Sub: Update on Litigation pursuant to Regulation 30 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“SEBI Listing Regulations”)

Dear Sir/Ma’am,

In furtherance of the disclosure dated February 24, 2025, we wish to update that the Hon’ble Supreme Court, vide its order dated February 28, 2025, has dismissed the Special Leave Petition (“SLP”) filed by the Company, while granting liberty to the Company to raise all contentions presented in the SLP before the assessing officer.

The SLP had challenged the judgment dated January 29, 2025, passed by the Hon’ble Delhi High Court in the Writ Petition, which contested the Notice dated May 1, 2020 and consequent proceedings initiated by the Income Tax Department for re-assessment under Section 148 of the Income Tax Act, 1961, for the Assessment Year 2008-09.

In compliance with the order passed by the Hon’ble Supreme Court, the Company will raise all relevant contentions before the appropriate forum.

You are requested to take the same on record.
