

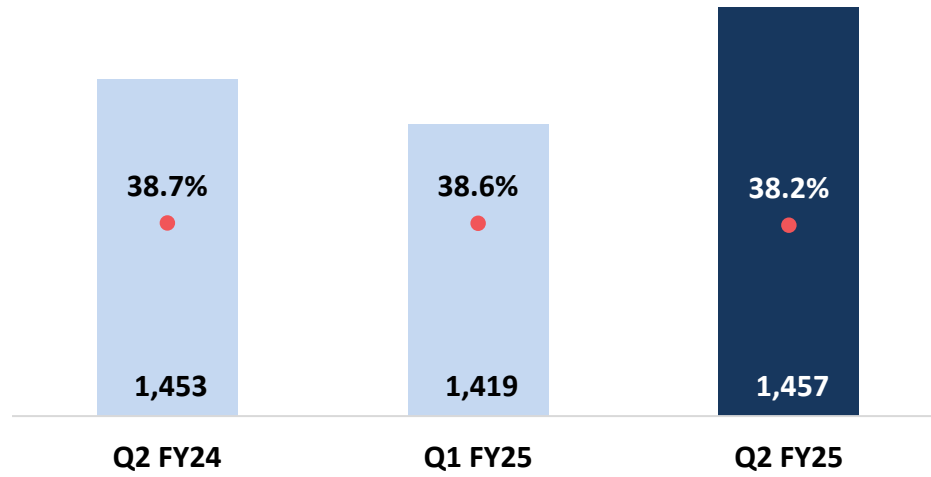

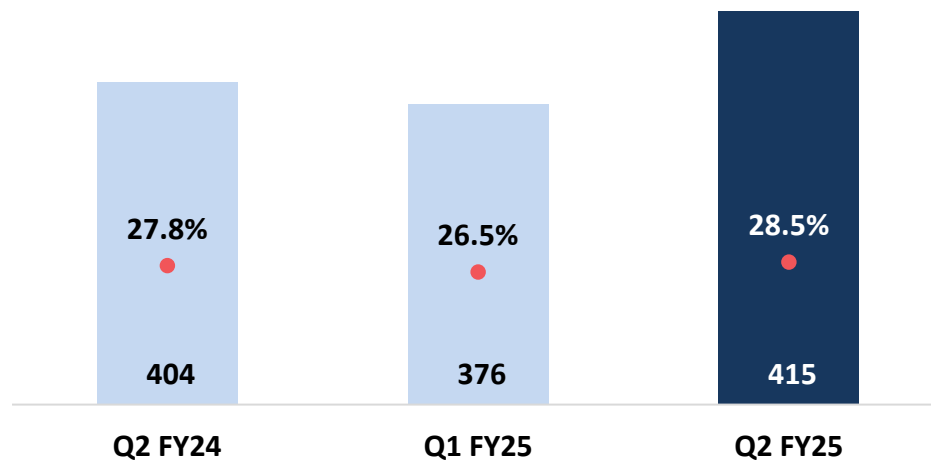
## Revenue from Operations and Gross Margin



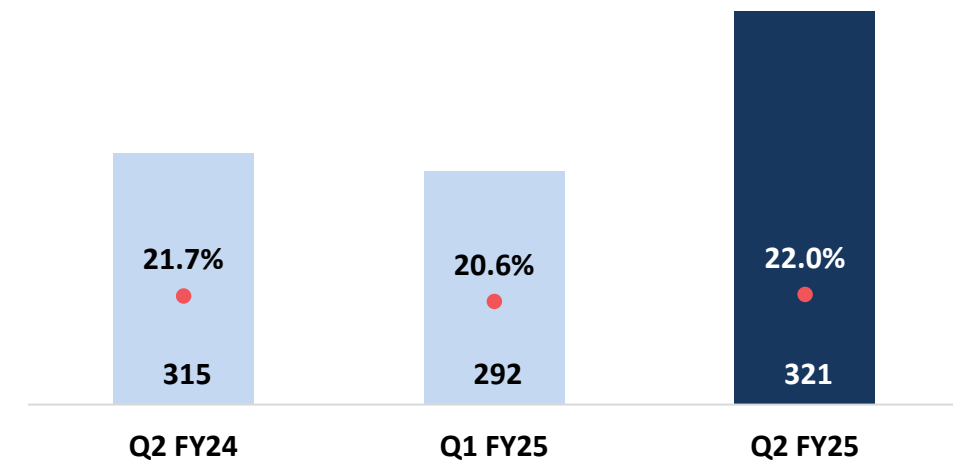
## EBITDA and EBITDA Margin
