Good deed comes around

A woman officer, holding an important position, is at the end of her tenure in office. Now, she is following the maxim – good deed comes around – so she is doing good to everyone. Madam has decided to close such inquiries against some officers as are being conducted for minor faults. She has already closed the files related to the inquiry against two IAS officers who were feeling distraught. Both the directly recruited officers were upset about the probe. The Chief Minister also put his seal on madam's decision. There was a minor fault in comparison to the big financial irregularities committed in government offices. Because of the inquiry, they were not getting promotion. Madam also opened the gate to their elevation to the next position. The officers, upset about the inquiry for a long time, are relaxed because of Madam's positive attitude. Now, a few officers have also become active to get their cases settled.

No hope!

An officer, junior to an additional chief secretary (ACS)-rank officer, is looking pessimistic after the latter's posting to the Chief Minister's Secretariat. The officer was making efforts to become the Chief Secretary through his high-profile clout. The Sahib tried to hit the target with help of a person considered very influential across the country. Nevertheless, after the posting of the ACS in the CM's Secretariat, it has been decided that someone junior to him will not be the CS. There is no doubt that the ACS will be the next CS. Now that the chances of his becoming the CS are dim, he is trying to get posting to the CM's Secretariat in lieu of the ACS. The head of the state also likes the officer. This is the reason why he has begun to use his clout to hit the jackpot. Nonetheless, it may not be easy for him to reach the target in the present circumstances.

Advance payment

A bureaucrat is highly apprehensive about the yet-to-come transfer list of IAS officers. His ache for collectorship of a district is such that every evening he wants to know from his colleagues whether the transfer list has been released. There are reports that the officer has given a huge amount of dough to an influential person for his posting. The person has told the officer that whenever the transfer list is out, he will be posted as collector. Yet he fears lest the person should deceive him. This is the reason why he wants to see whether the list consists of his name. The previous government removed the officer from a district, because there were complaints against him for his alleged involvement in some irregularities. Through his links with some influential people, he had tried to get posting to a district, but his efforts came to naught. After the formation of the new government, he is again

trying to get a posting of his choice.

The much-discussed post

There are discussions in the corridors of power about an important position. The names of many are doing the rounds for transfer to this post. The officer assigned with the job right now has no problem if he has to continue with the position or has to go to some other place. As he is close to the Chief Minister, he knows any decision will be taken only with his consent. The names of five officers are doing the rounds for the post, but what is important is that four of these five officers had been collectors of Bhopal. The name of another officer is also doing the rounds for the post. His name has been forwarded from the Chief Minister's home district. This IAS officer has many important departments. As his name is doing the rounds for that important position, many people have congratulated him. He has wooed most of the senior officers in the state bureaucracy. Despite this, people in the corridors of power say nothing can be said until an order is issued.

Reluctant officer

A department, despite being important, is treated as a loop line. A Principal Secretary posted there is reluctantly working. An important person in the state is reportedly unhappy with the officer's style of working. Rather than disposing of the files, the PS writes 'Charcha' (discussion) on those folders and returns them. He has no fixed time to come to the office. When the important person is away from the state capital, he attends the office – though for a while. A complaint about the officer's behaviour has been sent to the important person. The officer was gathering lots of carrots in the department where he had been posted. As the Sahib is not able to make sweetener in the present place of posting, he is gnashing his teeth. There are whispers in the corridors of power that the anger of this important person may take the Sahib to a worse department than he is in these days.

Eye on Delhi

A woman officer, whose efforts to go to Delhi on deputation have fallen through, again wants to go to the national capital. The woman officer is not at all keen on working in the state. Once she was assigned with many important jobs. But time has changed. Now, she has only a small department. Since the new government has been formed, madam is again chewing over shifting to Delhi where she has to opt for a position below her seniority. Despite this, she has stuck to her guns to shifting to Delhi. Before the assembly election, there were discussions that both madam and her husband would go to Delhi, but as they did not get a position in the Central Government, they had to stay back in the state. After the formation of the government in the state, her relationship with others has curdled. Against this backdrop, she wants to go to the Centre to get rid of the mess she is in.

HOLY COW | MP Anti-Cow Slaughtering Act imposed

NSA invoked against 2 over recovery of beef in Morena

The stringent National Security Act (NSA) has been invoked against two persons arrested after the recovery of beef from a village in Morena district, police said on Sunday.

Following a complaint of cow slaughter, the police on Friday night seized beef and cow hide from a house at the Bengali colony in Noorabad village of the district, police said.

SDOP Adarsh Shukla told reporters that a villager, Anil Gurjar, complained that he saw some people slaughtering a cow and when he opposed it, he was attacked by them on Friday evening.

Gurjar, who managed to escape from the attackers, lodged a police complaint, he said. The police later seized two sacks of bones and beef, besides the cow skin, from the house of the accused, SDOP said.



The police have registered a case against nine persons under the MP Anti-Cow Slaughtering Act, Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act and Indian Penal Code provisions for rioting, assaulting and intimidation, Shukla said.

Four persons, including two women, were arrested on Friday, the official said, adding a minor was also detained. After the incident, workers of several right wing organisations staged protests and blocked roads.

Stern action against those involved in slaughter, says CM

In the wake of rage over the cow slaughter incident in Seoni, Chief Minister Mohan Yadav emphasised on the state's commitment to upholding law and order, particularly concerning cow protection laws. "All districts have received clear instructions regarding the enforcement of these laws. Any individual found guilty of violating the cow slaughter prohibition will face stringent penalties. We are also supervising the enforcement actions at the state level," he said.

State level monitoring of strict action against the accused is being done, Yadav said while interacting with

media here on Sunday.

The chief minister highlighted that more than 550 cases (related to law prohibiting cow slaughter) have been registered within a month, resulting in the saving of over 7,000 cows.

"We have taken action against hundreds involved in such activities, and our efforts will continue unabated," said Yadav. Speaking on the Seoni incident, the chief minister said that a team headed by an ADG-level officer has been sent there and strict action will be taken on their recommendation. In Seoni district, carcasses of more than 40 cows were discovered in a river and a forested area. The police have arrested five individuals.

Shyam Darshan Yatra flagged off

Ujjain: MP Anil Firojia flagged off the Shri Shyam Darshan Yatra by the Shyampremi family of the Khatushyam Temple, located near Shri Uttaramukhi Hanuman Temple on Ankapat Road. For the past two years, this religious procession has travelled to Ujjain via Khatu Shyam, Salasar, Sanwariya Seth and Pashupatinath in Rajasthan.

Ujjain: Senior basketball coach of Ujjain District Basketball Association, Vijay Ball, was felicitated for his successful sports management during the summer vacations at Government Kalidas Girls College Ground.

MLA lays foundation stone for road works

Only last phase of Bhopal, Indore Metro projects remaining: CM

Chief Minister Mohan Yadav said the last phase of the Bhopal and Indore Metro project is remaining and shortly metro train runs will start at the two cities.

The chief minister was speaking to media persons at the BJP office. Earlier, he garlanded the statue of Dr Shyama Prasad Mukerjee on his death anniversary on Sunday. Prime Minister Narendra

Modi has launched a new version of Vande Bharat train with double speed and it would run on the existing tracks, said Yadav. Traffic arrangements could be ensured by rope way, cable car and other mode of transport in areas where the metro train running is not feasible, said the chief minister. "On many such subjects, we have done a joint meeting. In the first phase, we are mainly working in five cities including Bhopal, Indore, Ujjain, Gwalior and Jabalpur," the CM said. Talking about receiving the feasibility report of the metro train between Indore and Ujjain, the chief minister said that a decision has been taken to take this project in hand before Simhashtha. Madhya Pradesh will be made number one by using modern technologies. Earlier, Yadav paid tribute to remembered Dr Mukerjee saying because of his farsightedness he could anticipate the pre-and the post independence tragedies.

3 dead as bike ploughs into tomb at Kamla Park road

Three men on a bike ploughed into a tomb located on Kamla Park road on Sunday morning, following which two of them died on the spot, the police said. The police added that the third man riding pillion on the bike died on way to the hospital.

Shyamala Hills police station TI Ramvilas Vimal said that the identities of the victims have not been ascertained yet. He added that the incident occurred at around 2

pm on Sunday, at the Kamla Park road. The witnesses to the incident told police that the motorcycle was being driven rashly.

After the motorcycle dashed against the tomb, all three fell on the ground and started bleeding profusely. Two of them had died on the spot. The on-lookers took all three to a hospital where all three were declared dead. The police have taken charge of the bodies, sent them for post mortem. Police are trying to establish the identifies of the victims.

Two SUVs collide on Airport Road, one dies

An SUV going at high speed rammed into a jeep from the rear on Airport Road of the city late on Saturday night, the police said. The jeep turned turtle, and one of its occupants died, police added. The man who died in the incident has been identified as Ashfaq Mustafa (35), a contractor. He was on his way to a restaurant with five of his friends. Their jeep was parked on the Airport road, when a SUV hit it from the rear. The jeep overturned following the collision, and Ashfaq was trapped under it leading to his death. His other friends have sustained injuries, and are undergoing treatment. The errant SUV driver which rammed into the jeep fled from the spot, leaving the vehicle behind. Gandhinagar police said that they have seized the vehicle, and are searching for the accused car driver.

Disabled girl raped

Pithampur (Mhow): A 35-year-old man was arrested and sent to jail for raping a 14-year-old disabled girl from Dalit community in Mangrol village under Sagaur police station area of Pithampur. As per the police, the incident happened when the minor went to defecate. The girl belongs to the Dalit community and is mentally disabled while the accused man, who is from the same village, lives in the neighbourhood. Sagaur police station in-charge Prashant Pal said that accused Gokul, son of Govind was arrested and presented in the court from where he was sent to jail.

MPPSC exam: Candidates find it moderately difficult

Madhya Pradesh Public Service Commission's (MPPSC) State Service Preliminary Examination 2024 was conducted on Sunday in two shifts.

The first paper, General Studies, was held in morning shift, and the second paper of General Aptitude Test was held in the second shift. This exam is being conducted for 110 posts. A total of 1.8 lakh candidates had applied for it



and more than 1.5 lakh candidates took the exam.

The students who took the first paper of General Studies told Free Press that the paper was moderately difficult. About 30% to 40% of the questions were related to Madhya Pradesh. Utkarsh Tiwari, 23,

attempting the exam for the first time, described both papers easy, with the CSAT being moderate. He said that overall, the papers were manageable, and he expected the cutoff to rise due to the easy exam. Saurabh Pandey, 26, attempting the exam for the second time, said papers were moderately difficult. Aman Dubey, in his fourth attempt, found both sets of papers to be moderately difficult. He found the questions on politics relatively easy.
