### TN Deputy CM criticises Modi Govt

Thiruvananthapuram, Feb 6 (UNI) : Tamil Nadu Deputy Chief Minister Udhayanidhi Stalin alleged that India has not progressed in any aspect under the rule of the Narendra Modi Government at the Centre. Speaking at the Mathrubumi Literary Festival on Thursday, he said Modi's decision to implement demonetization — without any consultation with the states — crippled the Indian economy, and, affected every single citizen. Similarly, his implementation of GST, without considering the voices of states in the GST Council has severely impacted industries and businesses across the country, he added. "Another critical subject, under the 'Union List' is the Census. A majority of the political parties, across the country, are demanding that the Union government should — conduct a caste-based Census. However, the Union government has done nothing on this front. I have just highlighted, some of the key subjects,

under the 'Union List', where the Modi government, and BJP Government have failed miserably." "In Tamil Nadu, the Governor's office, instead of being a symbol of unity, has become a tool of political overreach." "Now, the Union government is attempting to take control of state universities, through the new UGC draft guidelines." "This draft proposes, empowering Governors to appoint the search committee for selecting the state and the Union, but as a roadblock to the functioning of the elected state governments." "In Tamil Nadu, we have a Governor who has sat on bills for months passed by the legislature, he has delayed crucial decisions, and, act in ways, that defy the mandate of the people." "In response, the TN Chief Minister has passed a resolution against the UGC draft guidelines in the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly." ### 'Solar Cell making facility significant milestone in RE journey'

"We look forward to continuing our contribution to Tamil Nadu's economic growth and India's clean energy transition", he added.

### SC questions TN Governor's delay in giving assent to Bills

New Delhi, Feb 6 (UNI) : The Supreme Court on Thursday questioned the prolonged delay by the Tamil Nadu Governor in granting assent to bills passed by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly. The court noted that the Governor withheld assent for several bills after sitting on them for over three years and referred some to the President. A bench comprising Justice JB Pardiwala and Justice R Mahadevan sought clarification from Attorney General (AG) R Venkataramani regarding the Governor's prolonged inaction. "What is so gross in the bills that the Governor took three years to identify?" Justice Pardiwala asked.

The bench highlighted that two bills were referred to the President only after the assembly re-enacted them. AG Venkataramani clarified that the Governor did not return the bills for reconsideration but merely declared that he was withholding assent. Justice Pardiwala criticized this approach, stating it undermines Article 200 of the Constitution. "He says, 'I withhold assent but will not ask for reconsideration.' That frustrates the proviso of Article 200. The Governor seems to have adopted his procedure," Justice Pardiwala remarked. The court demanded factual justification for the Governor's decision, asking for original files or documents to understand the basis for withholding assent. The bench emphasized that a mere statement of repugnance was insufficient. Justice Pardiwala noted that the Governor's decision came just three days after the Supreme Court's ruling in the Punjab Governor case, which held that Governors cannot veto legislative bills by inaction. The bench observed that Tamil Nadu's government alleged both malice-in-law and malice-in-fact.

### Stalin holds road show, meet DMK functionaries, visits IruTTu Shop in Tirunelveli

Chennai, Feb 6 (UNI) : On a two-day official ground level review visit to the southern Tirunelveli district, Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M K Stalin held a road show, interacted with the public, took selfies with them, met DMK party functionaries and also inspected the world famous halwa shop 'IruTTu Kadai' (Dark shop) and purchased a packet of halwa on Thursday night. Upon arrival at Tirunelveli by road after landing at Thoothukudi airport from Chennai, Mr Stalin held a road show, interacted with the people, who have lined up on both sides of the roads to greet him, received petitions and took selfies. Later, after inaugurating a Solar Power manufacturing plant and laying the foundation stone for another unit, Mr Stalin attended an official function. In the night, after meeting the DMK district secretaries and functionaries to review the preparations for the 2026 Assembly elections, which the ruling DMK is eyeing to win by a more than 200 of the 234 seats and discussing the strategy, the Chief Minister took time off to visit the 'IruTTu Kadai' halwa shop.

After inspecting the shop and hearing about how the halwa was being prepared with the staffs and the sales, Mr Stalin, in a show of simplicity, partook halwa with them and also made a purchase of a halwa packet. The staffs of the shop were extremely surprised about the Chief Minister's visit and expressed happiness for him taking his time off from busy schedule to visit the shop. Upon hearing about the CM's visit, a large number of people gathered in front of the shop to greet Mr Stalin. Earlier, Mr Stalin participated in a function in which he distributed various welfare measures for the beneficiaries, launched completed projects, laid stones for new projects.

### Destruction of Sheikh Mujibur Rahman's historic residence should be strongly condemned: India

New Delhi, Feb 6 (UNI) India today termed as regrettable the destruction of the historic residence of Bangladesh's founder Sheikh Mujibur Rahman in Dhaka by protesters, and said the house was a symbol of the heroic resistance of the people of Bangladesh "against the forces of occupation and oppression". Ministry of External Affairs spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said: "It is regrettable that the historic residence of Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, a symbol of the heroic resistance of the people of Bangladesh against the forces of occupation and oppression, was destroyed on February 5, 2025. "All those who value the freedom struggle that nurtured Bangla identity and pride are aware of the importance of this residence for the national consciousness of Bangladesh. "This act of vandalism should be strongly condemned." India had played an active and prominent role in the creation of Bangladesh, erstwhile East Pakistan, in 1971. The spokesperson's statement came as more than half of Sheikh Mujibur Rahman's house in Dhaka's Dhanmondi-3 Road No. 32 was demolished by demonstrators, in a demolition drive dubbed the 'Bulldozer March'. Ex-PM Sheikh Hasina's residence Sudha Sadan was also set on fire on Dhanmondi Road No. 5. Outside Dhaka, homes of Hasina's relatives and Awami League leaders, as well as various sculptors, were vandalised in Khulna, Jashore, Kushtia, Barishal, and Sylhet. The developments came as Bangladesh marked six months since the fall of the Hasina government and she went into exile in India amid mass protests.

### Three TN government school teachers arrested for sexual assault on 8th std student

Chennai, Feb 6 (UNI) : In a shocking incident, three teachers of a government school at Burgur in Krishnagiri district of Tamil Nadu were arrested and later suspended for sexually assaulting an eighth standard girl student and impregnating her. The incident, though happened a month ago, came to light on Wednesday evening, leading to the arrest of the school teachers working in Panchayat Union Middle school. After recording the statement of the victim in-camera on Thursday evening, a Judicial Magistrate Court remanded the trio in to judicial custody, based on her statement and on the basis of the hospital report after the girl was subjected to medical examination. The incident came to light after the School authorities went to the house of the 13-year-old girl student, who did not attend the school for the last one month. Her parents told them that she was recuperating after aborting her pregnancy borne out of the sexual assault on her by the three teachers inside the school campus. Acting on a complaint, police arrested the teachers under POCSO Act and the victim was sent to Krishnagiri government hospital medical examination after her parents aborted her pregnancy. They were later placed under suspension by the District Education authorities after the issue sparked a major row with the leaders of various Opposition parties, including the AIADMK and BJP, strongly condemning it, and massive protests by the girl's family members and locals demanding stringent action against the culprits. They later dispersed after police said the three teachers were arrested and suspended and that stringent action as per law would be taken against them. According to the School Education Department, the three accused teachers were named in the complaint lodged by the school headmistress and the block education officer, A. Muniraj, Chief Education Officer (in-charge). When some of the teachers visited her house to find out the reason for her prolonged absence, the girl told them that she suffered from ulcers, and would return to the school soon after treatment. However, suspecting something amiss, the school authorities visited the girl again when she narrated the alleged sexual assault by three teachers in a toilet on the school campus, according to Mr. Muniraj. Though the teachers had stoutly denied the charge, they were arrested and placed under suspension after a preliminary inquiry.
