COP29: BASIC countries ask rich nations to honour commitments

The commitments are to provide climate finance rather than 'diluting obligations' and rejected attempts by the rich nations to shift their financial responsibilities during negotiations

BAKU: BASIC countries, including India, have asked developed countries to honour their commitments to provide climate finance rather than "diluting obligations" and rejected attempts by the rich nations to shift their financial responsibilities during negotiations at the ongoing COP29 here.

As the annual climate change summit entered the fourth day on Thursday, Brazil, South Africa, India and China (BASIC) also reiterated the need for full and effective implementation of the Paris Agreement 2015, a legally binding international treaty. The Paris Agreement aims at substantially reducing

global greenhouse gas emissions to hold global temperature increase to well below 2 degrees Celsius and pursue efforts to limit it to 1.5 degrees Celsius above pre-industrial levels (with a baseline 1850-1900). India, Egypt, and the Independent Alliance of Latin America and the Caribbean (ALAC) also called for clear pathways to convert financial

pledges into binding contribution agreements.

However, these rich nations are facing criticism for not fully delivering on their own commitments, particularly regarding climate finance and support for developing countries.

In response, India, along with Brazil, South Africa and China as part of BASIC bloc, reiterated the need for full and effective implementation of the Paris Agreement. "The BASIC bloc rejected attempts by developed countries to shift their financial responsibilities," multiple negotiators confirmed to PTI. The poor, developing countries also asked rich, developed countries to honour their commitments to provide climate finance rather than "diluting obligations", a negotiator from Brazil told PTI.

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Head of UN nuclear watchdog visits Iran

As Mideast wars, Trump's return raise worries

DUBAI: The head of the International Atomic Energy Agency warned on Thursday that the "space for negotiation and diplomacy ... is getting smaller" over Iran's advancing atomic programme as wars in the Mideast rage and as President Donald Trump will return to the White House. Rafael Mariano Grossi of the IAEA was visiting Tehran in an effort to restore his inspectors' access to Iran's program and answer still-outstanding questions over it as he has on previous trips with limited success since Trump unilaterally withdrew the US from the Islamic Republic's nuclear deal with world powers.

However, the remarks from both Grossi and his Iranian counterpart at a news conference suggested sizeable gaps still exist, even as some countries are pushing to take action against Iran at an upcoming IAEA Board of Governors' meeting.

"We know that it is indispensable to get, at this point of time, to get some concrete, tangible and visible results that will indicate that this joint work is improving (the) situation, is bringing clarification to things and in a general sense it is moving us away from conflict and ultimately war," Grossi said.

Since the deal's collapse in 2018, Iran has abandoned all limits on its programme, and enriches uranium to up to 60 per cent purity — near weapons-grade levels of 90 per cent.

Surveillance cameras installed by the IAEA have been disrupted, while Iran has barred some of the Vienna-based agency's most experienced inspectors. Iranian officials also have increasingly threatened that they could pursue atomic weapons, something the West and the IAEA has been worried about for years since Tehran abandoned an organised weapons programme in 2003. Speaking at a news conference with Mohammad Esلمي of the Atomic Energy Organisation

of Iran, Grossi stressed that while the IAEA and Iran continued to negotiate, time was not necessarily on their side.

"The fact that international tensions and regional tensions do exist — this shows that the space for negotiation and diplomacy is not getting bigger, it is getting smaller," Grossi said. Before appearing with Esلمي, Grossi met with Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi, who later wrote on the social platform X that "differences can be resolved through cooperation and dialogue".

However, he warned Tehran was "NOT ready to negotiate under pressure and intimidation." Some politicians have even suggested Iran abandon the Treaty on the Nonproliferation of Nuclear Weapons, known as the NPT, and pursue the bomb.

Tulsi Gabbard to serve as Director of National Intelligence: Trump

WASHINGTON: US President-elect Donald Trump on Wednesday announced that Tulsi Gabbard, a former Democrat and the first-ever Hindu elected to the US Congress, would serve as Director of National Intelligence in his second term.

A four-term Congressman, 2020 presidential candidate and NYT bestselling author, Gabbard is a veteran with three deployments to war zones in the Middle East and Africa. She recently moved

from being a Democrat to a Republican member.

"I am pleased to announce that former Congresswoman, Lieutenant Colonel Tulsi Gabbard, will serve as Director of National Intelligence (DNI). For over two decades, Tulsi has fought for our Country and the Freedoms of all Americans," Trump announced. "As a former candidate for the Democratic presidential nomination, she has broad support in both parties." Trump said.
