Covid XE variant confirmed; no cause for alarm, say officials

WEEKS AFTER two unconfirmed cases were reported from Maharashtra and Gujarat, the country's first case of Omicron sub-variant XE has been confirmed by the Indian SARS-CoV2 Genomics Sequencing Consortium (INSACOG), a network of national testing laboratories set up by the Government.

As of now, experts say, there is no evidence to suggest that a Covid infection from the XE sub-variant is different from those caused by the other Omicron sub-lineages. The new sub-variant has been found to be only about 10 per cent more transmissible than the currently dominant BA.2 variant of Omicron, which triggered the third Covid wave in the country in January.

"Less than a handful of recombinant variants have been detected in the country so far. All of them are from geographically disparate regions. No cluster formation has been seen," a Government official told *The Indian Express*.

There was no official confirmation on where the XE sample was obtained from. But of the two unconfirmed cases reported earlier from the two states, the official said the sample from Maharashtra was not of the new sub-variant.

The XE confirmation — in INSACOG's weekly bulletin — comes at a time when there has been an increase in Covid cases in 12 states, leading to mask mandates. There has, meanwhile, been a decline in cases too in 19 other states, according to Government data till April 25.

The INSACOG bulletin states that the "Omicron (BA.2) is the dominant variant in India till date".

The XE variant is a "recombinant". This means it contains the mutations found in BA.1 as well as BA.2 variants of Omicron, and was first discovered in the UK in January. The random process of genetic mutations in viruses and other organisms is a common occurrence. Only a small fraction of these mutations significantly alter the abilities of the virus to infect, or to cause severe diseases.

Centre clears SII's Covovax for 12-17 group at pvt centres

New Delhi: The Centre has included Serum Institute of India's Covovax in the country's Covid-19 vaccination drive by making it available at private facilities for children aged between 12 and 17. Provision to book slots for the vaccine is being added to the government's CoWIN portal, according to sources in the Health Ministry.

Each Covovax dose will cost Rs 900 (plus GST), with an additional Rs 150 for covering the cost of services and consumables at the hospitals.

This comes after the government's technical panel — National Technical Advisory Group on Immunisation (NTAGI) — recommended the use of the vaccine among children aged between 12 and 17 years.

So far, children in the 12-14 age group could get only Biological E's Corbevax and those between 15 and 17 years Bharat Biotech's Covaxin.

These vaccines are available free of cost at government centres. At private facilities, Covaxin costs Rs 375 (plus GST), and Corbevax Rs 990. **ENS**

CHANCES OF THUNDER, RAIN IMD: Heatwave to abate from today

THE PREVAILING heat-wave conditions over Rajasthan, Vidarbha in Maharashtra and pockets around Delhi will begin to abate starting Tuesday, the India Meteorological Department (IMD) said on Monday.

The maximum temperatures over northwest India is set to drop by 3 degrees to 4 degrees Celsius and remain so until Friday, the Met officials said.

Many places in western Rajasthan and Vidarbha had been recording over 45 degrees Celsius all through last week.

Thursdays onwards, most parts of north and central India regions will be free from heatwave, according to the IMD's forecast. Besides, there are chances of thunderstorms

and rain over Jammu and Kashmir, Ladakh, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, eastern Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, Odisha, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and all states in South India until May 6.

"This is under the influence of the approaching western disturbance," an IMD official said. "Rainfall over the southern peninsula will be caused due to wind discontinuity in lower levels."

Likewise, central India will also experience a reduction in heat, as the day temperature is set to drop by 2 degrees to 3 degrees Celsius for the next three days, according to IMD.

However, Maharashtra and Gujarat may continue to experience hotter days this week, with a heatwave forecast on May 5 and 6 over Madhya Maharashtra.

3 The figures for the quarter ended March 31, 2022 are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the full financial year up to March 31, 2022 and unaudited published year-to-date figures up to December 31, 2021 being the date of the end of the third quarter of financial year which were subject to limited review by the statutory auditors.

4 The financial results for the quarter ended March 31, 2021 have not been reviewed or audited by the statutory auditors of the Company. However, the management has exercised necessary due diligence to ensure that the financial results for these periods provide a true and fair view of the Company's affairs.

5 Pursuant to the Taxation Law (Amendment) Ordinance, 2019 ("Ordinance") issued by Ministry of Law and Justice (Legislative Department) on September 20, 2019 effective from April 01, 2019, domestic companies have the option to pay Corporate income tax rate at 22% plus applicable surcharge and cess ("New tax rate") subject to certain conditions. Based on the assessment, parent Company has chosen to exercise the option of New tax rate during the quarter ended March 31, 2021. Accordingly, the unutilised credit for Minimum Alternate Tax aggregating to ₹ 23.02 Crores written off.

Further, the Company re-measured the outstanding deferred tax liability that is expected to be reversed in future at 22% plus applicable surcharge and cess. Accordingly, an amount of ₹ 115.04 Crores have been written back in the Statement of Profit and Loss during the quarter ended March 31, 2021.
