'I am a corrupt bridge, how long will I walk'

50 crore Hatkeswar bridge is like a neck bone for AMC, no one is ready to tear it down and build a new one, opposition protested with banners



Ahmedabad The Hatkeswar Bridge, which is the prime example of corruption in the Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation, has been closed for the past two years. A tender process has also been conducted by the Corporation to demolish Hatkeswar Bridge and build a new one, but so far no company is ready to demolish the bridge and build a new one, so now Hatkeswar Bridge has become a bottleneck for the Municipal Corporation. As no company has yet shown interest in the tender of the bridge, now the situation has arisen where the corporation has to dismantle the bridge itself.

Protest by putting up banners on the bridge. Even the opposition Congress has now protested by putting up banners about the Hatkeswar Bridge. A banner has been put up by the opposition Congress on Hatkeswar Bridge, which reads 'AMC, remove me. I am a corrupt bridge, I am very tired, how far will I walk', there have been protests by placing banners on this bridge. The banner put up by the corporation was later taken

down. The bridge has become a great show piece for the people of Ahmedabad as BJP authorities and officials are not approving any decision regarding Hatkeswar Bridge.

Bridge still in same condition after 680 days: Leader of Opposition Leader of Opposition Shehzad Khan Pathan said that the biggest corruption in the history of Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation was the Hatkeswar Bridge built at a cost of 50 crores, which was closed within a few months due to its dilapidated condition. Was on the one hand BJP and AMC could not prevent massive corruption. On the other hand, even after 680 days, the bridge is in the same condition and no one could get rid of it. Today, the Congress party protested by placing a banner on that bridge, demanding quick disposal of Hatkeswar Bridge.

There is talk of a scam going on in the vigilance department.

Questions were now raised against the functioning of the vigilance department in Hatkeswar Bridge, which is considered to be the biggest example of corruption in the

Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation. During the construction of the bridge, there has been negligence in taking samples and checking by the vigilance department, which has not been taken into consideration. It has been revealed that the sample testing which is done in the laboratory does not even have the signature of any officer of the vigilance department anywhere in the copy of the testing. There is talk of a scam going on in the Vigilance Department, which is the department that investigates crams and those responsible in the corporation.

Many shocking things have been revealed in the documents received by him under RTI in the case of Hatkeswar Bridge, which raises doubts whether the sample was taken or not. A sample for testing is usually taken during or after the cement concrete is filled. AMC indicated that the cement concrete was filled on 30th January 2016. However, the sample for its testing has been shown to have been taken on 27th January 2016, so whether the sample was taken or not is questionable. No doubt was raised by the vigilance department as to how the sample was taken three days ago.

AMC's material testing lab takes fixed construction samples and sends them for testing. Two samples are taken at the time of construction, one on day 7 and the other on day 28 from the water and sent for testing.

Distribution of buttermilk to save people from heat in red alert, corporators feeding more than six thousand people daily

Rajkot Scorching heat is falling all over Saurashtra and Gujarat including Rajkot. The temperature in Rajkot city has already crossed 44 degrees and the possibility of further increase in heat has been expressed by the Meteorological Department. Then the Rajkot Municipal Corporation has announced a red alert for the next 5 days. Seeing this, charitable people have become aware and are doing charitable work to save people from heat by distributing buttermilk free of cost. Rajkot Ward No. 14 corporator Nilesbhai Jalu has been distributing buttermilk in the city for the last 5 days and this service will continue for the next 5 days. It is worth mentioning that buttermilk is being made from 300 kg cows every day and distributed to more than 6,000 people daily.



A service activity has been started by Nilesbhai Jalu, corporator of BJP Ward No. 14, Rajkot city, to give relief to the people in the scorching heat. Starting from last 15th, buttermilk is being made from 300 kg cows every day and distributed to about 6,000 people in different places. Buttermilk is being distributed in Gundawadi. Rajkot's Mayorbhai Savalia said, We were going to dress a patient. Meanwhile, approaching Gundawadi, buttermilk is being distributed by Nilesbhai and his team. They think that the people are doing very commendable work in such a situation. I urge people to drink lemon water regularly and take plenty of vitamin C. Rajkot Municipal Commissioner Anand Patel said yesterday that the temperature is increasing continuously, due to which people need to be careful. Municipalities release details from time to time so that the people of the city can know about the change in season. Currently, as the temperature is likely to reach 45 degrees, the Manpa has declared a red alert. People should take this alert seriously and avoid going out unnecessarily at noon. Also it is necessary to drink as much water as possible. Apart from this, special construction sites have also been appealed to stop work at noon.

Also, the Municipal Corporation has suggested not to do any work on the side in the city from 12 noon to 4 pm. Health Department has started issuing instructions. Accused acquitted due to lack of proper evidence

7-year-old girl attempted to be raped in a field in Onanji area in Koranaka, girl strangled to death while screaming



Ahmedabad Ahmedabad's Sola High Court Police Station in September 2020 under Sections 317, 302, 363, 366, 376(2)(b), 376A, 376B of IPC and Sections 3a, 5(1)(d) of POCSO, 6, 11(6) and 12 of the offense was registered. Police arrested a 46-year-old accused in this case. The charge sheet of which was presented in Ahmedabad village court in November, 2020. Advocate B.C. Rathore and advocate Rakesh G. from the legal aid of the accused side. Panchal argued. In the current month, Judge J.T. Shah, while delivering the verdict, ordered the acquittal of the accused due to lack of proper evidence. The body was found on the third day after she was reported missing by a woman detailing the incident of her daughter, the eldest of her three children, who was 7 years and 8 months old. She was studying in class 2. A lot of efforts were made to find her when she went missing outside the house while she was playing outside that night. But being found, a missing complaint was finally registered. Three days after the complaint, on September 16, the body of this daughter was found in a decomposing condition in a field-like place near Onganj area. In the investigation of this crime, the police arrested the 46-year-old accused. According to the custom, the deceased's mother i.e. the complainant's brother -
What is the whole event? It may be mentioned that this was the second marriage of both the deceased's mother and father. Both had children from their first marriage. There were three daughters from the second marriage. In which this incident happened with the eldest daughter. At the time of the incident, the father had gone out to do lighting work. The police also suspected the complainant's mother. The crime branch was also involved in the investigation in this case. The 46-year-old accused, who was arrested, admitted to the doctor and the police that after taking the girl to Anonaji area, he tried to rape her by stripping her clothes in a field-like place. But the girl screamed and strangled her, killed her and escaped from there. The accused pleaded not guilty before the court and the court trial went on.
As the body was also decomposed, the medical evidence was not sufficient, the police also checked the CCTV footage at the scene. In which a stranger is seen carrying the baby girl.
