- 2 The Company has identified Films Distribution/Production as its only primary reportable segment in accordance with the requirements of Ind AS 108, 'Operating Segments'.

  Accordingly, no separate segment information has been provided.
- 3 The figures of the quarter ended 31st March, 2024 and 31st March, 2023 are balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published year to date figures upto the third quarter of the relevant financial year.
- 4 Pursuant to the Board approval on 28th October, 2023 and shareholder's approval on 29th November, 2023 through Postal Ballot, the Company has allotted 3,00,03,000 bonus shares of Rs 10/- each (ful paid up) on 11th December. 2023 to the eligible members of the Company whose names appear in the Register of Members of the Company /list of Beneficial Owners as on the Record Date i.e. 9th December, 2023 in the ratio of 6: 1 (six new equity shares for every one existing equity share). The said bonus shares shall rank pari passu in all respects with the existing equity shares of the Company, including dividend. As a result of the bonus issue, the paid-up capital of the Company has increased to Rs 35,00,35,000/-(Rupees Thirty Five Crores and Thirty Five Thousand only) from Rs 5,00,05,000/-(Rupees Five Crores and Five Thousand Only). Consequently, in accordance with Ind AS 33 'Earnings Per Share', the earnings per share (Basic and Diluted) have been adjusted for all periods presented.

- 7 Pursuant to the approval from Board of Directors dated 14th February, 2024 and members approval dated 14th March, 2024, the authorized share capital of the company has been increased to RS. 75.00 crores and issued 3,30,00,000 warrants (Equity Convertible Warrants) having face value of Rs. 10/- each.
- 8 Previous period's/year's figures have been regrouped/reclassified wherever necessary.
