Murders down, but chain snatching up in Pune: CP

(Standard Post Bureau) Pune, Feb 24 : Crimes like murders have come down in Pune, but incidents of vehicle vandalism or chain snatching have gone up, the city police chief said on Monday.

Police Commissioner Amtesh Kumar said earlier, there was an average of 5.5 murders per month, but now the figure has reduced to an average of 7.2 murders per month. "We want to reduce this to 6.5. There has been a 34 percent reduction in attempted murder in Pune, but we are not satisfied with these figures," said Amtesh Kumar.

stern warning to miscreants, he said the police would take tough measures against them.

Interacting with journalists at Pratiksha Bhavan, he, however, conceded that incidents of vehicle vandalism or chain snatching have increased in the last few days. "Measures are being taken to combat such crimes," he said.

Kumar said last week, a software engineer youth was beaten up during Shiv Jayanti, following which the police booked the accused under the Maharashtra Control of Organized Crime Act (MCOCA). He said

three of the accused have been arrested, and a few others are absconding. "If the criminals in the gang want to come into the mainstream, we have no enmity with them. But if anything wrong happens, we will not spare them," he said.

The top cop said cases have been filed against 20 to 22 people who glorified crime on social media, and action is being taken against them. In Pune, new arms licenses will be given to those in dire need, but not to those with a criminal background, he said. So far, 300 licenses have been cancelled.

'Govt positive about setting up of HC bench in Kolhapur'

Kolhapur, Feb 24 (UNI) Maharashtra and District Guardian Minister, Prakash Aabkar, said on Monday that the state government is positive about long pending demand of setting up a bench of Bombay High Court at Kolhapur and Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis will convene a meeting of the representatives of the bar associations of six districts, as soon as possible. He made this statement while addressing a gathering at historic Datta Chowk after a long strike by lawyers. Manik-Pati-Chowk, who was on hunger strike for last few days to press for the demand of a high court bench in Kolhapur, ended his fast by drinking a glass of sharbat from the minister's hand.

Aabkar further said that all elected representatives and ministers from the district, including Hasan Musafir and Chandrakant Patil, have done constant follow-up of this long pending demand with Fadnis and his two deputies and the government is optimistic about this, he added.

Use AI to increase fisheries production and marine security: Nitesh Rane



Mumbai, Feb 24 (UNI) Maharashtra Fisheries Minister Nitesh Rane asserted on Monday that the use of artificial intelligence (AI) is important for strengthening maritime security and increasing fish production. While interacting with students working on AI technology at Mantralaya, he said that the current era is the era of AI technology. To increase fish production and marine security are priorities of the

department, he pointed. Highlighting these are two distinct areas of fishing -- marine and freshwater, the minister asked students to use AI to augment productivity in both the sectors. He also asked students to find ways to bolster maritime security by increasing information gathered from drones. Rane also instructed students to prepare a detailed presentation on making the department self-sufficient by increasing the revenue.

Man arrested for raping three minors

Mumbai, Feb 24 (UNI) A 37-year-old man was arrested in neighbouring Vair city of Maharashtra for allegedly raping three minor girls, including two sisters, over several months, an official said here on Monday.

According to the complaint a 15-year-old girl on Sunday accused a neighbour of repeated sexual assault and revealed that the man had first assaulted her on the night of January 1, 2024, and continued to abuse her 14-year-old sister and a 17-year-old neighbour.

The victims alleged that the accused resorted to threats to coerce them into silence, allowing the abuse to continue for an extended period. The girls eventually found the courage to report the crimes, leading to the man's arrest.

The Vair police have registered a case under relevant sections of the Indian Penal Code, including charges of rape and violations of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act. Authorities have launched a thorough investigation into the disturbing allegations.

BJP MLA Vijender Gupta elected as Speaker

New Delhi, Feb 24 (UNI) Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) MLA Vijender Gupta has been elected as the Speaker of the Delhi Assembly on Monday.

As the first session of the Assembly began on Monday, Delhi Chief Minister Rekha Gupta proposed the name of Vijender Gupta for the Speaker's post, and it was supported by Cabinet Minister Manjinder Singh Sra. The second proposal for electing Gupta as Speaker was made by Cabinet Minister Ravindra Indraj and supported by Minister Parshv Verma.

BJP MLA Kulwant Rana also supported the proposal to elect Gupta as Assembly Speaker. The house unanimously approved the proposal for electing Vijender Gupta as the Speaker of the Assembly.

Man arrested with Hydroponic Weed

Mumbai, Feb 24 (UNI) A 23-year-old man was arrested by the Customs at the Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport here on Monday for allegedly smuggling Hydroponic Weed worth Rs 73 lakh from Bangkok, officials said.

According to the sources, the officers of the Air Intelligence Unit (AIU) of the Customs Department intercepted a passenger Iqbal Mohamed Ibrahim, a resident of Tamil Nadu, on suspicion that he might be carrying some contraband items. The man had arrived from Bangkok.

Thereafter the Customs officers opened the baggage of the passenger and noticed that it was filled with various types of chocolates and food items. On further scrutiny, the officers found a plastic packet containing green coloured dry leafy substance in the lower portion of the bag. When confronted, Ibrahim remained mum about the contents of the transparent vacuum sealed packet.

"On cutting the transparent plastic-like material packets, the packets were found stuffed with greenish coloured dry leafy substance in lump form, having a strong pungent smell.

The officers tested the same using Field Testing Kit of NDPS substance which showed positive result for hydroponic weed (Marijuana), a substance covered under Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act," said a Customs official.

Police constable dies, another seriously injured in road accident in Kolhapur

Kolhapur, Feb 24 (UNI) A police constable died on the spot and another woman police constable was seriously injured after a speeding tempo collided head-on with their scooter at Tirvade village on Gaganbavda road in the district on Monday.

According to police, a constable was proceeding to Sidree in Kagal tehsil of the district on a scooter with a woman constable to attend a function at the

lamer's native village. At Tirvade village, a speeding tempo collided head-on with their two-wheeler, killing the rider (male constable) on the spot and causing serious injuries to the pillion rider (woman constable).

The deceased constable was identified as Krishna Manohar Thombare (25), originally resident of Bodke village in Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar district but attached to Ramgiri police headquarter.

While, seriously injured woman constable, Asmi Amar Chaugule, originally resident of Sidree in Kagal tehsil, was admitted to Chhatrapati Pramila Rajesh hospital after preliminary medical treatment at rural hospital.

After incident, Gaganbavda police arrested the driver of tempo Qadar Omar Patankar of Gaganbavda, sources added.

Office executive arrested for blackmailing

Mumbai, Feb 24 (UNI) An office executive of a multi-national company (MNC) was arrested by city police for allegedly threatening his colleague with viral circulation of his obscene photos and also extorting money from her, an official said here on Monday.

According to details, accused, identified as Naveen Kumar Singh (25), was arrested by MIDC Police following a complaint of extortion and molestation.

Four years ago, Singh invited her to his birthday celebration and during the celebration, he allegedly forced himself on her, sexually assaulted her and secretly took explicit photos of her on his mobile phone.

Start short courses in various foreign languages to meet demand for skilled manpower: Governor

Nashik, Feb 24 (UNI) Governor and Chancellor of Universities in the state, C P Radhakrishnan on Monday asked the Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University (YCMOU) to start short courses in various foreign languages, including English, to meet the demand for skilled manpower.

Addressing the 30th convocation ceremony of YCMOU here, he said that many advanced countries in the world are looking for skilled manpower and they demand skilled manpower who know their language.

In this context, the university should consider starting short courses in Japanese, German, Russian, Italian, French or even English, he suggested.

The education system in the country is soon going to transition from an examination-centric model to an outcome-based model, he mentioned.

The Governor expressed that this change will not only make students more employable but will also enable them to become entrepreneurs and will complement the dream of a developed India by 2047.

The dream of achieving 50 percent enrollment in higher education by 2036 in India can be realized only by utilizing the potential of open and distance learning, he said.

This will provide an opportunity for education to people from remote areas and those who are far from the educational mainstream, he noted. Radhakrishnan made an appeal to the University to include new ideas and innovations in their curriculum to provide education that will be useful to the students. The government will be advised to get funds to transform the university into a digital university, he added. On this occasion, the Governor presented gold medals to the meritorious students in various academic disciplines.

The injured was admitted to Patna Medical College and Hospital. According to reports received from Saran, two people were killed and nine others injured in a collision between a pickup van and a truck under Chensari police station area in Rohtas district on Monday morning. The victims were returning from Prayagraj after taking Holy dip in Sangam.
