Plea to declare local body staff as govt employees

ERODE JULY 20

Former Chief Minister Karunanidhi declared all local body employees as government staff in 1989. But, no GO has been issued for it yet.

Now, the Chief Minister M.K.Stalin, who is ruling well on the footsteps of his father, should take appropriate action and issue a GO to fulfill his father's promise, pleaded TN Federation of all corporation officials associations.

The Erode Federation Honorary President Vijayakumar, President Radhakrishnan, Secretary Somsandaram said: In the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly, the Finance Minister announced that the government is considering the way to restore old pension scheme instead of new pension scheme. This has caused great joy among all government employees and teachers. Sridhar Committee has

already conducted a study in this regard and submitted a report to the government. It should be considered and old pension scheme should be brought. Similarly, GO 152 was issued by the present government. Accordingly, 35,000 posts in all corporations and municipalities were reduced to 3,000.

It announced that the remaining posts will be filled through outsourcing system. This situation should be changed and posts should be provided as they already are on permanent basis. Earlier, the Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu announced that the GO 152 will be withheld.

Therefore, the vacancies are to be filled on permanent employees instead of outsourcing system which could create many problems to staff and 15,240 posts be restored.

The Government of Tamil Nadu has created four

new Municipal Corporations now.

Accordingly, the number of Corporations rose to 25. At present the administration of the Corporation comes under the Director of Municipal Administration.

Now, as the number of Corporations has increased, a separate Directorate for Corporation Administration should be set up. By doing this, the administration will become more efficient.

Already, employees used to surrender about 15 days of Earn Leave and get the money every year. During the Corona period, the government canceled this EL surrender facility citing financial crisis.

Now the financial crisis and the corona problem are over. Therefore, the EL surrender should be restored. It will enable the staff to use the money for their children's education every year, they said.

Samajwadi Party leaders seek bigger pie in seat-sharing for Maharashtra polls

MUMBAI, JULY 20 (PTI)

The constituents of the Opposition's MVA alliance in Maharashtra, including the Shiv Sena (UBT), NCP (SP) and Congress, are also part of the larger, national-level

UP gov forms State Capital Region on lines of NCR

LUCKNOW, JULY 20 (PTI)

The Uttar Pradesh government Friday notified the formation of the State Capital Region' (SCR) on the lines of the National Capital Region (NCR).

Governor Anandiben Patel also approved the establishment of Uttar Pradesh State Capital Region Development Authority (UP-SCRDA).

The Housing and Urban Planning Department issued the notification following their approval to the proposals.

The notification said the newly formed Uttar Pradesh State Capital Region includes Lucknow and the adjoining districts of Hardoi, Sitapur, Unnao, Rae Bareilly and Barabanki.

According to the notification, a total area of 27,826 square kilometres will be included in the SCR.

The UP-SCRDA will oversee the implementation of development projects and ensure effective management of resources within the newly defined area.

It will be constituted

under the chairmanship of the chief minister.

The chief secretary of the state will be its vice-chairman and Additional Chief Secretary Housing and Urban Planning, Divisional Commissioners of Lucknow and Ayodhya, District Magistrates of all the concerned districts, Vice-Chairmen of Lucknow, Unnao-Shuklaganj and Rae Bareilly Development Authorities and many other officers will be members.

Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath had initiated this

project in September 2022.

"People from different cities want to come here and make their permanent residence.

The population pressure is also increasing in the surrounding districts and many a times complaints of unplanned development are also received.

In such a situation, keeping in view the future requirements, 'Uttar Pradesh State Capital Region' should be formed on the lines of National Capital Region (NCR)," he had said.

"We are becoming partners now. Today, the foundation of the INDIA alliance rests on the Samajwadi Party. If (party chief) Akhilesh Yadav j says something, no INDIA leader can refuse. Captain Thapa, who died fighting terrorists in J-K, cremated at ancestral village in Darjeeling

Captain Brijesh Thapa, who was killed while fighting terrorists in Jammu and Kashmir's Doda, was cremated with full military honours at his ancestral village in West Bengal's Darjeeling district.

Slogans of 'Brijesh Thapa Amar Rahe' reverberated in the air as a large number of

people gathered to pay their respects to the mortal remains of the officer on Friday.

Colonel Bhuvanesh K Thapa (Ret'd) recalled that his son, a third-generation Army officer, wanted to join the force since his childhood.

"I feel proud of my son. He did his duty," the retired Army officer told reporters.

Captain Thapa's mortal

remains had reached his ancestral home at Jing Tea Estate in Lebong on Thursday.

Politicians, cutting across party lines, and senior government and military officials were present during the cremation.

In a post on X, the Indian Army's Trishakti Corps said, "The valiant officer made the supreme sacrifice on 15th July 2024 while bravely fighting

terrorists in Doda. Various Army and Civil dignitaries have paid their respects to the brave officer. Indian Army ensured full military honours to the departed soul. Four army personnel, including the captain, died after being injured in a gunfight with heavily armed terrorists in Doda. Captain Thapa was 27 years old and had joined the Army five years back.

World Heritage Committee meeting: NDMC keeps 75 pump on standby to battle waterlogging

NEW DELHI, JULY 20 (PTI)

The New Delhi Municipal Council has installed CCTV cameras at 20 new locations to monitor waterlogging and procured 75 portable pumps to drain excess water in case there's heavy rainfall during the World Heritage Committee meet here, a civic body member said on Friday.

The WHC meet will be held here in the national capital from July 21 to 31.

"We have six control rooms that will be monitoring the situation while 175 personnel will be on ground. Apart from these, the central Command and Control Room will also keep an eye on the situation," NDMC Vice Chairman Satish Upadhyay said.

"There are 120 fixed pumps and 75 portable pumps in place to manage water accumulation," he said.

Forty eight temporary staff operators are on standby for any emergent waterlogging situations, the NDMC vice chairman added.

On June 28, Delhi recorded a record 228 mm of rainfall



leading to waterlogging in many posh areas of NDMC, such as Bharti Nagar, Golf Links and Satya Marg.

Upadhyay said CCTV cameras have been installed at Satya Sadan, Lodhi Estate, Africa Avenue underpass, Panchkuian Road, Raisina Road, Nyay Marg, Bharti Nagar and Zakir Hussain Marg.

He said a special beautification drive has been carried out at Khan Market, Connaught Place, and Janpath.

He is hosting a special dinner for delegates on July 25 at the Qutub Institutional area, he added.

Upadhyay said Sardar Patel Marg has been adorned with potted plants and floral decorations. The NDMC's Horticulture Department has supplied approximately 50,000 ornamental plants and flowers. Eight Floral Boards featuring the World Heritage Committee logo will be displayed, he said.

"Special preparations from Sardar Patel Marg to

Bharat Mandapam include potted plants, flags, and lights. The Horticulture Department has replaced plants damaged by heat or waterlogging," he added.

All roads in the NDMC area have been repaired and cleared of disruptions caused by heavy rain and all 52 roundabouts in the NDMC area have been beautified, Upadhyay said.

Connaught Place will be illuminated with special lights and trees along Sardar Patel Marg will feature up-lights and hanging lights, he said, adding that colourful flags will also be displayed along this route.

Eleven digital boards in Connaught Place will showcase rare and historic photographs of the area, in collaboration with the New Delhi Traders Association (NDTA), he said.

In collaboration with the Ministry of Culture, NDMC is installing wall art and sculptures as part of the city's beautification, Upadhyay said.

The WHC session will be at the Bharat Mandapam, which was also the venue for the G20 Summit.

Bahraini: 15 arrested for 'disturbing peace' on day of Muharram

BAHRAIC (UP), JULY 20 (PTI)

The Uttar Pradesh Police has arrested 15 people here in connection with three cases related to taking out religious processions through prohibited areas on Muharram, brandishing sharp-edged weapons and disturbing communal peace, an officer said.

"On Wednesday, which was the

day of Muharram, it was reported that some people carrying tazia attacked a group that prevented them from passing through a field in Payapur police station area," Superintendent of Police Vrinda Shukla said on Friday.

An FIR was lodged in the matter and police arrested 11 men on Friday, he said. Another FIR was lodged Wednesday

night in the Nanpara Police Station area against some people who tried to take out a religious procession through a prohibited area. Shukla said three people were arrested in the case on Friday. Another FIR was lodged in connection with some people openly brandishing sharp-edged swords, and police arrested one person, Abu Talib, on Friday in the case.

AI relief aircraft leaves for San Francisco with passengers of flight diverted to Russia

MUMBAI, JULY 20 (PTI)

An Air India relief aircraft for passengers of its Delhi-San Francisco flight stranded at Russia's Krasnoyarsk Airport has now departed from there for the US, city, the airline has said.

"The flight AI 1179 departed Krasnoyarsk (KJA) at 00:02 hours local time (20 July) for San Francisco (SFO), carrying all passengers and crew of AI183 that was diverted to Krasnoyarsk," Air India said in a statement.

The airline had to divert its Delhi-San Francisco flight with 225 passengers and 19 crew members to the Russian city on Thursday after the cockpit crew detected a potential issue in the cargo hold area of the Boeing 777 aircraft.

The relief flight with an Air India team, including crew and security personnel,



took off from the Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport here at 12:52 pm for the Russian city of Krasnoyarsk.

The ferry flight also carried on board essentials in addition to sufficient food for all passengers.

The airline said it has mobilised additional on-ground support at SFO to carry out the clearance formalities for all passengers upon arrival.

The team at SFO are prepared to provide all necessary assistance to

officials, for the assistance to the passengers and to Embassy's team in the coordination work throughout the emergency situation," the Indian Embassy in Moscow said in a post on X.

The Embassy had earlier on Friday announced that an Embassy team of three senior officials and interpreters were on ground in Krasnoyarsk to assist the passengers of Air India flight to San Francisco which made an "emergency" landing at Krasnoyarsk last night.

"The team is coordinating with airport and security authorities and representatives of the Russian Foreign Ministry to provide all possible assistance to the passengers. The team will stay on ground in Krasnoyarsk till Air India's replacement plane arrives and takes the passengers on their onward journey," the Embassy had said in its post.

Heavy rains lash Nagpur, school holiday declared; red alert for Chandrapur



NAGPUR, JULY 20 (PTI)

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) on Saturday predicted heavy rainfall, with the possibility of extremely heavy showers at isolated places in Nagpur and other districts of Vidarbha region over the next two days and advised people not to step out of homes unless necessary.

It issued a red alert for Chandrapur, and an orange alert for Nagpur, Amravati and Wardha districts for Saturday, Nagpur, the second capital of Maharashtra, has been witnessing heavy showers since Friday. The observatory at the Nagpur airport recorded 90.6 mm rainfall in the 24-hour period ending 8.30 am on Saturday,

officials said. In view of the downpour, the Nagpur district collector declared a holiday for all schools and colleges in the city and rural area on Saturday, they said.

Incessant rains led to waterlogging in several areas of Nagpur city. Two bridges in rural parts of the district got submerged, they added.

IMD's Regional Meteorological Centre (RMC) in Nagpur also issued a moderate flash flood warning over few "watersheds" (catchment areas and reservoirs) and neighbourhoods in Amravati, Bhandara, Chandrapur, Gadchiroli, Gondia and Nagpur districts that is valid for the next few

hours. The RMC predicted thunderstorm, lightning and heavy to heavy rainfall with isolated extremely heavy rainfall in next 24 to 48 hours in Nagpur, Bhandara, Chandrapur, Wardha, Gadchiroli, Gondia, Yavatmal districts of Vidarbha, and advised people to stay indoors.

It also issued a red alert for Chandrapur and an orange alert for Nagpur, Amravati and Wardha.

A red alert indicates heavy to extremely heavy rain of over 20 cm in 24 hours, while an orange alert means very heavy rain (6 cm to 20 cm). A red alert requires authorities to "take action" in view of an extreme weather event, while an orange alert signifies a preparedness advisory for authorities due to the potential for severe weather conditions.

In Gadchiroli district, eight roads were shut due to flooding, including the Allapali-Bharmaged stretch of a national highway, the officials said.
