Pursuant to Regulation 30 read with Clause no. 20 of Para A of Part A of Schedule III of the Listing Regulations read with SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-1/P/CIR/2023/123 dated July 13, 2023 ("SEBI Circular"), this is to inform that the Company is in receipt of judgment dated July 05, 2024 passed by the High Court at Delhi where it has ordered granting an adinterim injunction and anti-enforcement protection to the Petitioner (Honasa Consumer Limited) restraining the Respondent (RSM General Trading LLC) to execute the Decree against the Petitioner within the territorial jurisdiction of courts at Delhi, or elsewhere ("Order").

Nature and details of the action(s) taken, or order(s) passed	Honasa Consumer Limited ("Petitioner/Honasa") filed a petition under Section 9 of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 ("Petition") against RSM General Trading LLC (Respondent/RSM) before the High Court at New Delhi, India. The petition sought for an ad-interim injunction and anti-enforcement of the judgement dated May 16, 2024 passed by the Court of full Commercial Jurisdiction, Dubai ("Court of First Instance") against Honasa for compensation of AED 25,071,991/- ("Decree") as damages to RSM.
	The High Court at New Delhi passed an order granting an ad-interim injunction and anti-enforcement protection to Honasa restraining the Respondent to execute the Decree against Honasa within the territorial jurisdiction of courts at Delhi, or elsewhere. ("Order").

The Order is granted to restrict RSM in executing the previous decree passed by the Dubai Court in India or elsewhere till the next date of hearing. However, the appeal filed in the Dubai Court by Honasa for challenging the previous erroneous decree shall remain in force and will be heard accordingly. In view of the above, there is no change in the financial or operational impact on Honasa from our previous disclosure (dated May 17, 2024) pertaining to this matter
