“RESOLVED THAT in supersession of earlier resolution passed by the Members of the Company through Postal Ballot dated March 23, 2016, and pursuant to the provisions of Section 180(1)(c) and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the Companies (Meetings of Board and its Powers) Rules, 2014, including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof, for the time being in force, and in terms of the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company, the approval of the Members be and is hereby granted to the Board of Directors of the Company (hereinafter referred to as the “Board”, which term shall be deemed to include any Committee constituted/ empowered/to be constituted by the Board from time to time to exercise its powers conferred by this resolution), for borrowing from time to time such sums of money on such terms and conditions as deemed appropriate for the business of the Company, which, together with the money already borrowed by the Company (excluding temporary loans obtained from the Company’s bankers in the ordinary course of business), exceeds the aggregate of the Company’s paid-up share capital, free reserves and security premium amount, provided that the total amount so borrowed shall not exceed Rs. 1000 crores.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Board and Key Managerial Personnel of the Company, be and are hereby severally authorized to do all such acts, deeds, matters and things as it may deem fit in its absolute discretion and to take all such actions as may be necessary, desirable or expedient to give effect to the aforesaid resolution.”

Item No. 2

Approval of Material Modification in the approved Related Party Transactions with Adani Enterprise Limited

To consider and if thought fit, to pass with or without modification(s), the following resolution as an **Ordinary Resolution**:

The Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 (“Act”) read with Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (“Rules”) and other applicable provisions, as amended from time to time setting out all material facts relating to the resolutions mentioned in this Postal Ballot Notice is annexed hereto.
2. The Board of Directors of the Company have appointed M/s. Vishal Arora and Associates, Practicing Company Secretaries as the Scrutinizer to scrutinize the postal ballot process including votes cast through remote e-voting in a fair and transparent manner.
3. In compliance with the MCA Circulars, the Notice is being sent by electronic mode only to those Members whose names appear in the Register of Members/List of Beneficial Owners and whose e-mail IDs are registered with the Company/ Depositories/ RTA as on the cut-off date i.e. Friday, August 30, 2024. The Members who have not registered their e-mail IDs are requested to follow the instructions given under Point No. 8.
4. In compliance with the provisions of Sections 108 & 110 and other applicable provisions of the Act read with Rules 20 & 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended), and Regulation 44 of SEBI Listing Regulations and the Circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, the Company has engaged the National Securities Depository Limited (“NSDL”) as the authorised agency to provide the remote e-voting facility (i.e. the facility of casting votes by a Member by using an electronic voting system).
5. The Members, whose names appear in the Register of Members/ List of Beneficial Owners as on August 3, 2024, being the cut- off date, are entitled to vote on the Resolutions set forth in this Notice through remote e-voting only. The voting rights of Members shall be in proportion to their share in the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on the said cut-off date. Hard copy of the Postal Ballot Notice along with the Postal Ballot Form and pre-paid business reply envelope will not be sent to the Members for this Postal Ballot and Members are required to communicate their assent or dissent only through the remote e-voting system. This Postal Ballot is being initiated in compliance with the MCA Circulars.

5. Upon confirmation, the message “Vote cast successfully” will be displayed.

7. Once you confirm your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 102 AND 110 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013 IN RESPECT OF ITEMS OF SPECIAL BUSINESS

In conformity with the provisions of Sections 102 and 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 (**'the Act'**), the Secretarial Standard - 2 on General Meetings issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India and the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (**"SEBI Listing Regulations"**), the following Explanatory Statement setting out all material facts relating to the business mentioned at Item Nos. 1 and 2 of the accompanying Notice dated September 2, 2024 should be taken as forming part of this Notice.

Item No. 1

Pursuant to Section 180(1)(c) of the Companies Act, 2013, if a Company desires to borrow money and the total amount to be borrowed, along with the existing borrowed amount, surpasses the aggregate of Company's paid-up share capital, free reserves, and securities premium (excluding temporary loans obtained from the Company's bankers in the ordinary course of business), then the Company must obtain the approval of the Members by passing a Special Resolution.

The existing borrowing limit of the Company is Rs. 500 crores, which was approved by the Members vide Postal Ballot dated March 23, 2016.

However, in order to meet the Company's financial requirements for both short-term and long-term purposes, it may be necessary to borrow additional funds or issue bonds, debentures, or other securities amounting upto Rs. 1000 crores.

Therefore, basis the recommendation of the Audit Committee and the Board at their meeting held on September 2, 2024, it is proposed to increase the borrowing limit of the Company to Rs. 1000 crores, subject to the approval of the Members of the Company.

The Board recommends passing of the Special Resolution as set out in Item no. 1 of this Notice, for approval by the Members of the Company.

In accordance with the provisions of Regulation 23 of the SEBI Listing Regulations read with the Company's Policy on Materiality of Related Party Transactions and dealing with Related Party Transactions, the transactions involving transfer of resources, services or obligations between the Company or any of its subsidiaries on one hand and a related party of the Company or any of its subsidiaries on the other hand, which either individually or taken together with previous transaction(s) during a financial year, exceed Rs. 1,000 crores or 10% of the annual consolidated turnover of the Company as per the last audited financial statements, whichever is lower requires approval of the Members of the Company. Further, any material modification (defined as a variance of 20% or more from the relevant previously approved Related Party Transactions) is required to be approved by the Members by passing an Ordinary Resolution.

Adani Enterprises Limited (“AEL”) is the Ultimate Holding Company of the Company and accordingly a related party of the Company in terms of Regulation 2(1)(zc) of the SEBI Listing Regulations.

The Company, in order to further its business interests and the business interest of the Group, enters into various transactions with AEL.

The Members of the Company, via Postal Ballot dated March 8, 2024, had approved entering into material related party transactions with AEL for an amount aggregating upto Rs. 185 crores for the financial year 2024-25.

However, in order to meet the Company’s financial requirements for both short-term and long-term purposes, the Audit Committee and the Board of Directors of the Company, at their meeting held on September 2, 2024 has approved the below material modifications to the already approved related party transactions with AEL, subject to the approval of the Members of the Company:

- a. availing of credit facility of Rs. 135 crores from Axis Bank Limited, which is required to be secured against the Corporate Guarantee for the said amount to be issued by AEL;
- b. enhancement of the amount of the Inter-Corporate Loan availed from AEL from Rs. 120 crores to Rs. 300 crores and extending the tenure of the said loan till March 31, 2029;
- c. interest expenses on increased loan amounting to Rs. 15 crores.

Accordingly, an approval from the Members of the Company is being sought for material modification in the already approved related party contract(s)/ arrangement(s)/ transaction(s) with AEL and increase the transaction(s) value from Rs. 185 crores to Rs. 515 crores for the financial year 2024-25, subject to such contract(s)/ arrangement(s)/ transaction(s) being carried out at arm’s length and in the ordinary course of business of the Company and AEL.

As per the SEBI Listing Regulations, all related parties of the Company, whether or not a party to the proposed transaction(s), shall abstain from voting on this resolution.

The Board recommends passing of the Ordinary Resolution as set out in Item no. 2 of this Notice, for approval by the Members of the Company.
