FOR PRIVATE HOSPITALS UNDER PMJAY SCHEME

Uploading clips before surgery, flexible packages: Health min issues new SOPs

EXPRESS NEWS SERVICE AHMEDABAD, DECEMBER 23

AMID A crackdown against the violations by private hospitals, empanelled under Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana-Mukhyamantri Amrutam (PM-JAY) in Gujarat, the state government Monday issued new guidelines, under the scheme, covering three main procedures such as cardiology, neonatal and oncology.

From flexible packages to uploading the pre-operation videography of surgeries to maintaining records following quality control standards to the hospital installing the CCTV cameras keeping in mind the privacy of the mothers, the comprehensive guidelines attempt to reduce the "scope for malpractice or criminal activity".

Health Minister Rushikesh Patel while issuing the new SOPs, during a press conference, on Monday said: "The new guidelines have been made keeping in mind all the aspects so that there is no scope for malpractice or criminal activity". The new SOPs cover cardiology, radiology, neonatal services and TKR/THR (Total knee replacement/Total hip replacement) among other aspects.

Cardiology

The government has decided to recognise only those centers that work full-time with a cardiologist and a cardiothoracic surgeon for cardiology services. It will also be necessary to have a full-time cardiac anesthetist and physiotherapist at the hospitals now. Health Minister Patel said that in special cases, the centers providing cardiology services will be allowed to perform angioplasty if emergency treatment is essential. Hospitals will also have to upload the CD/angiography of angiography and angioplasty at the time of pre-op. In case of emergency, this CD/angiography will have to be uploaded after the treatment, according to the new guidelines.

Oncology

Providing details about the SOPs for cancer treatment, Minister Patel said based on the

claims have been paid under the scheme in the state till 4-12-2024, amounting to Rs 15,562.11 crore.

Out of the total claims received under the scheme from 11-7-2023 to 10-7-2024 in the state, 24,701 claims (worth Rs 41.18 crore have been rejected)

1,16,266 claims (worth Rs 121 crore) have been deducted.

The patients admitted under the scheme are called through the 104 helpline number to take their feedback regarding the treatment.

4,96,184 patients were called using the helpline number (from November, 2023 to November, 2024).

99% responses were positive and good.

0.3% of patients had a poor response

0.6% had a moderate response.

for the radiotherapy machine. In cases where brachytherapy (a type of radiation therapy) is required, treatment will have to be provided only by the hospitals empanelled under PMJAY, no tie-ups will be allowed.

Neonatal care

To ensure quality treatment is given to children in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit or Special Newborn Care Unit, the hospitals will have to install CCTV keeping in mind the privacy of the mothers. Apart from this, the Taluka Health Officer will have to visit the Neonatal Intensive Care Units from time to time and submit a report to the State Health Agency. An online visit module portal will also be made operational soon to monitor every visit. Full-time pediatricians have been made mandatory for empanelment in neonatal speciality so that children get round-the-clock treatment.

Orthoplasty

According to the SOP for TKR/THR (Total knee replacement/Total hip replacement) under the PMJAY scheme, it has been made mandatory for the hospitals to treat at least 30 percent of "orthoplasty" cases.

In case, this is not followed, the hospital will be penalized. Also, if the hospital does not comply with the norm for nine consecutive months, they will be suspended from the "Orthoplasty" speciality. A total of 75 hospitals affiliated under the PMJAY scheme have been fined Rs 3.51 crore under TKR violations. Based on the PMJAY violation complaints, over 14 hospitals have been suspended, de-empanelled and penalised for malpractices till 2024. A fine of approximately Rs 18 crore has also been imposed.

Additional norms

Under the scheme, other guidelines have also been issued. As per the provisions of the Clinical Establishment Act-2024, it has been made mandatory to take a consent form with video recording while explain-

ing the predefined treatment process to the patient and their relatives.

These include angiography, angioplasty, coronary artery bypass surgery, amputation, all "ectomy" surgeries, organ donation/organ transplantation/organ retrieval surgery. Video consent will also be mandatory for surgeries such as spinal surgery/brain surgery/cancer surgery.

Furthermore, at the time of discharge, all diagnostic reports will have to be provided along with the discharge summary to the patient.

The State Anti-Fraud Unit (SAFU) which is functioning to catch irregularities under the PMJAY scheme has been directed to intensively monitor the treatment-related activities in all the hospitals in the state.

A separate team has been formed, including personnel from government and GMERS Medical Colleges to prevent frauds committed by private hospitals. Chief District Health Officer/Medical Officer of Health will have to conduct audits to at least two hospitals monthly, according to the norms. As part of the third party audit, the field audit will be planned through the tender process.

The team will conduct field audits of 2 to 3 per cent cases daily. Meanwhile, NHA has been requested to generate necessary triggers to prevent possible misuse of treatment packages by hospitals.

3.7 magnitude quake hits Kutch, no casualty

Ahmedabad: A tremor of 3.7 magnitude jolted Kutch district on Monday morning, the Institute of Seismological Research (ISR) said.

There was no report of any casualty or damage to property, the district administration said. The tremor was recorded at 10.44 am with its epicentre 76 kilometres north-north east of Lakhpat, the Gandhinagar-based ISR said. This is the second seismic activity of more than 3 magnitude this month in the district.

On December 7, a tremor of 3.2 magnitude was recorded in the district, according to the ISR.

Last month, Kutch recorded an earthquake of 4 magnitude on November 18. Gujarat is a high earthquake-risk area. **PTI**

Clash between two groups leaves 1 dead in Juhapura

Ahmedabad: A clash between two groups in the Juhapura area of Ahmedabad resulted in the death of a man, police said Monday, adding that six people have been arrested in the matter.

The violence took place on Saturday, two days after an altercation over a man from one group allegedly laughing at the wife of a man from another group, officials stated, adding that cross-complaints have been filed in the case.

According to the FIR filed over a complaint filed by a resident, Kasim Yasin Shaikh, on December 19, his brother Nazim had laughed at Heena, the wife of another man in the area, identified as Sartaj Salim Shaikh. The two then had an altercation but the matter was said to be resolved.

Two days later, however,

while the family was having dinner, they heard noises outside. Kasim's son Zafar, brother Zulfikar and Zulfikar's son Faisal, and another brother Nazim all went out to look what had happened.

They saw the four accused—Sartaj Salim Shaikh, Faraz Salim Shaikh, Sahil Salim Shaikh, and Nawaziz aka Raghu Anwar Shaikh—gathered outside. Later, the two groups started thrashing each other. According to the officials, Nawaziz succumbed to the injuries in the hospital.

Six people have been arrested in the case, said officials of the Juhapura police station.

Nazim Yasin Shaikh, who was absconding since the incident, was among those arrested by the Ahmedabad City Crime Branch on Monday. **ENS**
