As Trump's Tariff Threats Get Louder, What's Next for India-US Trade Ties?

New Delhi: Ahead of Prime Mi-∞ inister Narendra Modi's US vi-Esit, India slashed customs duties on a range of products as Was-—hington ratchets up threats of Freciprocal tariffs.

In the first round, the new Trump administration imposed tariffs on China, Mexico and Canada. Trump also said he will le evy a 25% tariff on metal imports. Threat of action against Indialo-Eoms large as Trump has frequently called India a 'Tariff King'. In a proactive move that could help reduce the risk, India's February 1 budget reduced duties on fish hydrolysate for the manufacture of aquatic feed, specific waste and scrap items, ground installation = for satellites, ethernet switches and motorcycles, which will di-

∉rectly benefit American exports. The US is India's largest trading partner. In FY24, India's exports ≛to the US were \$77.51 billion, whi-Ele imports were \$42.2 billion. Trump has targeted countries Ewith which the US has a trade de-Efficit, asking for more exports.

PRESSURE TO LOWER TARIFFS

-Trump's grouse of India being a ta-Eriff abuser emanates from the fact ∞ =that New Delhi imposes a standard £42-120% duty on almonds, 30% import tariff on cherries and cranberries and 50% on apples. The US had also raised concerns over 70% Eduty on chickpeas and 35% on diagnostic reagents.

"The US is bound by its WTO commitments of the Uruguay N_Round due to which developed =countries have low tariffs while =we have the right to impose high reciprocal tariffs, India will gain no market access but every other country including the US -will benefit because these concessions will be on a most-favou-Fred nation basis," said a Delhi-

N__based trade expert. India's weighted average tariff ≡is 9.2% on minerals, 26.1% on foot-Ewear and 24.8% on textiles and clothing, higher than Indonesia, Malaysia and the Philippines. The US is likely to pressure India to lower tariffs on these items.

India is likely to gain from the EUS-China trade war. India was Ethe fourth largest beneficiary Ewhen the US imposed higher duties on Chinese goods during =Trump's first tenure.

After returning to power, Trump signed an order to impose stiff tariffs on imports from China. China retaliated by slapping a =15% tariff on US coal and LNG exports and 10% on its oil and agricultural equipment and announ-Eced a probe into Google, rekind--ling their trade war.

"This will impact us positively. Exporters have given positive feedback on export orders and va-Elue," said an official.

Exporters have told the govern--ment that they expect to tap \$25 billion export potential in the US. "Higher tariffs on China can Ecreate a significant opportunity For Indian exports, especially in ≣sectors where Beijing has previo-Eusly been a dominant supplier," said Federation of Indian Export

Tariffs can Impact India More: Nomura

New Delhi: Emerging Asian economies such as India and Thailand face higher risks from Trump's retaliatory tariffs, financial services firm Nomura said Tuesday.

US President Donald Trump has said that he would announce reciprocal tariffs on US imports from other countries this week.

Nomura said the imposition of tariffs by the US could end up hurting emerging Asia including India, China and Thailand more than developed Asian economies such as Hong Kong and Singapore, -Our Bureau

NON-TARIFF BARRIERS

Washington imposes strict emission and safety regulations that Indian automotive products must comply with, leading to higher compliance costs. Also, lower tariffs on imports from Mexico and Canada due to USMCA (United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement) make Indian vehicles less competitive in pricing.

India could seek easing of regulatory restrictions, tariff barriers and safety and environmental compliance requirements which limit its access to the US market.

Min Panel may Propose 5% GST with ITC Benefit on Term Plans

New Delhi: A ministerial panel tasked by the Goods and Service Tax (GST) council to explore feasibility of levying taxes on insurance products may recommend a 5% GST with input tax credit on term plans, officials said.

The Group of Ministers (GoM), headed by Bihar deputy chief minister Samrat Chaudhary, on Friday asked the fitment committee, under the council, to examine the tax impact of the proposal, they said.

"After the resistance from the insurance industry, the fitment committee, assisting the GoM has been told to work on the 5% GST with ITC, and also to work on the revenue impact on that," said an official privy to the development.

The official said the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) has been asked to discuss the pros and cons of the proposal with industry, which has strongly opposed a complete exemption, arguing that without input tax credit (ITC) benefit, insurance products could become pricier.

"IRDAI is working on building consensus and the GoM will meet again after the IRDAI report," said the official cited above.

Insurance companies had made representations to IRDAI and Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC), expressing their reservations. The industry has batted for levy of a 12% GST with ITC for term plans.

"The industry has reservations regarding letting go of the input tax credit and the IRDAI is looking into it," Sanjay Agarwal, chairman, CBIC, told ET in a post-budget interview earlier this month.
