Pursuant to Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, and in reference to the disclosure made by the Company on October 20, 2023, regarding the disallowance of transitional input tax credit of excise and service tax from the pre-GST era by the State Tax Officer, Taxpayer Services Circle, Thrikkakara, Ernakulam, Kerala, the Company provides the following update:

For the period July 2017 to March 2018, the officer had raised a demand of tax amounting to ₹2.61 lacs, along with interest of ₹2.61 lacs and a penalty of ₹0.26 lac, on the grounds that the dealer held Central Excise and Service Tax registration.

The Company has now received an order dated January 23, 2025, wherein the First Appellate Authority decided the appeal in the Company's favor. The demand order passed by the GST Officer has been annulled, as the adjudication was deemed unsustainable on procedural as well as legal grounds.

We request you to take this information on record.
