मंदिर के कलश चोरी

इंदौर। द्वाकपुरी इलाके में एक मंदिर दे रात चोरी हो गई। फरियादी ने क्षेत्र में ही रहने वाले तीन लड़कों पर शक जताई है, वह देर रात मंदिर के आसपास घूम रहे थे। द्वाकपुरी थाने में फरियादी मागीरय सिंसोदिया निवासी दिग्विजय मल्टी की शिकायत पर चोरी का मुकदमा दर्ज किया गया है। जी ब्लॉक के सामने मल्टी में एक हनुमान मंदिर बना हुआ है, वहीं की छत के पीलल के कलश अज्ञात बदमाश बीती रात चुरा ले गए। कलश की कीमत लगभग 10 हजार है। फरियादी ने पुलिस को बताया कि उन्हें गांधीपुर, किशोर और मयूर पर चोरी की शक है। उनका कहना था कि देर रात तीनों मंदिर के आसपास घूमते हुए नजर आए थे। पुलिस मामले की जांच कर रही है।

टैकर रिर्वर्स लेते समय आठो से टकराया

इंदौर। खजुराना थाना क्षेत्र के पटेल नगर में पानी विफलित करने गए निगम का टैकर वालक रिर्वर्स ले रहा था, तभी आठो से टकराया गया। पुलिस को फरियादी लक्ष्मी पिता बाबूलाल खैरवार निवासी विजय नगर में शिकायत दर्ज करवाई कि टैकर रिर्वर्स करते समय आठो से टकराया गया। इस पर अननदीप सिंह निवासी पटेल नगर ने विवाद कर मारपीट की।

कार मांगी और अन्य को सौंप दी

इंदौर। विजय नगर पुलिस को हरीश पिता रमेशचंद्र एमवार निवासी नेहरू नगर में शिकायत दर्ज करवाई कि इशान पिता वसीम अहमद खान निवासी विशाखा पड़नम और उडस सुबोधन पिता वीरू गौड़ निवासी अहमदाबाद निजी उपरोध हेतु फरियादी से दो दिन के लिए कार लेकर गए थे। घटना दो माह पहले हुई। बदमाशों ने दो दिन के लिए कार मांगी और वापस नहीं लौटाई। फरियादी ने पुलिस को बताया कि कार किसी अन्य को सौंप दी। फरियादी ने मरोसा कर आईडी कार्ड लेकर कार दी थी।

दहेज के लिए सताया, मारपीट कर घर से निकाला

इंदौर। महिला थाना पुलिस ने एक युवक और उसके परिवार वालों के खिलाफ दहेज प्रताड़ना का मुकदमा दर्ज किया है। आरोपी की पत्नी ने आरोप लगाया है कि उससे दहेज में आठो रिश्ता और 10 लाख रुपए की मांग की जा रही है, महिला थाने में मागीरयपुरा निवासी एक युवती की शिकायत पर उसके पिता सौरभ गौड़ और सास किरण गौड़ सहित ससुरा राधा कृष्ण गौड़ के खिलाफ मुकदमा दर्ज किया गया है। पीड़िता ने पुलिस को बताया कि शादी को 2 साल बीत गए हैं, आरोपी पति और सास ससुरा लगातार दहेज में 10 लाख रुपए की मांग को लेकर उसे परेशान कर रहे थे। पति आठो भी चाह रहा था। इन्होंने उसे कई बार मारा पीटा जब उनकी मांग पूरी नहीं हुई तो मारपीट कर घर से निकाल दिया।

4 लाख की ब्राउन शुगर के साथ पकड़ा 3 तस्कर

इंदौर। क्राइम ब्रांच ने ऑपरेशन प्रहार के तहत तीन तस्करों को पकड़ा है और उनके पास से 4 लाख की ब्राउन शुगर जब्त हुई है। एडीसीपी क्राइम ब्रांच राजेश डोटीरिया के अनुसार मुखबिर से मिली सूचना के आधार पर चंदन नगर क्षेत्र से कुंदन पिता सेवामय सिंसोदिया निवासी ऋषि पैलेस द्वाकपुरी, जय पिता अशोक चौहान निवासी एमआईजी और रवि पिता अंतरसिंह निवासी विनयादव गांधीनगर को पकड़ा है। तीनों एक मोटर साइकिल पर सवार थे। तलाशी में उनके पास 40 ग्राम ब्राउन शुगर मिली है। ब्राउन शुगर की अंतरराष्ट्रीय बाजार में कीमत 4 लाख है। आरोपी महंगे शौक रखते हैं इसलिए तस्करों का धंधा कर रहे थे।

पूर्व सरपंच के यहां जमकर हुआ बवाल

इंदौर। बेटमा इलाके में पूर्व सरपंच के यहां मान के कार्यक्रम में जमकर बवाल हुआ। मेहमानों ने एक दूसरे पर हथियार निकाल लिए, तीन लोगों के खिलाफ पुलिस ने मुकदमा दर्ज किया है। बेटमा पुलिस के अनुसार मान दोलाताबाद में पूर्व सरपंच केलाश रहते हैं। उन्हीं के यहां मान का कार्यक्रम था, सायल दीपक पिता सुमेर सिंह परिहार ने पुलिस को बताया कि आरोपियों के नाम मोहन सिंह, सुमेर और प्रेम सिंह हैं। फरियादी के अनुसार मान कार्यक्रम में उसने मेरु महाराज को पैसा चढ़ाया, इसी बात को लेकर आरोपी नाराज हो गए और उसे अपा शब्द कहे लगे। फरियादी ने गालियां देने से मना किया तो आरोपियों ने हथियार निकाल लिए और उस पर हमला कर दिया। बताया जा रहा है आरोपी और फरियादी करीबी रिश्तेदार ही हैं।

इंदौर। सदर बाजार थाना क्षेत्र के हरदोल लाल मंदिर के समीप से पुलिस ने पिट्ट उर्फ ब्रजेश निवासी मराठी मोहल्ला को पकड़ा। उपनिरीक्षक जयेंद्र दत्त शर्मा ने सट्टा खेल रहे पिट्ट से मोबाइल कार्ड भी जब्त किए।

10वीं फेल को पास कराने के लिए बैटाए 'मुन्नाभाई'

नकाब हटाते ही सामने आ गई छात्रा की सच्चाई, छात्र भी पकड़ाया, पुलिस ने पांच लोगों पर दर्ज किया प्रकरण

इंदौर। एमपी बोर्ड 10वीं की 'रुक जाना नहीं योजना' के एक्जाम के दौरान छात्र-छात्रा की जगह दूसरे स्टूडेंट से परीक्षा दिलाने का मामला सामने आया है। पुलिस ने शुक्रवार देर रात पांच लोगों पर केस दर्ज कर लिया। इसमें एक नाबालिग छात्रा, एक नाबालिग छात्र के अलावा प्राइवेट स्कूल की एक टीचर समेत पांच लोग हैं। घटना शारदा कन्या हायर सेकेंडरी स्कूल बड़ा गणपति क्षेत्र की है।
माध्यमिक शिक्षा मंडल 10वीं-12वीं में फेल हो चुके छात्र-छात्राओं को पास होने के लिए एक अतिरिक्त मौका रुक जाना नहीं योजना के तहत देता है। इसी के एक्जाम चल रही है। शुक्रवार को 10वीं विज्ञान का पेपर था। परीक्षा केंद्र शारदा कन्या में गर्मी की वजह से एक छात्रा ने अपना नकाब हटाया। तभी पर्यवेक्षक (पेपर कराने वाले टीचर)

को शक हुआ। इस पर साइन कराने और फोटो मिलाने के बहाने फर्जीबांडा सामने आ गया। एक अन्य छात्र ने मास्क लगा रखा था, वो भी पकड़ा गया।
स्कूल प्राचार्य सीमा जैन शिकायत पर पुलिस ने खजुराना की प्राइवेट महिला टीचर जैन, उसका पति मुस्तफा शेख, एक्जाम देने आए नाबालिग छात्र का भाई जुनेद खान, दूसरे की जगह परीक्षा देने बैठी नाबालिग छात्रा और नाबालिग छात्र पर केस दर्ज किया गया है। जिस प्राइवेट टीचर को मुख्य आरोपी बनाया है, वह खजुराना क्षेत्र में प्राइवेट स्कूल में पढ़ाती है।
पुलिस ने बताया पांचों आरोपियों द्वारा षडयंत्रपूर्वक एक्जाम फॉर्म भरने वाले स्टूडेंट की जगह दूसरे लड़के-लड़कियों से परीक्षा दिलवाकर नियमों का उल्लंघन किया गया। धोखाधड़ी, षडयंत्र और मध्य प्रदेश मान्यता प्राप्त परीक्षा अधिनियम 1937 का

केस दर्ज किया है।
ऐसे बेनकाब हुए फर्जी स्टूडेंट
माध्यमिक शिक्षा मंडल की 10वीं-12वीं की परीक्षा में फेल हुए स्टूडेंट्स के लिए 'रुक जाना नहीं योजना' में 20 मई से परीक्षा आयोजित की जा रही थी। शुक्रवार को परीक्षा केंद्र शारदा कन्या उमावि में 10वीं में फेल हुए स्टूडेंट्स का विज्ञान का पेपर था। परीक्षा दोपहर 2 से शाम 5 बजे तक चली। इसी दौरान फर्जी परीक्षार्थी पकड़े गए। यहां पता चला कि एक छात्रा नकाब और एक छात्र मास्क लगाकर एक्जाम दे रहा है। इस बीच गर्मी लगने पर उस छात्रा ने नकाब हटाकर पसीना पोंछने की कोशिश की तो चेहरा देखकर पर्यवेक्षक को शक हुआ। उसने फोटो से छात्रा का मिलान किया। फिर

साइन करवाकर दोबारा तस्दीक की तो कन्फर्म हो गया कि ये फर्जी छात्रा है। लेकिन हंगामा न हो इसलिए बीच एक्जाम में छात्रा को रोक नहीं और उसे एक्जाम देने दी गई। इसी तरह एक अन्य छात्र ने भी मास्क हटाया तो वह भी इसी तरह ट्रेस हो गया। एक्जाम के बाद शुक्रवार शाम को प्रिंसिपल ने मल्हारगंज थाने पहुंच रिपोर्ट दर्ज करवा दी है। इसमें टीचिंग स्टाफ समेत 5 लोग शामिल हैं।
पूछताछ में छात्रा ने बताया नैडम-सर के नाम
जब एक्जाम के लिए अटेंडेंस होती है तो स्टूडेंट्स की साइन कराते हैं। जब पहली छात्रा पर शक हो गया तो अटेंडेंस के बहाने उसकी साइन ली गई। तब फोटो से मिलान किया तो पता चला कि ये वो छात्रा नहीं है,

जिसने फार्म भरा है। पूछताछ में छात्रा ने बताया कि उसे सर और मैडम लेकर आए हैं। इसी तरह मास्क लगाकर एक्जाम देने वाला छात्र भी पकड़ा गया है। बच्चों को एक्जाम दिलाने लाने वाले सर-मैडम और एक अन्य साथी सहित 5 लोगों पर केस दर्ज करवाया है। ये कौन लोग है जो इस तरह एक्जाम दिलावा रहे थे, हमें नहीं पता।
जिले में एक्जाम के लिए बनाए 20 सेंटर
एक जाना नहीं योजना के तहत 20 मई से एक्जाम शुरू हुई है जो 6-7 जून तक चलेगी। हमारा सिर्फ 10वीं का सेंटर है और यहां एक्जाम 30 मई को संपन्न हो जाएगा। बाकी जगह चलती रहेगी। हमने फर्जीबांडे के मामले में विविध कार्रवाई कर दी है।

शातिर चोर भी हैं पुलिस पर हमले के आरोपी

नल फिटिंग का काम करने के दौरान मौका मिलते ही करते हैं वारदात

आरोपी युवक के खिलाफ पुलिस केस दर्ज
इंदौर। परदेशपुरा इलाके में नाबालिग लड़की के साथ गलत हरकत का मामला सामने आया है। आरोपी ने लड़की के निजी फोटो हासिल कर उन्हें वायरल करने की धमकी देने लगा। पीड़िता फोटो देखने आरोपी युवक के घर गई तो वहां उसके साथ युवक ने हरकत की और बदमाश करने की धमकी दी। मामले में पुलिस ने आरोपी युवक के खिलाफ केस दर्ज किया है।
पुलिस के अनुसार आरोपी का नाम हिमांशु निवासी शीलनाथ कैप भंडारी ब्रिज के नीचे है। 17 वर्षीय लड़की ने पुलिस को शिकायत करते हुए बताया कि हिमांशु से उसकी दोस्ती थी। आरोपी ने उसके कुछ निजी फोटो हासिल किए और उन्हीं फोटो को वायरल करने की धमकी दे रहा था। वह पीड़िता को लगातार परेशान करता था। पीड़िता कल उससे इसी मामले में बात करने पहुंची तो आरोपी ने बुरी नीयत से पकड़कर उसके साथ हरकत कर डाली। शोर मचाने पर आरोपी धमकी भी देने लगा। इसके बाद पीड़िता थाने पहुंचे और आरोपी के खिलाफ केस दर्ज करवाया।

महिला के गले से मंगलसूत्र चुराने की कोशिश

इंदौर। बाणगंगा इलाके के घर में घुसकर महिला के गले से मंगलसूत्र चुराने का मामला सामने आया है। हालांकि घरवालों ने बदमाश को पकड़ लिया और पुलिस के हवाले कर दिया। शिकायत के बाद आरोपी के खिलाफ पुलिस ने केस दर्ज किया है।
बाणगंगा थाने में फरियादी बबिता पति सनी कश्यप की शिकायत पर आरोपी आकाश पिता लक्ष्मीनारायण परिहार निवासी टिगरिया बादशाह रोड के खिलाफ चोरी का केस दर्ज हुआ है। बबिता कश्यप ने पुलिस को बताया कि देर रात वह घर में सो रही थी तभी उसे एहसास हुआ कि उसका मंगलसूत्र कोई निकाल रहा है। उसकी नींद खुली तो उसने शोर मचाया। पास ही में सो रहे पति और दूसरे कमरे में सो रहे ससुर की नींद खुली तो देखा कि घर में एक अनजान युवक मौजूद है। पड़ोसियों की मदद से उसे पकड़ा और थाने लाए, उसने अपना नाम आकाश परिहार बताया। पुलिस उससे चोरी के अन्य मामलों में भी पूछताछ कर रही है।

गलत और भ्रामक जानकारी छापकर प्रचार करने का आरोप
इंदौर। हिन्दू धर्म के देवी-देवताओं के बारे में गलत व भ्रामक जानकारी छापकर प्रचार करने के मामले में पुलिस ने शिकायत के बाद केस दर्ज किया है। संत रामपाल महाराज को भी आरोपी बनाया है। मामले में जांच की जा रही है।
जुनी इंदौर थाना क्षेत्र में कॉलोनी में पिछले दिनों (17 मई) रामपाल भक्तों के द्वारा ज्ञान गंगा और अन्य पुस्तक बांटी जा रही थी। इसकी सूचना पर बजरंग दल कार्यकर्ताओं ने किताब बांट रहे युवक को पकड़ कर पुलिस के हवाले किया था। बजरंग दल और रामपाल भक्त बड़ी संख्या में थाने पहुंचे और आमने-सामने हो गए थे। तब कुछ नहीं हुआ लेकिन शुक्रवार को बजरंग दल कार्यकर्ता धर्मेंद्र चौहान निवासी राजाबाग थाने पहुंचा और पुलिस को आवेदन सौंपा। जिस पर से पुलिस ने संत रामपाल महाराज हिसार हरियाणा, माखन सिंह लुनियापुरा राजाजी बाजार इन्दौर के खिलाफ धारा 295अ, 153अ, 34 भादवि के तहत केस दर्ज कर लिया। आरोप है कि आरोपियों ने हिन्दू धर्म के देवी देवताओं के बारे में गलत व भ्रामक जानकारी छापकर प्रचार किया है।

सराफा में ब्रोकशिप करने वाले युवक की मौत
इंदौर। सोने-चांदी ब्रोकरी की मौत हो गई। घर वालों को फोन कर उसके अस्पताल में भर्ती होने की सूचना दी गई। परिजन अस्पताल पहुंचे तब तक युवक की मौत हो गई। मौत का कारण अभी साफ नहीं हो पाया है। युवक की शादी नहीं हुई थी। दरअसल, रमेश तिवारी उम्र 34 साल निवासी पटेल नगर को एमवाय अस्पताल में भर्ती कराया गया था। रमेश सराफा में कई सालों से ब्रोकशिप का काम करता था। शुक्रवार रात को रमेश के छोटे भाई विकास को किसी का फोन आया और रमेश के एमवाय अस्पताल में भर्ती होने की सूचना दी गई। विकास एमवाय पहुंचा तब तक रमेश की मौत हो चुकी थी। रमेश सुबह से काम पर चला जाता था। शुक्रवार को उसके पास पेमेंट भी आने वाला था। पोस्टमार्टम रिपोर्ट में ही मौत का कारण स्पष्ट हो पाएगा।

Fear of defeat

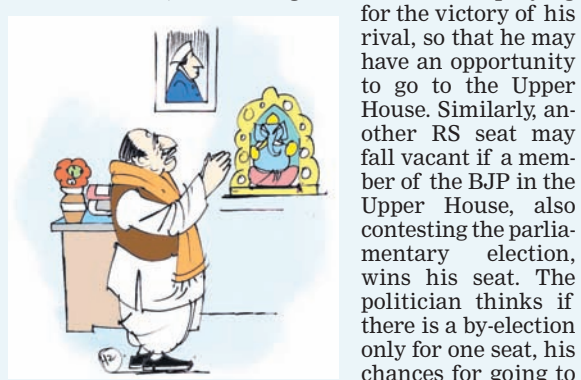
Fear of facing their opponents in the election ring has cost two women politicians of the ruling party dear. It has ruined their political career. The BJP leadership is in no mood to give them any position - either in the government or in the party organisation. One of them refused to fight the assembly election, anticipating that the BJP had barely had any chance to form a government. Nevertheless, after the BJP convincingly won the election and formed a government, she craved for a place in the Upper House, but the party's central leadership even declined to discuss the topic. His stature in politics is not so high that his name may figure in a discussion for the post of party's state unit president. Nor is the party taking him seriously. He wanted the party to send him to the Rajya Sabha if he was not made the party's state unit president. Before the assembly election, he was given a position after the central leadership's interference. But after the assembly election, the new regime stripped him off the position. About this leader it is said though he may neither be sent to the Upper House nor made president of the party's state president, yet he is set to get an important position after the Lok Sabha election.

Praying for rival's win

A leader of the BJP who has set his eyes on a seat of the Rajya Sabha is praying for the victory of a Congress leader. Because the Congress leader is a Rajya Sabha member, if he wins the election, the seat will fall vacant; but it will go to the BJP. He is praying



for the victory of his rival, so that he may have an opportunity to go to the Upper House. Similarly, another RS seat may fall vacant if a member of the BJP in the Upper House, also contesting the parliamentary election, wins his seat. The politician thinks if there is a by-election only for one seat, his chances for going to the Upper House are dim. If both seats fall vacant, then only he has an opportunity to hit the jackpot. This politician did not canvass for the Congress candidate, but since the day he came to know that if the rival contender won the seat it would go to the BJP, he has begun to pray for the opponent's victory.

Then it didn't happen

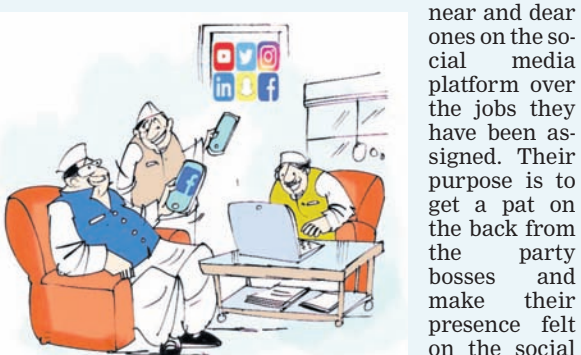
A renowned Bollywood actor, fielded by the ruling party from a constituency in Himachal Pradesh to fight the 2024 parliamentary election, was likely to throw down the gauntlet from the Guna constituency in Madhya Pradesh to the then Congress's big cheese Jyotiraditya Scindia in 2019. New tax regime made effective for ITR filing

CA Deepak Maheshwari has said that, in view of the important amendments made in the Income Tax Law by the Central Government in the last year's budget separate columns have been added for many types of new information in the prescribed ITR form. Due to which the new tax system for assessment year 2024-25 (FY 2023-24) has been made more simple, easy and attractive so that more and more taxpayers can choose the new tax regime and file their taxes accordingly.

He said this while addressing a workshop organised by MPTLBA and CTPA jointly. Maheshwari said that for



those taxpayers who want to pay tax as per the old tax regime, the information for availing the necessary deductions prescribed in the return form has been made more detailed. Maheshwari said that the effect of giving the desired information mentioned above will be that under the old tax system, it will no longer be possible to make any fake or wrong claim in the income tax return regarding such desired exemptions.

He said that keeping in view the online games being

played on a large scale, provisions for taxation on these have also been brought by the Central Government, and detailed information regarding such activities and business has also been sought through Income Tax Return Form.

TIMELY ISSUE OF NEW RETURN FORMS IS WELCOME

President of MPTLBA Advocate AK Lakhotia, said that the timely release of new returns forms (formats) by the government this year is welcome, because the most important tool in the currently prevalent online tax system is ITR (Income Tax Return). One will get enough time to gather evidence regarding all information and after matching it, one can file correct return.

Ward 65 corporator goes half-naked in protest against irregular water supply

In an unique form of protest, the corporator of Ward 65 on Saturday protested below waterhead tank near Baileshwar Mahadev Temple by getting half-naked after getting troubled with irregular water supply in the area. The area corporator Kamlesh Karla who was on protest said, "Its been two months that we are not receiving proper water supply in my ward (Sindhi Colony ward). Water is coming only for five to ten minutes."

I have tried meeting the concerned officials but no one heard me and they are continuously ignoring my phone calls.

He said that the water from the same tank is supplied to Ward No 62 and 63 which are also facing such problem.

He alleged that the IMC workers used to fill tanks from this overhead tank and sells it in the area in Rs 600 for Narmada Water and also Rs 400 for bore-

well water. "Only 10 per cent of wall is opened of our water supply line because of which the water tank could not be able to get filled properly and supply remain affected," said Karla.

The residents of the area also joined him in protest and raised slogans against district administration. IMC officials said that the distribution of water is done accordingly. Problem has been heard of this area and its resolution is under process.

Narmada Waterline bursts at Teen Imli Square

On Saturday evening, Narmada waterline at Teen Imli Square burst which caused gallons of water to flow over the road and caused trouble to commuters. The road got filled with water and people passing through square, especially two-wheeler riders remained troubled. The officials of IMC took the call and started repairing work by night hours.

15 people, including 3 BJP leaders, booked for loot, ransacking

Mhow: Kishanganj police have registered a case against 15 people, including three BJP leaders - Kanchan Singh Chohan, Dinesh Chohan, and Udal Singh Chohan - on charges of causing hurt, criminal intimidation, mischief, rioting, and robbery, as well as provisions of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act. Though no arrests have been made thus far, the Kishanganj police have assured that the case is under active investigation. A contentious land dispute in Pigdamber village has escalated, leading to allegations of assault, theft, and property damage. The conflict centers around Kuldip Pawar and other residents of the village, who vehemently oppose any construction in their area without their explicit consent. The genesis of the current turmoil can be traced back to a tragic incident last year when a youth lost his life about this very issue. At that time, Pawar and his associates had objected to the dust generated by the drilling of a borewell. The latest chapter in this saga unfolded on Friday evening when Lokesh Verma, a resident of Mhow, was overseeing the drilling of a borewell on his plot in Victoriya Milan Colony, situated along the Mhow-Indore road. Pawar, accompanied by Shivendra Chohan and Virendra Chohan, confronted Verma and demanded an immediate halt to the drilling, citing concerns over excessive dust dispersal in the area.

Kabul: Death toll due to fresh rounds of rainstorms and flooding in Afghanistan's Faryab and the neighbouring Sari Pul province over the past two days mounted to 17, local officials said on Saturday. In the Lawlash district of the Faryab province, 12 people have lost

their lives, and 11 others sustained injuries due to downpours and flash floods since Friday, provincial government spokesman Esmatullah Muradi said, Xinhua news agency reported. The official said that women and children were among the victims.

Mine collapse kills 5 in Kenya

Nairobi: An illegal gold mine collapsed in northern Kenya, leaving at least five miners dead, police said Saturday. The collapse of the Hillo mine in the Dabel area on Friday was attributed to a landslide. Marsabit County Police Commander Patrick Mwakio said the miners died on the spot after the debris covered them. No other miners have been found and it was not clear if anyone else was missing in the collapse. Interior Minister Kithure Kindiki in March had declared the area as disturbed and had subsequently banned mining activities in the area after a mining dispute led to the deaths of seven people.

Pro, anti-Iran protestors clash

London: British police say four people were hurt and one was arrested when supporters of Iran's authorities clashed with anti-government protesters at a London event marking the death of President Ebrahim Raisi. Protesters had gathered outside the venue in the west London area of Wembley and clashes broke out, police said. One person was arrested on suspicion of violent disorder. Four people were treated by paramedics for injuries that are not thought to be life-threatening or life-changing. Police said that detectives would examine social media footage and other evidence to see whether more offenses had been committed.

Baloch activists lambast Pakistan

Oslo: Prominent Baloch leader, Mahrang Baloch, in a discussion with the Norway chapter of Pen International, highlighted the issue of enforced disappearances and extrajudicial killings in Balochistan. The Baloch leader stated that during the last two decades, in the name of counter-insurgency operations and peace, a large number of people have been forcibly disappeared by Pakistani forces. She further stressed that these people have been detained in detention centres, and tortured, and their families didn't know about their whereabouts.

Monkey menace in Thai town

Thailand: The Thai town of Lopburi, plagued by several cases of monkey-human conflict, launched an offensive on Friday, using trickery and ripe tropical fruit. The first stage of the plan, instituted Friday, is to bait cages with the animals' favorite food. The captured monkeys will then be relocated elsewhere. There are thought to be around 2,500 monkeys running around the town. The effort will go on for five days this month, then is likely to be repeated. Some of the monkeys will be left free to maintain Lopburi's image as Thailand's monkey town.

Heavy rains return to Brazil

PORTO ALEGRE: Heavy rains once again hit Brazil's southernmost state on Thursday, ruining days-long clean-up efforts and flooding areas which had previously been untouched in Rio Grande do Sul's capital city of Porto Alegre. Record flooding over the past month killed 163 people, and over 600,000 were displaced. Another 64 people are still missing. Rains had lightened up over the past few days, with stores beginning to rebuild. But the rains returned Thursday morning. In a span of 12 hours, parts of Porto Alegre received more rains than they did in a whole month, according to data from the country's national meteorological institute.

'ICJ ruling is outrageous'

Israel says it has no choice but to attack Rafah to root out the last of Hamas fighters

There was no let up in Israeli military strikes on Friday even as the UN's top court, International Court of Justice (ICJ), ordered Israel to halt its military offensive in the southern Gaza city of Rafah. Israel called the order "outrageous, morally repugnant and disgusting", adding that the accusations it is committing genocide in Gaza "are false", reported Al Jazeera. Earlier Israel had signalled it would ignore any ruling to halt its offensive by the court, which has no enforcement powers. It said it has no choice but to attack Rafah to root out the last battalions of Hamas fighters it believes are sheltering there.

Israel said its military offensive in Gaza was in line with international law. "Israel has not and will not carry out military operations in the Rafah area that create living conditions that could cause the destruction of the Palestinian civilian population, in whole or in part," National Security Adviser Tzachi Hanegbi said in a joint statement with the foreign minister.

War cabinet minister Benny Gantz said Israel would continue its offensive "wherever and whenever necessary - including in Rafah".

In New York, Palestinian ambassador to the UN, Riyad Mansour, hailed the ruling and called for Israel to abide by it. "We expect that resolutions of the ICJ will be implemented without hesitation," he said. "That's mandatory. And Israel is a party to the convention."

Palestinians said they wanted action and not mere words on implementation of



the ICJ ruling.

The order must be obeyed, the European Union's foreign affairs chief Josep Borrell wrote on X in Brussels. Borrell highlighted the court order for Israel to "maintain the Rafah crossing open for humanitarian assistance."

In Canberra, Australia's minister for climate change and energy Chris Bowen said the federal government supported the ruling. He described the situation in Rafah as a humanitarian disaster that has the scope to get worse.

"We have been very consistent that Rafah should not be attacked," Bowen said at a press conference on Saturday.

On Friday, the ICJ had ordered Israel to "immediately halt its military offensive in Rafah".

"The humanitarian situation (in Gaza) is now to be characterised as disastrous," the ruling said.

A deputy commander of Hamas has been killed in an airstrike in central Gaza Strip, the Israel Defense Forces (IDF) have announced.

The IDF in a statement on Friday night identified the killed Hamas commander as Tziad al-Din al-Sharfa. The statement said he was killed in an Israeli air attack in central Gaza.

The Israeli Army said the assassination of the senior Hamas leader was conducted through a joint operation between IDF, Shin Bet and Military Intelligence.

The 99 Infantry Division of the IDF led the operation and coordinated the attack on al-Sharafa, considered a key operative of Hamas in

the Gaza Strip.

The IDF is now specifically focusing on senior leaders of Hamas and is working on specific inputs from Shin Bet and Israel Military intelligence on the movement of senior Hamas group leaders.

The IDF also said that it had assassinated Yusuf al-Shobaki who was heading the Industrial Security department of the Hamas militant group in Gaza.

Meanwhile, Israeli activists battled over Gaza-bound aid convoys in an attempt to disrupt the aid. With aid lorries entering Gaza at the main Kerem Shalom crossing, the battle is now between rival groups of activists doing their best to block and those trying to protect aid convoys.

China's war games around Taiwan end

The Chinese military has ended its two-day joint drills surrounding Taiwan, stated to be the biggest and closest exercises held around the prosperous self-ruled island that China claims to be part of its mainland.

The drills on Thursday and Friday were held in retaliation to Taiwan's new President Lai Ching-te's remarks rejecting Beijing's sovereignty claims over the island. China views Taiwan as a rebel province that must be reunified with the mainland even by force.

While there was no official announcement that the drills ended, the Chinese social media WeChat account of the PLA's Eastern Theatre Command on Saturday said the exercises lasted two days from Thursday. However, senior Taiwan

lawmaker Wang Ting-yu from Lai's Democratic Progressive Party said the latest drills appeared to be more about China making a noise than upping the ante, given it had to respond to Lai's speech. "They were comparatively more restrained than previous ones," Wang, who chairs parliament's defence and foreign affairs committee, said on social media.

Taiwan's Defence Ministry said on Friday and Saturday, 62 PLA aircraft and 27 PLA Navy vessels were detected.

It said 47 aircraft crossed the median line of the Taiwan Strait and entered Taiwan's southwestern, southeastern and eastern ADIZ.

Taiwanese Armed Forces have monitored the situation and employed a CAP aircraft, navy vessels, and coastal missile systems in response to the detected activities, it said.

Pak govt nod to more cases against Imran

Pakistan's Punjab government has approved the registration of more cases against jailed former prime minister Imran Khan and his party men for allegedly inciting hate against the state institutions, especially the powerful Pakistan Army.

The 71-year-old former cricketer-turned-politician has been in jail since August last year after being convicted in some of the nearly 200 cases slapped on him since his ouster in April 2022. "The Punjab Cabinet of Maryam Nawaz has approved legal action against Pakistan Tehreek-i-Insaf (PTI) founder leader Imran Khan and his other party leaders for building a hate narrative



against the state institutions," Punjab Information Minister Azma Bokhari told reporters after a cabinet meeting on Friday evening.

The minister said Khan is trying to become Mujeeb-ur-Rehman (of Bangladesh). Mujeeb had successfully led the Bangladeshi independence movement against Pakistan. He became the first prime minister of Bangladesh in 1971.

Bokhari said those who meet Khan in Adiala Jail Rawalpindi also follow him in spreading hate against the institutions.

The Punjab government is likely to book Khan and his close associates for writing an article in a British newspaper on a complaint from a journalist, she said.

300 feared dead in Papua New Guinea landslide

Rescue operations have begun in the landslide-hit Kaokalam village in Enga Province in northern Papua New Guinea (PNG), local media reported on Saturday.

More than 300 people are feared dead and over 1,100 houses were buried by a massive landslide that levelled a remote village in Enga Province, about 600 km from capital Port Moresby, around 3 a.m. on Friday.

The landslide in the Pacific nation north of Australia buried more than 300 people and 1,182 houses, the Papua New Guinea Post Courier said, citing comments from a member of the country's par-



liament, Aimos Akem. "Australia's High Commission in Port Moresby is in close contact with PNG authorities for further assessments on the extent of the damage and casualties," a DFAT spokesperson said in a statement.

The Australian Broadcasting Corp reported on Saturday that four bodies had been retrieved from the area after emergency teams reached the sparsely populated area,

where the toll is expected to rise.

The landslide has blocked highway access, making helicopters the only way to reach the area, the broadcaster reported.

Social media footage posted by a villager showed survivors searching through tons of earth and rubble by hand, looking for missing relatives while a first emergency convoy delivered food, water and other provisions Saturday at the site of the disaster. Women could be heard weeping in the background.

An assessment team reported that 100 people were dead and 60 houses were buried by the collapse.

US TO GIVE \$275 MN AID PACKAGE TO UKRAINE

The US will provide a new \$275 million military aid package for Ukraine to help the beleaguered country repel Russia's assault on Kharkiv, U.S. Secretary of State Antony Blinken said in a statement Friday.

The package contains urgently needed capabilities including ammunition for HIMARS, 155mm and 105mm artillery rounds, missiles, anti-armor systems and precision aerial munitions, the State Department said in a statement.

"Assistance from previous packages has already made it to the front lines, and we will move this new assistance as quickly as possible so the Ukrainian military can use it to defend their territory and protect the Ukrainian people," the statement said.

Meanwhile, a report said that finance chiefs from the Group of Seven industrial democracies and central bankers will be meeting in Italy on Saturday to explore ways of using frozen Russian assets to help Ukraine, which is struggling to contain a Russian offensive in the north and the east.

The G7 and its allies froze some \$300 billion of Russian assets shortly after Moscow invaded its neighbour in February 2022, in order to hamper the Russian onslaught.

"We are making progress in our discussions on potential avenues to bring forward the extraordinary profits stemming from immobilised Russian sovereign assets to the benefit of Ukraine," according to a statement issued by the forum.

G7 negotiators have discussed for weeks how to best exploit the assets, such as major currencies, which are mostly held in European-based depositories.

The US has been pushing its G7 partners to back a loan that could provide Kyiv with as much as \$50 billion in the near term.



Taken back embattled areas: Zelenskyy

Ukrainian forces have secured "combat control" of areas where Russian troops entered the northeastern Kharkiv region earlier this month, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy has claimed.

"Our soldiers have now managed to take combat control of the border area where the Russian occupiers entered," Zelenskyy said in his nightly video address on Friday evening.

Zelenskyy's comments appeared to be at odds with those of Russian officials.

Viktor Volodatskiy, a member of Russia's lower house of parliament, said Russian forces now controlled more than half of the town of Vovchansk, three miles (five kilometers) inside the border, Russian state news agency Tass reported on Friday.

Vovchansk has been a flashpoint since Russia

launched an offensive in the Kharkiv region on May 10.

Vodolatskiy was also quoted as saying that, once Vovchansk was secured, Russian forces would target the cities of Sloviansk, Kramatorsk and Pokrovsk in the neighboring Donetsk region. No independent confirmation of the claims was immediately possible.

Russia's Kharkiv push appears to be a coordinated new offensive that includes testing Ukrainian defenses in the Donetsk region further south — where Russia's Defense Ministry said Saturday that its forces had taken over the village of Arkhangel'ske — while also launching incursions in the northern Sumsy and Chernihiv regions. Russian President Vladimir Putin said the Kremlin's army is attempting to create a "buffer zone" in the Kharkiv region to prevent Ukrainian cross-border attacks.

Another Everest climbing record shattered

Purnima Shrestha, a Nepalese mountaineer and photojournalist, on Saturday scripted history by becoming the first person to summit Mt Everest, the highest peak in the world, three times in a single climbing season.

Purnima first summited the 8848.86-metre peak on May 12. She reached the summit again on May 19 with Pasang Sherpa and achieved her third summit on Satur-



day, at 5:50 am, said Pemba Sherpa, expedition director at Eight K Expeditions which organised the expedition.

This was Purnima's fourth ascent to Everest. She climbed the Everest for the first time in 2018. "This is for the first time in the history of mountaineering that any climber has submitted Everest thrice in a single season," said Nima Doma Sherpa, an Everest summiter.

Purnima visited the Everest Base Camp in 2017 to cov-

er the Everest marathon. She said this event attracted her to climb the mountains.

She then climbed Mt. Manaslu (8,163 mt) in the same year and the next year, she successfully climbed the highest peak in the world.

In addition to her triumphs with regard to Everest, Purnima has also conquered other formidable peaks including Manaslu, Annapurna, Dhaulagiri, Kanchenjunga, Lhotse, Makalu, and Mount K2.
