NCP's Massive Show of Strength in Mankhurd Shivajinagar and Anushakti Nagar

Grand Election Rally in the Presence of Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar

Mumbai, Nov 7: In the Mankhurd-Shivajinagar constituency of senior NCP leader and former minister Nawab Malik, and the Anushakti Nagar constituency of Sana Malik-Shaikh, a grand election rally was held on Thursday in the presence of National President and Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar.

Ajit Pawar kickstarted the campaign for NCP candidates from Mumbai. The campaign began from the Anushakti Nagar and Mankhurd-Shivajinagar

constituencies. The rally in Anushakti Nagar began from Gowandi Tata Nagar, while another rally was held in Nawab Malik's Mankhurd-Shivajinagar constituency. Citizens gave a warm reception to Ajit Pawar, Sana Malik-Shaikh, and Nawab Malik by garlanding them at various spots during the rally. Ajit Pawar, Sana Malik-Shaikh, and Nawab Malik carried out the rally on an open jeep. The rally received a thunderous response from the public, with thousands of men, women, youth, and elders, along with party officials and workers, joining the campaign.

2,833 complaints received through C-Vigil app

Mumbai, Nov 7 (UNI) Over 2,833 complaints were received till November 6 on the C-Vigil app for the Assembly General Election 2024 across the state, the Chief Election Officer said here on Thursday.

Out of this 2,819 complaints were found to be true and action has been taken by the Election Commission, the officials said. C-Vigil app, which helps citizens to follow the code of conduct, can be downloaded from any app store. Through this app, citizens can report violations of the code of conduct.

After the complaint is filed, appropriate action is taken after investigation by the concerned team, the statement said.

Enforcement agencies of the state and central government have seized 281 crates and 78 lakhs of excess money and 78 lakhs of illegal money, liquor, drugs, and precious metals. Effective implementation of the code of conduct is underway in the state, added the statement.

18 UBT office bearers resign from the party alleging factionalism

Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj, Nov 7 (UNI) : Accusing former UBT MP Chandrakant Khaire and Assembly Leader of the Opposition Ambhadhas Danve of factionalism, 18 party office bearers from the Gulmandi area resigned from the outfit's party membership on Thursday. All those who quit are considered supporters of former MLC

Kisanchandra Tanwani. The Gulmandi area is considered the stronghold of the Shiv Sena UBT group. The first branch of Shiv Sena started from here. Upazilla Chief Sachin Zaveri and Division Chief Somnath Bomble told a media meet that 18 supporters of Tanwani have resigned collectively from their positions in the Shiv Sena UBT party after

getting tired of factionalism. Meanwhile, Tanwani, who was given a ticket from the Aurangabad Central Assembly constituency, has withdrawn from the poll arena after health reasons. Citing health reasons after that UBT Chief Uddhav Thackeray removed him from the post of district Chief. However, Tanwani also resigned from party membership yesterday.

Congress President Kharge to release MVA manifesto Nov 10

Mumbai, Nov 7 (UNI) : Maharashtra state Congress Party in charge Ramesh Chennithala on Thursday said party national president Mallikarjun Kharge will release the manifesto of Maha Vikas Agadhi on November 10 here in the presence of NCP-SP and UBT leaders. The decision was conveyed to the media after the first meeting of the party's campaign committee for the Maharashtra Assembly elections during the day at its state headquarters Tiak Bhavan.

Chennithala said Kharge, Leader of the Opposition in the Lok

Sabha Rahil Gandhi, All India General Committee General Secretary Priyanka Gandhi, Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah, Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy along with senior Congress leaders will hold public meetings in various parts of the state to campaign for the candidates of the Congress and its MVA partners.

The meeting was attended by the Regional Vice President Nana Gawande, the convener of the campaign committee and the panel's members.

He said Kharge will be on a five-day tour of Maharashtra and his

meetings will be held in various parts of the state on November 13, 14, 16, 17 and 18. Rahul Gandhi will hold meetings on November 12, 14 and 16. Congress National General Secretary Priyanka Gandhi will address campaign meetings on November 13, 16 and 17.

Chennithala further said that action has been taken against all Congress rebels who have not withdrawn their candidatures against the official candidate of Mahavikas Agadhi and they have been suspended from the Congress for six years. He asserted that there would be no friendly fight anywhere in the state.

After passing of Assembly resolution, world aware what J&K wants: Omar Abdullah

Srinagar, Nov 7 (UNI) : Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Omar Abdullah on Thursday said people have raised their voice on restoration of Article 370 through the Assembly and the world was told what the people want here.

On Wednesday, the National Conference-led government passed a resolution in the Assembly for the restoration of special status to Jammu and Kashmir. The passing of the resolution triggered uproar in the Assembly over the last two days.

"I had repeatedly told you in the elections that we have to raise our voice through this Assembly. This we have to send a message through this Assembly that what happened to us on August 5 August 19 (when J&K special status was scrapped) is not acceptable to us. And it happened without our permission, our consent and our consultation," Omar said in his address during a function at Ganderbal after laying the foundation of a bridge.

Omar hit out at those who accused them of not passing the resolution on the first day of the Assembly session and said they wanted to pass a resolution which even the central government could not ignore.

"Now, when it (the resolution) was not mentioned anywhere on the first day (of the Assembly session), some people started taunting us. Some said we forgot it... We are not among those who deceive," Omar said.

"The difference is that we are people who know the law. We know how things should be brought through the Assembly. And we wanted such a voice to be raised through the assembly

that even the central government could not ignore." Otherwise, we would have brought such a resolution on the first day which they would have thrown into the dustbin. Then what would have been the benefit?," Omar asked.

Patna, Nov 7 (UNI) : Millions of devotees on Thursday offered "Araghya" to setting Sun in Bihar on the occasion of Chhath festival.

Millions of devotees mostly women thronged on the bank of Ganga river in Patna and other rivers, ponds and water bodies in the state to pay obeisance (Araghya) to setting Sun on the occasion of Chhath festival.

Rituals of Chhath festival began on Tuesday with "Naha Khai" while "Khamra" was celebrated on Wednesday. Devotees will offer "Araghya" to rising Sun on Friday, marking the end of four day Chhath festival, considered as most pious festival dedicated to nature, which is now being celebrated across the country and also abroad where Indians have settled since long due to various reasons including the quest for earning livelihood.

Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar also offered "Araghya" to setting Sun at his official residence in Patna where

SDPI hold agitation in Sambhajanagar

Chhatrapati Sambhajanagar, Nov 26 (UNI) : As part of the country-wide protest against incident of alleged violence that took place at Sambhal in Uttar Pradesh on November 24, a strong protest was held in front of the district collector's office here on behalf of Social Democratic Party of India (SDPI) on Tuesday.

On this occasion, state president Syed Kalim said that the historic Jama Masjid at Sambhal has been there for hundreds of years. The court ordered the survey without hearing the other party in violation of the 1991 Religious Security Act. Local citizens cooperated with the survey, which was conducted on November 19, but on the morning of November 24, the authorities came again with an army of police, he said. At this time, the crowd gathered, and the local police allegedly resorted to the lathi charge and firing, in which four innocent youths were killed, he recalled. SDPI condemned the incident and raised slogans against the Uttar Pradesh government and the police. They demanded a judicial inquiry into the incident and justice for the victims. They also demanded that the UP government should give financial assistance of Rs 50 lakh each to the families of the deceased.

'Ghar Ghar Constitution' campaign to be undertaken during Constitution Amrit Jubilee

Chhatrapati Sambhajanagar, Nov 26 (UNI): On completion of 75 years of Indian Constitution, the campaign 'Ghar Ghar Constitution' will be implemented in the year 2024-25 in the district.

On occasion of the Constitution Day on Tuesday, a mass reading of the Preamble of the Constitution was held at the district collector's office.

Collector Deepil Swami appealed every Indian to respect the Constitution and be aware of the duties given to them along with

the rights given to them by the Constitution. Later, outgoing state Deputy CM Devendra Fadnis participated in 'Mashal Rally' organised by Maharashtra Police Boys Association at Gateway of India in Mumbai. On this occasion, the police officers and personnel paid homage to those police officers and personnel who were martyred in horrific terrorist attacks on Mumbai on November 26, 2008. Fadnis wrote on his social media platform X/

11 is significant for two things. One is India got its Constitution on this day, so this day is celebrated as 'Constitution Day' and second for terrorist attacks on the financial capital of the country - Mumbai - on this day in 2008, in which hundreds of innocent civilians lost their lives along with police officers and personnel who sacrificed their lives while capturing Ajmal Kasab, one of 10 terrorists who attacked the sovereignty of the country. "Saluted all the brave souls of Mother India. Also wished everyone a very happy Constitution Day," he stated. Continuing

further, he said that after the year 2014 India is developing as a strong and capable nation so that no one will be able to cast an evil eye on it. "Until the spirit of 'Nation First' is inculcated in us, the concept of the strongest nation in the world will never materialise," he noted. Maharashtra is prosperous only because of law and order in the state, he said and emphasised that the police administration is working to maintain this wealth. Therefore, the state government will fulfil the demands of the police in terms of housing, health, education, and so on, he added.

MPCC chief Patole meets Mallikarjun Kharge, Rahul Gandhi in Delhi

Mumbai, Nov 26 (UNI) : Maharashtra Pradesh Congress Committee (MPCC) president, Nana Patole, on Tuesday met Congress party's national president Mallikarjun Kharge and Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi in Delhi.

On this occasion, newly elected MP of Nanded, Prof Ravindra Vasant Rao Chavan along with Congress party's MPs from Maharashtra were also present. Talking to reporters after this meeting, the MPCC chief said that during the meeting, he apprised

the party leaders of the results of the Maharashtra Assembly elections.

This result is not only unexpected but also unacceptable to the people of the state, he noted and said that people's sentiments are different.

He further said that there are rumours going on that there was a glitch in electronic voting machines (EVMs), as a result voters are speculating that the vote given to one party could have gone to another.

However, the Supreme Court has refused to believe it and is seeking

proof for it, he said.

Patole took a dig at the BJP and its allies over the delay in deciding on the chief ministerial face, questioning why they are taking so much time to decide on the chief ministerial candidate after the people of Maharashtra have given them a sweeping majority.

He further said that only the person who blindly signs the documents of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's dear industrialist friends will be appointed as the chief minister of Maharashtra, he added.

NCP (SP) candidate alleges poll fraud in Parli seat; raises question over Munde's victory

Mumbai, Nov 26 (PTI) : NCP (SP) candidate Rajesheb Deshmukh on Tuesday alleged fraud in voting in the Parli assembly constituency in Maharashtra's Beed district, claiming that the votes were cast using the names of deceased persons in nearly 150 polling booths. Deshmukh, who lost the recent election by a huge margin of 1,40,224 votes to Dhananjay Munde of the Aji Pawar-led NCP, has accused Munde's supporters of using fraudulent means to manipulate the election.

Speaking to a regional news channel, he said, "NCP candidate Dhananjay Munde clearly orchestrated terrorism. His supporters actively prevented eligible voters from casting their votes. I have shared around 10 different videos publicly, exposing fraud in the election process. This is not the way to conduct an election in a democratic manner." Irregularities were carried out in nearly 140 to 150 booths in the constituency, where votes were allegedly cast in the names of deceased individuals, he claimed.

"The names of these

deceased persons should have been removed from the voters' list long ago. Munde's supporters ensured that others were not allowed to vote. Even the Election Commission officials appeared helpless," Deshmukh alleged, adding that he could provide a list of voters to back his claims.

Deshmukh revealed that he had immediately written to the Election Commission (EC) following the election, but did not receive any response. "I sent a letter to the EC on the very day of the voting. The next day, I submitted four additional letters, but to date, I have received no

reply from them," he claimed. Deshmukh also expressed disappointment over the "lack of action" by the Election Commission despite his complaints. He wondered how Munde emerged victorious, given the widespread anger towards the state government over issues such as agrarian distress and unemployment. "There was a strong wave of support for Sharad Pawar and our party due to people's frustrations with the state government. So how did the ruling party candidate win? When we tried to protest, my relatives and supporters were arrested," Deshmukh added.

Essar Group chairman Shashikant Ruia passes away

Mumbai, Nov 26 (UNI) : Essar Group chairman Shashikant Ruia passed away here after an illness, a company official said on Tuesday. The renowned industrialist was admitted to the Breach Candy Hospital in south Mumbai due to age-related problems. BARC launches high-yield, climate-resilient varieties of wheat, rice and oilseeds

Mumbai, Dec 6 (PT) : The Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC), Mumbai, has introduced eight new high-yielding, climate-resilient varieties of wheat, rice and oilseeds, it said on Friday.

Developed using radiation-based mutation breeding techniques, these non-GMO crop varieties are set to "revolutionise" agriculture across India, the BARC said in a statement here. The new varieties — five cereals and three oilseeds — are tailored to diverse agricultural conditions and were launched in collaboration with state agricultural universities.

Speaking at the launch, Ajit Kumar Mohanty, Secretary of Atomic Energy (DAE) and Chairman of the Atomic Energy Commission,

highlighted BARC's significant contribution in enhancing farmer incomes and boosting food and nutritional security.

Vivek Bhasin, Director, BARC, called these varieties a "boon for farmers" due to their early maturity, disease resistance, climate resilience, salt tolerance, and higher yields compared to existing options.

India's wheat production faces challenges from rising temperatures, especially during the grain-filling stage. For the first time, BARC has developed wheat varieties, he said.

The Trombay Jodhpur Wheat-153 (TJW-153) was developed in collaboration with Jodhpur Agriculture University for Rajasthan. TJW-153 is heat-tolerant, ensuring stable yields despite early or terminal

heat stress. It is resistant to fungal diseases like blast and powdery mildew, which significantly reduce yields, and is ideal for Rajasthan's arid conditions, the BARC said. Trombay Raj Vijay Wheat-155 (TRVW-155) was developed in collaboration with Rajmata Vijayaraje Scindia Krishi Vishwavidyalaya, Gwalior, for Madhya Pradesh. It has enhanced zinc and iron content, better "chapatti"-making quality, and resistance to fungal diseases such as blast and powdery mildew.

Rice variety Bauna Luchai-CTLM was developed with ICGV, Raipur, for Chhattisgarh in collaboration with ICGV, Raipur, it addresses the growing demand for health-enhancing rice varieties.

The Trombay Konkani Khara variety is saline for Maharashtra's saline coastal soils. It achieves 15 per cent higher grain yield under saline conditions. Developed in collaboration with Dr Balasaheb Savant Konkani Krishi Vidyaapeeth, Dapoli, it allows rice cultivation in previously non-arable brackish soils.

Sanjeevani is rich in more than 350 phytochemicals known for therapeutic and medicinal properties, boosting immunity and antioxidant responses, the BARC said.

Lok Vikas connects Dharavikars to Govt welfare schemes

Mumbai Dec 6 (UNI) : Over 300 residents of Dharaivi in central Mumbai have gained access to critical government welfare schemes through Lok Vikas, an initiative by the Dharaivi Social Mission (DSM).

Held on October 19 and November 16, two Lok Vikas events facilitated the enrolment of 197 individuals, some benefiting from multiple schemes. The initiative has already brought medical insurance benefits worth Rs 10 crore (approx.) to over 300 families in the area.

In a locality where most people work in unorganised sectors, welfare programmes like Ayushman Bharat, E-Shram Card, and Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana provide much-needed financial and health security. However, challenges such as lack of awareness and fears about cybercrime often prevent residents from accessing these benefits.

Umesh Sonar, a participant, shared how Lok Vikas eased the enrolment process for him and his wife Pushpa into Ayushman Bharat. "Earlier, we were afraid to misuse of Aadhaar and cybercrime

concerns. With DSM's help, we felt safe and confident."

The programme's impact goes beyond just enrolment. For many, it represents a lifeline to essential social protections. "I enrolled in the E-Shram Card scheme and found the process smooth. Many people are unaware of these benefits, but Lok Vikas ensures we don't miss out," said Silabee Shaikh, a 48-year-old cook.

Dharaivi Social Mission's inclusive approach addresses the barriers residents face, offering free, secure assistance to enrol in welfare programmes. Social workers, Bhagyalakshmi Bhagyalakshmi highlighted its importance: "For many, these schemes are a safety net. DSM is making sure no one is left behind."

With more events planned, Lok Vikas aims to expand its reach, bridging the gap between government welfare schemes and the people of Dharaivi. By creating awareness and unlocking benefits, DSM is strengthening the community and building a foundation for a more secure future.

SC dismisses plea against political affiliations of Bar Council Members

New Delhi, Dec 6 (UNI) : The Supreme Court on Friday rejected a petition seeking directions to prevent members of the Bar Council of India (BCI) and State Bar Councils from affiliating with political parties.

A Bench comprising Justice Surya Kant and Justice Ujjal Bhuyan observed that bar associations are intellectual bodies and that having a political ideology does not necessarily harm their functioning. "The bar bodies are intellectual. Their functioning won't change just because the President or Chairman has an ideology. We are a country with firm faith in democracy. We cannot direct Parliament to enact a law or anything of the sort," the Bench stated.

The Bench further pointed out that prominent figures such as Senior Advocates Manan Kumar Mishra and Kapil Sibal, who lead the Bar Council of India and the Supreme Court Bar Association respectively, also have political histories and affiliations. "What is wrong if any bar member holds an ideology, including a political one.
