Maharashtra girl now becomes Gujarat's international hopes in MMA



MUMBAI: Even as India's performance in the international sports arena is slowly improving, a teenager now from Gujarat, who hails from the conservative and closely-knit Zalawadi Ghanchi Muslim community has emerged as India's hopes in Mixed Martial Arts, more popularly known as MMA. Fifteen-year-old Inaaya Multani, who has several national medals in her bag, is set to scale new heights internationally. "I want to show how girls can learn basics and be great in the art of self-defence," said Inaaya, as she arrives in Mumbai. "I really want to work in this arena. There is a lot that girls can do," she said, adding that she

intends to collaborate with government, civic bodies, schools and colleges and help out the girls. "Self-defence techniques not only help you in times of crisis but also boosts confidence and self-esteem," the young girl said. Inaaya hails from Mumbai, however, a few months back, the Multani family had migrated to Gujarat. "A fighter can be a winner, but that doesn't make a winner a fighter" - is what Inaaya believes. MMA is a full-contact combat sport based on striking, grappling and ground fighting, incorporating techniques from various combat sports from around the world. There is a lot of buzz in Mumbai, as over the weekend, Inaaya is going to be in Ghatkopar, for the Super Fight Champion competition. Inaaya won two gold medals last month in Thai kickboxing by split decision PML (Pro MMA League) Nationals in MMA with two dominant knockout wins. Inaaya is the first girl in India to play in a cage in Kolkata at a tender age of 9. She is now training under coach Alam Idrisi for Super fitness MMA.
