- Economic headwinds continued to impact our industry in the US during the quarter
- We are optimistic about FY 25 being a promising year for our quartz business, with improvements already being seen on the demand front, driven by our strategic initiatives. Capex update (Quartz Business)

- Kreos from Breton of Italy is a new-generation mixture extrusion and distribution system designed to produce full-body, ultra-thin, and uniquely innovative aesthetic slabs. This line is expected to be commercialized during Q2 of FY25
- CHROMIA from Breton of Italy is designed for decorating engineered stone slabs with high-definition digital printing. This technology allows for printing precise, intricate patterns and vibrant colors, enhancing the aesthetic appeal and customizability of slabs. This line is expected to be commercialized during Q4 of FY25






