# First in India German technology transparent dome, water-fire proof, no cloth or wood

Surat Instead of bouncers, a special security team, CCTV will also be installed in the parking lot.

Special care is being taken by the garba organizers to prevent rain from disrupting Navratri. Now sportsmen need not worry about rain spoiling the fun of Navratri amidst the forecast. Because, Navratri organizers in Surat have started building a dome of special German technology. Because of this, even if it rains, the players will be able to play garba with determination and concentration. The dome is water-proof as well as fire-proof, so that even an outside fire cannot touch the dome. Apart from this, special arrangements have been made by the organizers to avoid fire accidents even inside the dome.

A master plan has been prepared by the organizers and the police department regarding how security will be during Garbana Dome during Navratri. Navratri will be organized in Surat in the largest dome in entire Gujarat. Taking a lesson from the RPK Game Zone fire in Rajkot, Surat organizers

have made new changes for the Dome this year. Accordingly, thermocols and cloths used in decoration will not be used. Because these substances are the most flammable when there is a fire. Instead of fabrics and thermocols, it has been decided to use only fabrication and lighting.

Use of marble instead of wood in flooring

It has been decided to use marble instead of wood in the flooring for Navratri organized by G Nine Group. While during Kesaria Navratri, an emergency task force of 50 people will be formed in place of bouncers. Who will protect the people if any tragedy occurs. Yeshvi has planned to build roads around the Dome so that the vehicles of the fire brigade can exit. Apart from this, gas cylinders have been banned in the food zone. On the other hand, the police department has also planned for security. Organizers have been ordered to provide adequate lighting at dark places around Navratri celebrations. The parking lot has also been instructed to install fireproof.

For the first time in India, a transparent dome of

German technology has been made for Navratri.

The dome has fireproof cloth and floor fireproof carpet. Akash Bhadani said that till now we used to keep only 6 emergency exits in Navratri planning but this year we have kept 10 exits. Arrangements have been made to vacate the dome in just 5 to 7 minutes in case of any untoward incident. We are planning to have double the number of fire trucks than last year. Apart from this, fireproof carpet will be used on the flooring.

Roads will be built on all sides of the dome so that the fire truck can go.

Paresh Khandelwal said that we have become alert after the fire incident in Rajkot. We are going to make a road around the dome so that the fire truck can pass. As many as 5 exit gates will be constructed. Also, instead of one parking lot, 5 parking lots will be built. No compromise will be made in Navratri. More than 50 fire extinguisher bottles will be placed. Gas bottles will not be allowed in food stalls. Where cloth is used the cloth shall be fireproof. We will create a task force of 50 people for

emergencies like fire.

Keval Jayasola said that all kinds of arrangements have been made to prevent fire. Till now we used to put 50 fire extinguishers but this year we will put around 100. It is planned to have 2 vehicles of fire fighters instead of 1. For the first time this year, a task force of 50 people has been formed for special

emergencies. This team will be as stiff as bouncers. The team will also be trained on how to deal with incidents like fire. This time the shutters of the dome will be kept open. German technology dome to be made fireproof Heeren Kakkia said that we already plan to avoid the horrific fire but after the TRP zone incident we have become more alert.

## Joint venture

In the two conflicts in Ukraine and Gaza that daily dominate our newspapers, phones and television sets, history clearly permeates all arguments and counter-arguments of the opposing parties and their allies. In many senses, history-writing has had a symbiotic relationship with conflict and war for a long time. In the modern age, this relationship has cemented itself even more visibly and strongly.

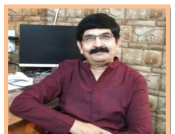
One example of this is in the history of diplomatic documentation in the United States of America. Perhaps the longest-running series of published diplomatic documents are the volumes in the 'Foreign Relations of the United States' series now comprising over 450 volumes. The first volume appeared in 1861 and the origins of this tradition are linked to the outbreak of the American civil war. At the time, there was a demand for authentic documents that would establish how and why the war between the Northern and the Southern states — the latter titled themselves the Confederate States of America — actually broke out. There was equally the desire to know how the US government, with Abraham Lincoln at the helm, was acting to isolate the breakaway Confederacy and prevent it from gaining international recognition. The early volumes had the effect of explaining their motivation and selection of documents included for publication.

Over the years, these initial volumes have been much scrutinised to see what the then US government wanted its own people and other governments to know about the civil war. Not surprisingly, it had played up the issue of slavery and its role in causing the conflict. But the thinking that underwrote the origins of the FRUS volumes also was that combat was not limited to the battle-fields alone and the Confederacy had to be blunted and overcome diplomatically in different capitals, something which we see in the international atmospherics that surround Gaza and Ukraine.

Alongside this was also the consideration that as large an extent of openness as possible was desirable to keep domestic political and public opinion on board in the midst of a deeply divisive and prolonged conflict. If this required declassifying and publishing even contentious documents, this should be done overriding any government's natural preference for secrecy.

Little over half a century later, as the First World War ended, there was a rush among the principal European combatants to deny responsibility for the European bloodbath. Germany felt this pressure the most. The Treaty of Versailles of 1919 had enshrined the idea of Germany's 'war guilt'. This had been a demand for authentic documents that would establish how and why she had a choice in the matter. Guilt also meant — apart from moral opprobrium — a responsibility to pay compensation and reparations to the other combatants for the losses suffered in the war. Through the 1920s, the Germans expended much effort to dilute if not erase this idea of war guilt. Amongst the modalities adopted for this was a specialist historical section being set up in the German foreign office to publish documents downplaying Germany's role in the outbreak of the war or to at least establish that others were also equally responsible. About 50 volumes of such documents were published over the 1920s. This German initiative inevitably meant that others would follow suit. The French, the British, the Russians and others followed in what became a slugfest of diplomatic documentation from opposing points of view. From these propaganda battles and from the process of studying, processing and writing about the war based on this mass of documentation, diplomatic history as a discipline consolidated itself in Europe and in the US. It would perhaps also be correct to argue that foreign offices in these countries sharpened their historical sensibilities through this process. Thus, it is no coincidence that the British foreign office's formal establishment of a historical division staffed with trained and professional historians or the US state department setting up the 'Office of the Historian' date to this time. In both these cases, historical documentation on diplomacy was to prove that your nation was morally on the right side in the pursuit of a particular policy.

## There is an immeasurable distance between late and too late

William Shakespeare has said "Better three hours too soon than a minute too late." We Indians are generally unpunctual and do not seem to realize that this means an undisciplined approach to both life and work. Suppose a minister is going to give a speech in your town at 9 O'clock on a Sunday morning. Being a good citizen, you are keen to know about the policies of your Government. So you decide to go and listen to the speech of the minister. You also decide that after the speech is over at 10 O'clock you will go for an outing with your family. The children wait enthusiastically for 10 O'clock to arrive. It's important to apologize as well, says Sheila Dramis, CEO of HR Partners, "Acknowledge that you understand it sets a bad example, impacts the team and that you are taking steps to correct it. This is better than spewing out excuses. Your manager wants to know you understand the implications and are taking steps to change."

But things do not turn out the way you envisaged because the speech scheduled for 9 O'clock take place finally at 1 O'clock. The work is that no one will ever tell you that the speaker has been postponed. If someone had, you could have at least told your family about the change in programme. Even at the venue of the meeting, they will keep reassuring you that the minister will arrive in 5 minutes, 10 minutes in "just a while more." The top reasons people blame for their delay are like traffic, oversleeping, bad weather, being too tired to get out of bed, and plain old procrastination. Most people regard lateness as a minor and pardonable offence and sometimes turn up to engagements intentionally late, expecting the other party to easily forgive them. This attitude towards time is very common among young people and people without demanding or busy schedules.

Let me give you another example. You have invited a few friends for tea at your home at 6 O'clock in the evening. You think that after your delay of 2 or 3 hours is a very minor thing. During the monsoon, even a delay of 8-10 hours is expected. If a train arrives out on time, in all probability, it is a train which is at 6 O'clock late! No doubt, circumstances do arise and it is not always possible to be on time but if you are going to be late for an appointment, it's our duty to call as soon as we know we are going to be late. વિશ્વામિત્રી નદી કે જેને ૩૬ એલટી લેવેલ ૨૬ ફૂટ છે તે ૧૧ વખત વટવટી ચુકું છે. વર્ષ મુજબ જોઈએ તો ૧૯૮૪, ૧૯૮૮, ૨૦૦૩, ૨૦૦૫, ૨૦૦૬, ૨૦૦૮, ૨૦૧૪, ૨૦૧૬, ૨૦૧૯ અને ૨૦૨૪ નો સમાવેશ થાય છે. વર્ષ ૨૦૨૪ નો જુલાઈ અને ઓગસ્ટ એમ બંને મહિનામાં ૨૬ ફૂટનો લેવેલ કાંસો કરી ગયું હતું. આમ, લગભગ ૬૨ બે-ગ્રજ પૂર વડોદરામાં પૂર આવે છે. આ વખતે પણ વિશ્વામિત્રીના પૂરના મેદાનમાં બાંધકામોના દબાણોને લીધે
