- ii) The Company is engaged in the single operating segment "Performance Chemicals".
- iii) The Company has received interim payment of Rs. 545 lakhs from the Insurance Company with respect to the claim filed in the previous year. The final claim is under process and there is no dispute made by the Insurance Company. We expect to realize the claim in due course.
- iv) The Company has considered the possible effects of COVID 19 on the carrying value of financial and non-financial assets including liquidity. The business of the Company has been classified as 'essential commodity and despite the COVID lockdown our production facilities have been operating after taking the necessary precautions. We have been able to maintain sales and do not expect any material impact on our supply chain. Basis the liquidity position as at 30 September 2020 and the expected cash generation from operations, we do not envisage any impact on our financing and debt arrangements at this point in time.
- v) During the previous quarter, the Company and the Managing Director along with Director (Operation and Business Development) have received a show cause notice from an Adjudicating Officer of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) with respect to allegations pertaining to non-disclosure of certain information to the Stock Exchange under Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulation, 2015.

The Company has obtained necessary legal advice and is taking appropriate steps for the same in due course.

On 29 June 2020, the Board of Directors had recommended a final dividend of Rs. 1.50 per equity share (face value of Rs. 10 per equity share) for the financial year ended 31 March 2020, which has been approved by the shareholders in the Annual General Meeting held on 25 September 2020. Accordingly, Rs. 184 lakhs was appropriated as distribution to equity shareholders during the quarter ended 30 September 2020.

- 2. - iv) The Company has considered the possible effects of COVID 19 on the carrying value of financial and non-financial assets including liquidity. The business of the Company has been classified as 'essential commodity and despite the COVID lockdown our production facilities have been operating after taking the necessary precautions. We have been able to maintain sales and do not expect any material impact on our supply chain. Basis the liquidity position as at 30 September 2020 and the expected cash generation from operations, we do not envisage any impact on our financing and debt arrangements at this point in time.
- v) During the previous quarter, the Company and the Managing Director along with Director (Operation and Business Development) have received a show cause notice from an Adjudicating Officer of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) with respect to allegations pertaining to non-disclosure of certain information to the Stock Exchange under Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulation, 2015.

The Company has obtained necessary legal advice and is taking appropriate steps for the same in due course.

vi) On 29 June 2020, the Board of Directors had recommended a final dividend of Rs. 1.50 per equity share (face value of Rs. 10 per equity share) for the financial year ended 31 March 2020, which has been approved by the shareholders in the Annual General Meeting held on 25 September 2020. Accordingly, Rs. 184 lakhs was appropriated as distribution to equity shareholders during the quarter ended 30 September 2020.
