'RAISI'S CHOPPER CRASHED DUE TO WEATHER'

THE HELICOPTER CRASH in which Iran's late President Ebrahim Raisi was killed was primarily caused by weather conditions that included thick fog, Iran's state TV said on Sunday, citing the final investigation report on the incident.

X GOES DARK IN BRAZIL AFTER TOP COURT RULING

ELON MUSK'S X started to go dark in Brazil at the order of the top court as Latin America's largest nation became the latest front in a global fight over the regulation of free speech on the internet.

PHILIPPINES NABS OVER 150 FOREIGNERS

PHILIPPINE AUTHORITIES ARRESTED more than 150 foreign nationals during a raid of an illegal online gaming hub on Saturday. Agents found dozens of people engaged in illegal activities on makeshift workstations inside a resort on the central island of Cebu, the immigration bureau said in a statement.

PAK CONFIRMS FOURTH CASE OF MPOX VIRUS

AUTHORITIES IN PAKISTAN on Sunday reported another case of monkeypox (mpox) virus amid the confusion about the total number of cases confirmed so far in the country. The fourth case was detected in Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa (KP) province where authorities confirmed three previous infections of the virus.

Killing of hostages puts Israel PM under severe pressure

ISRAEL RECOVERED THE bodies of six hostages who it said had been killed by their Hamas captors in Gaza, igniting recrimination against Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's decision to hold firm opposing concessions demanded by the Palestinian militant group for a potential cease-fire.

The six — including a maimed Israeli-US citizen, Hersh Goldberg-Polin, whose parents helped spearhead US solidarity campaigns for the hostages' return — were discovered on Saturday by troops searching a tunnel in the southern city of Rafah, the army said.

An Israeli official told Bloomberg their remains bore signs of execution by shooting. Izzat Al-Rishq, a member of the Hamas political bureau, said the hostages had been killed in an Israeli bombing.

The discovery stunned a public already dismayed at slow-moving efforts — shepherded by the US, Qatar and Egypt — to mediate a way to wind down the almost 11-month-old war between Israel and Hamas. Netanyahu canceled a planned appearance to open the new school year, as well as the regular weekly cabinet meeting.

Netanyahu made a rare public penance in a call to the parents of one of the slain hostages, saying he apologised that the state failed to save their son and the other five. His office said his military secretary had been in Moscow in an effort to secure Russian help with the hostages. "Those who murder hostages do not want a deal,"

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Netanyahu said in a statement. The slain hostages were mourned in the US, where President Joe Biden voiced outrage at Hamas and promised, in a statement, to keep "working around the clock for a deal to secure the release of the remaining hostages."

In Israel, much of the public fury was directed toward the prime minister, who on Friday won the support of his security cabinet for keeping Israeli troops in the key Gaza-Egyptian border area under any truce with Hamas. —BLOOMBERG

Ukraine launches mass drone attack against Russia

KYIV LAUNCHED ONE of the biggest drone attacks on Russia since the full-scale war began, targeting power plants and an oil refinery overnight, while Moscow's forces made further advances towards a key town in eastern Ukraine, officials said on Sunday. Ukraine also reported Russian shelling of areas near their shared border. A missile attack on a grain convoy killed a truck driver while another, on Ukraine's second largest city of Kharkiv in the northeast, injured at least 28, it said.

The fighting comes at a critical juncture in the two-and-a-half year conflict, with Russia pressing an offensive in eastern Ukraine while trying to expel Ukrainian forces that broke through its western border in a surprise incursion on August 6.

Russia last week pounded Ukraine with its heaviest air strikes of the war, hitting energy facilities, part of a campaign of drone and missile barrages that have killed thousands of civilians and troops since the conflict began in February 2022.

Ukraine, with a rapidly expanding domestic drone industry, has stepped up its own attacks on Russian energy, military and transport infrastructure.

It is also pressing the United States and other allies for permission to use more powerful Western-supplied weapons to inflict greater damage

inside Russia and impair Moscow's abilities to attack Ukraine.

Russian officials said air defence units had destroyed 158 drones launched by Ukraine overnight, and that debris caused fires at the Moscow Oil Refinery and at the Konakovo Power Station in the neighbouring Tver region. Temporary restrictions imposed on Moscow's Nnukovo, Domodedovo and Zhukovsky airports overnight were lifted on Sunday morning, according to aviation watchdog Rosaviatsia. Reuters could not independently verify the reports of drone attacks against Russia. —REUTERS

Korea exports extend gains to 11th month

SOUTH KOREA'S EXPORTS rose for an 11th straight month in August, but the pace of growth was weaker than the previous month and market expectations as demand for computer chips slowed, while auto sales remained sluggish. Overseas sales by

Asia's fourth-largest economy rose 11.4% year-on-year to \$57.90 billion, trade data showed on Sunday, slowing from a gain of 13.9% in the previous month, which was the fastest in six months. —REUTERS

UN begins polio vaccination in Gaza Strip

THE UNITED NATIONS, in collaboration with Palestinian health authorities, began vaccination of 640,000 children in the Gaza Strip on Sunday, with Israel and Hamas agreeing to brief pauses in their 11-month war to allow the campaign to go ahead.

The World Health Organisation (WHO) confirmed last month that a baby was partially paralysed by the type 2 polio virus, the first such case in the territory in 25 years.

The campaign began on Sunday in areas of central Gaza, and will move to other areas in coming days. Fighting will pause for at least eight hours on three consecutive days.

The WHO said the pauses will likely need to extend to a fourth day and the first round of vaccinations will take just under two weeks.

Children, escorted by members of their families, crowded a UN-run clinic in the central Gaza city of Deir Al-Balah, where

around one million people were sheltering, according to Palestinian officials. Medical staffers marked children who got the drops with a pen on their fingers.

"I came to the UNRWA clinic today to vaccinate my daughters against polio and God willing we won't see any more diseases other than the diseases we are already experiencing. I hope we will go back to our homes safe and sound," said Gaza mother Afnan Al-Muqaayad. —REUTERS
