endemic to the Andaman islands. Led by professor S D Biju of the University of Delhi and Harvard University, the research team documented a unique upside-down spawning behaviour in these frogs, alongside an alarming trend of using human trash as breeding sites. These findings, published in Harvard Museum of Comparative Zoology's journal Breviora, have significant implications with regard to conservation of this already-threatened species that is listed as 'vulnerable' in the IUCN Red List.

The study involved a team of scientists from University of Delhi, Zoological Survey of India, Harvard University and University of Minnesota. It revealed that these frogs are increasingly using artificial objects as breeding sites, such as plastic sapling bags, and human trash comprising discarded plastic, glass, and metal containers. This shift is likely to be a response to the loss and fragmentation of forest habitats, forcing the frogs to adapt to the rapidly changing environment on these small islands. Charles Darwin's frog stands out due to its distinctive reproductive habits. Unlike most frogs, which lay their eggs in water, this species deposits terrestrial eggs above water surface on inner walls of water-filled tree cavities or root buttresses. During mating, the pairs adopt upside-down posture, a unique trait among frogs, to lay eggs. This behaviour may have evolved as a strategy to prevent aggressive unpaired males from displacing mating pairs and disrupting egg-laying. "Upside-down spawning is the most remarkable behaviour in this frog. No other frog is known to lay terrestrial eggs inside tree holes in an upside-down position. This discovery is also fundamental for understanding how the species interacts with its environments and which habitats are essential for its survival," said Prof Biju. However, breeding in these unnatural sites poses risks to frogs' survival and development. The findings underscore need for conservation efforts focused on protecting the natural habitats of Charles Darwin's frog.

# AI gets notice as trainee pilot flies Riyadh flight without supervision

New Delhi: Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has sent a show-cause notice to Air India (AI) after a trainee pilot operated a Mumbai-Riyadh flight without supervision, reports Saurabh Sinha. AI didn't comment on the notice. The trainee pilot was scheduled to fly Mumbai-Riyadh flight on July 9 under the supervision of a training captain. However, the training captain fell ill, and rostering replaced him with a normal line (non-training) captain.

"En route, the two pilots realised this mix-up (which wasn't their fault) by the scheduling department. They filed a voluntary report with the base manager," a source said. DGCA had earlier de-registered the pilots pending an inquiry. Some AI officials have been called to DGCA office, said a source. AI sources admit there were a series of oversights.

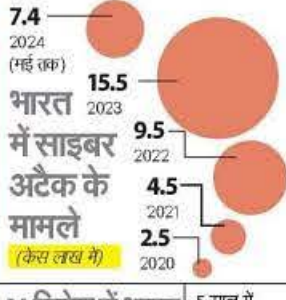
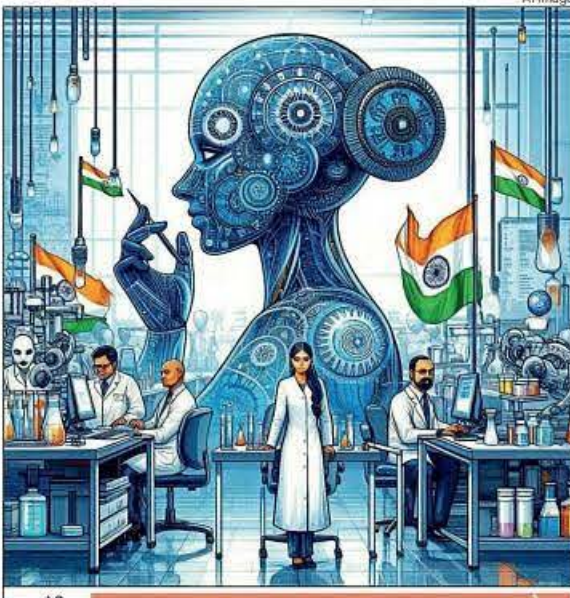
