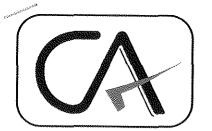

(b) Review of the Standalone financial results for the quarter ended March 31, 2024

We conducted our review of the standalone financial results for the quarter ended March 31, 2024 in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements ("SRE") 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the ICAI. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with SAs specified under section 143(10) of the Act and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Against this the company has approached the Hon'ble High Court at Mumbai, to rescind the appointment of arbitrator appointed by Naaptol and to seek appointment of independent arbitrator by the court. The management is confident that the entire amount is recoverable. However as a matter of prudence the company has decided to make a provision at 10 percent per annum beginning from F.Y. 2020-21. Accordingly the aggregate provision as on March 31, 2024 stands at 40 percent.

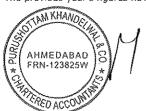

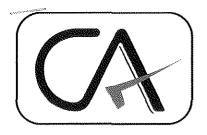

The Group's investment in the Chandanpani Enterprise (the "Associate"), an associate accounted for by the equity method, is carried at Rs. 218.23 Lacs on the consolidated balance sheet as at March 31, 2024, and the Company's share of the Associate's net profit of Rs. 4.48 Lacs is included in the Company's income for the year then ended. The Associate has an investment in a foreign entity which is carried at Rs. 201.60 Lacs in its accounts as at March 31, 2024. We were unable to obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence about the fair value of Associate's investment in the foreign entity as at March 31, 2024 because of unavailability of its financial information. Consequently, we were unable to determine whether any fair value adjustments to the carrying amount of the foreign entity were necessary.

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing ("SAs") specified under Section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act"). Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in Auditor's Responsibilities paragraph (a) of Auditor's Responsibilities section below.
