



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'Govt may either frame new Direct Taxes Code or revamp existing one'

STREAMLINING EXERCISE. Rationalisation of capital gains tax not a revenue-raising measure, but a simplification exercise, says Revenue Secretary

The Centre is yet to take a call on whether a new Direct Taxes Code should be framed or the existing income tax law will be revamped, Sanjay Malhotra, Revenue Secretary, said.

"Whether it will be a completely new Code or whether existing Income Tax Act will be revised. Both the options are open. Purpose will be to make the law simple to read," Malhotra said at a post-Budget conference, organised by industry body Assocham in the Capital.

REVIEW EXERCISE

The review exercise would also involve consultations with stakeholders, he added.

In her Budget speech, Finance Nirmala Sitharaman had said the government would undertake a comprehensive review of the Income Tax Act to make it easy to read. "The purpose is to make the Act concise, lucid,

easy to read and understand. This will reduce disputes and litigation, thereby providing tax certainty to the taxpayers. It will also bring down the demand embroiled in litigation. It is proposed to be completed in six months," Sitharaman said.

Meanwhile, Malhotra on Friday also asserted that the latest rationalisation of capital gains tax in the Budget should not be seen as a "revenue augmentation" effort, but be viewed as a simplification exercise.

"All of you (industry) had asked for simplification of capital gains tax regime. So the Budget has delivered on it. Simplification does not mean that tax rates will come down. Please appreciate that government needs revenues. Let's be prepared that some rates will go up and some will come down. Simplicity has its own virtues," Malhotra

REMOVING AMBIGUITIES Malhotra also said the proposed insertion of Section

11A in Central GST Act is aimed at removing ambiguities and must be invoked only in exceptional cases and not resorted to as the norm.

Based on the recommendations of the 53rd GST Council Meeting, the Centre had, in the Budget, introduced this section to grant the government the power to regularise instances of non-levy or short-levy of GST due to prevailing general trade practices

Ravi Agrawal, Chairman, Central Board of Direct Taxes, (CBDT), said, "The provisions introduced in the Budget relating to direct taxes can be broadly categorised into simplification, standardisation and compliance. The purpose of tax administration is not penalty and prosecution but to provide comfort to the taxpayers.

"We are one of the leading nations to provide the facil-ity of pre-filled forms and compliance has improved because of that. Last year, we saw about 8.5 crore income tax returns, which is a significant increase. Also, about 72 lakh updated returns were filed indicating the enhanced ease in compliance."

Sanjay Kumar Agarwal, Chairman of Central Board of Indirect Taxes & Customs (CBIC), said the Budget proposals on the Customs front would enhance the competitiveness of domestic industry. He also expressed confidence that the Goods and Services Tax (GST) collection target for 2024-25 would be comfortably met going by the collection trend in the first quarter this fiscal.

'Industry must do some advocacy with States on GST concerns'

The Finance Ministry on Friday urged industry to do some advocacy with the States to help resolve their concerns around multiple assessments and audits under the Goods and Services Tax (GST) framework.

On its part, the Revenue Department would also talk to States to see how industry concerns could be addressed on this front, a top Finance Ministry official said.

Although GST has been touted as a 'One Nation One Tax', the ground reality for corporates with pan-India operations is that they are subjected to assessments and audits of 30 different States (depending on place of business activity), complicating their compliance efforts.

"On GST, we have in recent years taken a big leap. But still with 30 States, there are 30 taxes. So You (industry) now have multiple registrations and assessments at each State because there are 30

"Now how do we reduce from 30 to one. Like it bothers you, it bothers us also, we need a collaborative approach with all

the States. "My request to you (industry) is you also do some advocacy and talk to stakeholders in various States. We will also do that,"SanjayMalhotra, Revenue Secretary, said at a Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) organised post-Budget interactive session with Finance Ministry in the

Malhotra was responding to a question from Cavinkare's top official, who pointed out that Companies with pan India operations have still to go through assessments and audits in different States under GST system. It was submitted that if there can be a centralised assessment or audit, this could help industry in its compliance much more efficiently.

Malhotra made it clear that no short term or immediate solution can be arrived at on this front. "This will happen over a period of time. We need to keep speaking about it and working on it. It is a difficult task," Malhotra added.

BUDGET FOCUS

Malhotra said that the primary focus of the Union Budget has been on the taxpayers. The Budget tax proposals have been framed to promote rationalisation, simplification,

compliance burden, and ease of paying taxes, he added.

He said that the Government values interactions with the industry before, during, and after the budget-making process and will ensure that the trust placed by taxpayers is duly acknowledged by the government, by way of a consultative and collaborative policymaking process.

PARTNERING INDUSTRY

Malhotra also said that government was willing to partner and collaborate with industry for the proposed comprehensive review of Income Tax Act 1961

"We see industry as partners. We have an approach of collaboration and not confrontation. We will move forward together to make India strongand continue to collaborate with you on proposed review of Income Tax Act and take all your suggestions," Malhotra

He was responding to CII Director General Chandrajit Banerjee's submission that CII would like to work on providing comprehensive inputs to the government during the consultation process.

DGFT simplifies EPCG scheme to make compliance easier

The Directorate General of Foreign Trade has announced changes for simplification of the Export Promotion Capital Goods (EPCG) scheme making it easier for exporters to comply with regulations and reducing the time and effort required to meet requirements, per the government.

The scheme, which allows import of capital goods for pre-production, production and post-production at zero customs duty against an obligation to export, will now provide exporters an extended period to submit installation certificates for imported



capital goods, reducing pressure on businesses to meet timelines.

Additionally, a simplified and reduced composition fee structure for extending the export obligation period has been introduced to minimise manual intervention, streamline compliance and speed up service delivery, according to a statement issued by the Commerce Department on Friday.



Former first couple call up presumptive Democrat nominee

Atlanta: Former US President Barack Obama and former first lady Michelle Obama have endorsed Kamala Harris in her White House bid, giving the vice president the expected but still crucial backing of the nation's two most popular Democrats.

The endorsement, announced Friday in a video showing Harris accepting a joint phone call from the former first couple, comes as Harris builds momentum as their party's likely nominee after President Joe Biden's decision to end his re-election bid and endorse his second-in-command against Republican nominee and former President Donald Trump.

It also highlights the friendship and the historic link between the nation's first Black president and the first woman, first Black woman and first person of Asian descent to serve as vice president, who now aims to break those bar-

riers at the presidential rank. "We called to say Michelle and I couldn't be prouder to endorse you and do everything we can to get you through this election and into the Oval Office," the former president told Harris, who was seen taking the call as she walked backstage at an event. The statement is set for release as finance ministers and central bankers from the Group of 20 major economies wrap up their second day of meetings in Brazil, which has used its presidency to focus on reducing econo-

mic inequalities. Last month, the World Bank forecast that the global economy would avoid a third consecutive decline in

mic levels through 2026. "We are encouraged by the increasing likelihood of a soft landing of the global economy, although multiple challenges remain," the draft, to be formally adopted later on Friday said. "Downside risks include wars

and escalating conflicts." By avoiding explicit mention of the wars in Ukraine and Gaza, diplomats have worked to sidestep the disagreements between Russia and major Western nations that derailed a consensus at the finance chiefs' February meeting. To defuse the disagreement, Brazil drafted a chair statement on geopolitical issues, stressing that these matters will be addressed by G20 leaders in November: Reuters

Paris: France's high-speed rail network was hit Friday with widespread and "criminal" acts of vandalism including arson attacks, paralysing travel to Paris from across the rest of the country and Europe, and thwarting Olympic athletes from travel, only hours before the grand opening ceremony of the Games.

French officials condemned the attacks as "criminal actions." but said there was no sign of a direct link to the Games. Prosecutors in Paris opened a national investigation saying the crimes could carry sentences of 10 to 20 years.


