Sub: Disclosure under Regulation 30 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (“SEBI Listing Regulations”) by Bajaj Electricals Limited (“Company”)

Pursuant to the provisions of Regulation 30 (read with sub-paragraph 8 of Paragraph B and/or paragraph 20 of Paragraph A, Part A of Schedule III) of the SEBI Listing Regulations, and in accordance with the Company’s Policy on the Determination of Materiality for the Disclosure of Events or Information, we hereby inform you that the Company has received an order dated July 4, 2024 from the Office of the Deputy Commissioner of State Tax, Central Goods and Services Tax, Indore Division 2 (Indore-10), Indore Zone-I, Madhya Pradesh (“GST Authority”), issued under Section 73 of the Goods and Service Tax Act, 2017, involving an alleged penalty aggregating to Rs. 1.91 lakh, for alleged excess ITC claimed in FY 2019-20 in the state of Madhya Pradesh (“Order”).

The Company is currently exploring various legal options and necessary steps, including challenging the said Order issued by the GST Authority before the relevant appellate authority. Please note that there is no impact on financial operations or any other activities of the Company due to this Order.

We request you to take the above on record and treat the same as compliance under the applicable provisions of the SEBI Listing Regulations, if any.
