Sucralose safe to use in small doses, reveals study

Mumbai, Aug 7 (UNI) The first-ever study conducted in India on the effects of sucralose on cardio metabolic risk factors among adults with type 2 diabetes (T2D) has revealed that small quantities of sucralose in daily beverages like coffee and tea have no adverse effect on glycaemic markers like glucose or HbA1c levels. On the other hand, the study shows a slight improvement in body weight (BW), waist circumference (WC) and body mass index (BMI).

The study was conducted by Madras

Diabetes Research Foundation (MDRF) for diabetes and its complications, recently.

"This study becomes crucial as many people with diabetes in India continue to use added sugar in their coffee and tea, making the beverages a potential daily source of sugar intake. Further, India's overall carbohydrate consumption, particularly white rice or refined wheat, is very high. This adds to the risks of T2D," said senior Diabetologist Dr V Mohan, chairman of MDRF, who led the study, in a release here on Wednesday.

Man sexually exploits Mumbai college student, held

Mumbai, Aug 7 (UNI) : A man posing as representative of a modelling company was arrested for extorting Rs 45 lakh and sexually exploiting a 19-year-old Mumbai college student on the pretext of launching her in the glamour world, police said on Wednesday.

Rahul Chavan, 27, was arrested from Bandra on the student's complaint, police said.

His two associates are still on the run, police said. The victim, a resident of Bhandup, is currently pursuing a computer engineering degree at a prestigious city-based college, police said.

According to her statement to the Bhandup police, she was approached via Instagram by an individual named Hardik, who claimed he could help her build a career in modelling. Hardik said he was associated with a well-known company that represented many OTT platforms, police said. Later, he introduced her to his two associates who

sexually exploited the victim and extorted money, police said.

Take immediate steps to protect Hindus in Bangladesh: HJS

Kolhapur, Aug 7 (UNI) The right-wing Hindu Janajagruiti Samiti (HJS) on Wednesday urged Prime Minister Narendra Modi to take immediate steps to safeguard the Hindu community amidst escalating violence erupted over reservation issue in Bangladesh, which has now reached a high point and is likely to turn into anarchy.

In a press release here, Ramesh Shinde, national spokesperson of HJS, said that the anti-government movement has now started targeting Hindu people and temples there, and despite the Bangladesh army's assurance of giving protection to Hindus, there is fear among minority Hindu people.

He demanded that the Indian government, led by Modi, should ask the Bangladesh army to stop attacks on Hindus, looting of their houses, attacks on temples, and relocate them (Hindus) to safer places.

He also demanded that the government should raise this issue in the United Nations and request a UN delegation to visit violence affected Bangladesh. Raising an alarm over circulation of harrowing videos depicting atrocities against Hindus in Bangladesh on social media, the HJS warned that if the Indian government does not intervene promptly, Bangladesh risks slipping into a situation akin to Pakistan, with potential for a massacre of Hindus, Shinde added.

Murder charges framed against railway constable

Mumbai, Aug 6 (UNI): A Mumbai court on Wednesday framed murder charges against Railway Protection Force constable Chetan Singh Chaudhary who had shot dead four people – three passengers and his senior colleague – in the Jaipur-Mumbai train on July 31 last year.

Additional Sessions Judge N L More charged Chaudhary under Indian Penal Code sections 302 (murder), 153-A (promoting enmity between different groups on grounds of religion, race, place of birth, residence, language, etc) and others, and relevant provisions of the Railways Act and the Maharashtra Prevention of Defacement of Property Act.

At the start of proceedings, the accused pleaded "not guilty" and opted to face trial.

LoP Kharge raises the issue of dropping Preamble of NCERT books

New Delhi, Aug 7 (UNI) The Leader of Opposition (LoP) in Rajya Sabha and Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge on Wednesday raised the issue of dropping the Preamble of Constitution from some NCERT textbooks and sought clarification from the government on it.

He also slammed the government for changing the syllabus of school books.

"The Preamble of the Constitution used to be printed in NCERT textbooks which has been removed now. Preamble is the soul of our Constitution. It lays down the fundamental principles of the Constitution and democracy such as justice, liberty, quality and fraternity," he said.

The LoP also said that after its 'defeat' in Lok Sabha election, the BJP government first shifted the statues of Mahatma Gandhi and BR Ambedkar into a corner in Parliament complex and then attempts are being made to tamper with the provisions of the Constitution.

"We warn them that such changes are not acceptable to people. In order to impose their communal ideology, BJP and RSS are tampering with the syllabus of school books. The step taken by the NCERT in this regard is not correct. I demand from the government to present in detail in the House the changes made in the syllabus. We want a clarification on this," Kharge said.
