COMPLAINT | Alleged negligence led to complainant's granddaughter developing quadriplegic cerebral palsy

Probe into negligence at Motherhood Hospital

Acting over a complaint of medical negligence, Chief Medical and Health Officer (CMHO) Dr BS Saitya has constituted a three-member panel plan to investigate allegations of medical negligence against Dr Neeraj Parank and the staff of Motherhood Hospital. The probe was initiated following a complaint filed by Dr S Garg, retired Principal of Government Medical College, alleging that negligence during treatment

led to his granddaughter developing quadriplegic cerebral palsy, a condition for which there is no curative treatment. Dr Garg had submitted the complaint with the collector during Jansuwa and also with the police. The complainant alleged that doctor and her team at Motherhood Hospital failed to provide appropriate care, resulting in irreversible harm to the child. Additionally, Dr Garg has accused the hospital of fabricating medical documents. Police has sent a letter to the CMHO to get the matter

investigated and in response, Dr Saitya has directed the three-member committee comprising Dr Virendra Rajgir, Dr Tarun Gupta, and Dr Rupali Joshi to conduct a thorough investigation into the alleged negligence and review all related medical documentation. The committee has been asked to submit a detailed report, along with its findings, to the CMHO within seven days. Meanwhile, the committee had called Dr Garg for recording his statements while the hospital is yet to submit the documents over the same.

We have constituted the committee and will take appropriate action over the same. We will also submit the report to the police, and to the district administration.

IMC, traffic police join forces against roadside parking



10 trucks and numerous other vehicles seized

With a view to ease traffic congestion, Indore Municipal Corporation (IMC) and Traffic Police have launched a joint drive to remove vehicles parked on the roadside and near dividers in key areas of the city. The crackdown on Wednesday mainly focused on the stretch between Janjiwala Square and Malwa Mill Square. IMC's removal gang and personnel from the Traffic Police seized over 10 trucks, 4 four-wheelers and numerous two-wheelers, while 25 to 30 cars were issued challans for illegal parking.

The move comes as part of an on-going effort to address traffic disruptions caused by improper parking on roadsides, particularly near dividers, which has been a growing concern for commuters, said municipal commissioner Sushil Kumar Verma. According to removal gang incharge Lata Agarwal, the parking of both two-wheelers and four-wheelers in these areas was severely hindering the smooth flow of traffic, leading to frequent jams. "These vehicles were creating obstructions on major routes and it was imperative to take action to resolve the issue," she said. The authorities have said that such actions will continue across various city roads focusing on areas where roadside parking is creating traffic bottlenecks.

ADG Sagar chairs review meeting for redressal of complaints received on CM Helpline

A review meeting for the complaints received on the CM Helpline portal was called by ADG (complaints department of PHQ) DC Sagar in the city on Wednesday. The officer has given certain directives to the officers of the Indore police and instructed them to take quick and satisfactory action on the complaints at the primary level so the complainants need not seek help of senior officers. Commissioner of police Santosh Kumar Singh, Additional CP (Law and order) Amit Singh, DCPs of all zones and all police stations in-charges were present in the meeting. ADG Sagar discussed the resolution of pending complaints of CM Helpline and directed that on priority basis, complaints of people's problems should be resolved satisfactorily at level-1 and level-2 special emphasis should be given to resolve complaints related to kidnapping of minor children and women. He informed all station-in-charges that the police station is a primary unit. If prompt action is taken here to the satisfaction of the complainants, then the number of complaints at the senior level will automatically reduce. He informed everyone that just as you are doing better work in other areas of policing, in the same way, take special interest in resolving these complaints and try to give your best.

Factory sealed for groundwater contamination

A factory was sealed and fined for polluting groundwater following a joint inspection by Indore Municipal Corporation and Madhya Pradesh Pollution Control Board (MPPCB). The factory, which is located in Khatpura Agarwal Compound, was found to be illegally discharging hazardous chemicals into the water supply causing environmental damage. The inspection team comprising MPPCB scientist RM Gaud along with key municipal staff including Zone 5 sub-engineer Mayank Panwar discovered that the factory had been discharging hydrochloric acid into an unregulated pit behind the facility. Upon inspection, it was also discovered that the factory was operating without a valid municipal licence or the required business licence. The



officials noted that there were no proper disposal mechanisms for the hazardous chemical waste, a violation of both environmental and public health regulations. A legal sample of the contaminated groundwater was collected by the MPPCB team, confirming the harmful effects of the pollution. In response, officials imposed a spot fine of Rs 10000 on the factory and took immediate steps to seal the premises. Factory owner Sagar Singh Basse was present during the proceedings.
