

# PM never went to Manipur which has been burning for years: Rahul

'Wherever Modi goes, he spreads hate. Even today the Prime Minister of India has not gone to Manipur which has been burning for one and a half years, it has never happened in India's history'

Leader of the Opposition in Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi launched a frontal attack on PM Narendra Modi while addressing an election rally at Nanded in Maharashtra on Thursday, accusing him of not visiting the violence-affected North Eastern state of Manipur for one and a half years.

"Wherever Modi goes, he spreads hate. Even today the Prime Minister of India has not gone to Manipur which has been burning for one and a half years. It has never happened in India's history. He makes one community fight the other but ensures that only some people make money. Adani's and Ambani's wealth is only increasing. Airports were given away, ports were given away



and now Dharavi's land which is worth Rs 1 lakh crore, is being given away. The loss is borne by soybean farmers, workers and unemployed youth. It is all happening right before your eyes," he charged.

He spoke about the need for a caste census and said, "We will conduct a caste census at the national level and at

the state level. I had asked the PM in Parliament, why is he not conducting a caste census? There is a 15 per cent Dalit population in India. Adivasis are 8 per cent of the population. OBCs are at least 50 per cent of the total population of India and then there are 15 per cent of minorities. But nobody knows what the population

of OBCs is in terms of actual numbers. We can estimate that OBCs are at least 50 per cent of the population, but in reality, nobody really knows the exact figure. That is why we need a caste census".

Earlier during the day, addressing an election rally at the Adivasi-dominated Nandurbar assembly constituency in the state, Rahul Gandhi said that "This election is a clash of ideologies". "Please remember that the real fight is to save the Constitution of India. That's because whatever you have received, whether it is land, forest, water, MNREGA, Right To Food and everything else, comes from the Constitution," he said.

"The INDIA alliance says that the country must be run according to the Constitution. Modi says, I wave the Constitu-

tution at public meetings. He says that the Constitution is hollow and that is because he has never read it in his life. He says that Rahul Gandhi waves a red colour Constitution.

We are not bothered about what is the colour of this book's cover page, but we are willing to defend whatever is written in the Constitution, with our lives" Gandhi said.

"We bowed before Birsa Munda's photograph today. Are the thoughts of Birsa Munda not there in this Constitution? Modi says that this Constitution is empty and hollow. Dear Modi, please listen, this Constitution is not hollow. This Constitution contains the thoughts of Birsa Munda, Phule, Dr Ambedkar and Mahatma Gandhi. So this Constitution is not hollow, but it is the very soul of India.

PM to interact with BJP workers in Maha on 16 Nov

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Thursday announced that he will interact with BJP workers in poll-bound Maharashtra during the 'Mera Booth-Sabse Majboot' programme on November 16.

In a post on X, PM Modi praised party workers for working hard to ensure a BJP victory in the Maharashtra Assembly polls.

"Our dedicated workers are working hard to ensure a landslide victory for the BJP in the Maharashtra Assembly elections. Amidst this tireless hard work of the party workers, I am very excited to interact with them in the 'Mera Booth Sabse Majboot' programme on November 16 at 11:30 am," Modi said. Campaigning has intensified for the 288 assembly seats in Maharashtra with both the ruling Mahayati and the opposition Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) making efforts to woo the electorate.

The polls are scheduled for November 20 and counting will be held on November 23. Stepping up his attack on Congress in poll-bound Maharashtra, Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Tuesday alleged that the opposition party wants one caste to fight the other and urged people to stay united while emphasising the slogan "hum ek hain to safe hain". Addressing election rallies in Chirum, Solapur and Pune, PM Modi largely focused his attack on Congress, alleging that the party is "looting people" in Karnataka and the money is allegedly being used to fight polls.
