Centre notifies amended minerals rules

THE CENTRE HAS notified the amended minerals concession rules that will pave the way for sale of 50% of mineral produced from captive mines, transfer of mines without any charges and partial surrender of a lease. Various amendments were made in the Mines and Minerals (Development and Amendment) Act, 1957, earlier this year. The changes were aimed at increasing employment and investment in the sector, raising revenues to states, among others.

Govt buys over 209L tonne paddy so far this Kharif

THE GOVERNMENT ON Tuesday said it has procured 209.52 lakh tonne of paddy so far in the current Kharif marketing season for over ₹41,066.80 crore. The Kharif marketing season (KMS) 2021-22 runs from October to September.

Over 2.38 cr ITRs for FY21 filed: I-T department

OVER 2.38 CRORE income tax returns have been filed for the 2020-21 fiscal so far, the I-T department said. Of this, over 1.68 crore income tax returns have been processed, while refunds have been issued in more than 64 lakh cases.

Excise duty cut seen providing higher pricing freedom to OMCs

THE LATEST REDUCTIONS in the excise duty on petrol and diesel by the Centre is seen to increase the ability of the state-run oil marketing companies (OMCs) to raise auto fuel prices if crude oil rates increase in the international market. The surge in global crude oil prices are likely to continue till the end of the year with the OPEC+ countries showing no signs of increasing production over the pre-determined levels till December, even as global crude demand is on the rise.

Analysts at Motilal Oswal Financial Services pointed out that amid growing concerns on the ability of OMCs to raise record-high prices further, investors remained wary of investing in OMCs in light of the upcoming elections in Goa, Manipur, Punjab, UP and Uttarakhand by the end of FY22. "While the cut in excise would not raise marketing margins immediately, they would increase the ability of the OMCs to raise prices if oil prices gain from hereon," the brokerage firm added.

OMCs had not hiked auto-fuel prices in conformity with the global crude movements between late February and May

in the run up to Assembly elections in four states and the UT of Puducherry. Between January and April, petrol price (in Delhi) had increased around 8% while the cost of crude had grown about 25%. To recover their marketing margins, retail petrol prices were kept unchanged (at ₹101.84/litre in Delhi) between July 17 and August 21, while global crude corrected from around \$73/barrel to about \$65/barrel in the same period. The Centre, on November 3,

announced excise duty cuts of ₹5/litre on petrol and ₹10/litre on diesel. After the tax cuts, retail price of petrol in Delhi fell from an all-time high of ₹110.04 a litre to ₹103.97 a litre on November 4. Diesel rates dropped from ₹98.42 a litre to ₹86.67 a litre. The prices were unchanged till November 9. The tax reductions brought down the central taxes on petrol and diesel to ₹27.9 per litre and ₹21.8 per litre, respectively. In March and May 2020, surcharge and cess on auto fuels were cumulatively increased by ₹13 per litre on petrol and ₹16 per litre on diesel, leading to record-high auto fuel rates. At present, the prices charged to dealers by Indian Oil Corporation are ₹48.23/litre for petrol and ₹49.61/litre for diesel.

Oil PSUs to set up 22k EV charging stations

INDIAN OIL CORPORATION (IOC) and two other public sector oil firms will install 22,000 electric vehicle (EV) charging stations over the next 3-5 years to support the nation's target to reduce its carbon intensity and hit net zero emissions by 2070.

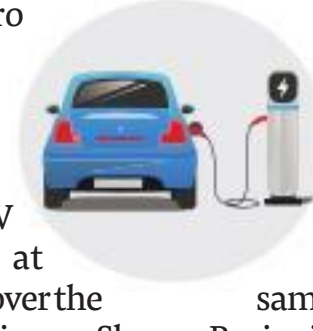
IOC, the country's largest state-run refiner by capacity, will set up EV charging facilities at 10,000 fuel outlets over the next three years, chairman Shrikant Madhav Vaidya said. BPCL will set up 7,000 stations over the next five years while HPCL has plans for 5,000 stations.

At the 2021 Climate Change Conference, also known as COP26, Prime Minister Narendra Modi outlined a net-zero emissions target by 2070 for

India. Also, India is targeting to increase its low-carbon power capacity to 500 gigawatts (GW) by 2030 and meet 50% of its total energy requirements by 2030. It is looking to reduce the carbon intensity of its economy by 45%, cut projected carbon emissions by 1 billion tonne by 2030 and achieve a net-zero target by 2070.

IOC plans to install 2,000 charging stations over the next year, with BPCL and HPCL targeting 1,000 each over the same period, oil minister HS Puri said on Tuesday.

RIL's mobility joint venture with BP also launched its first mobility retail outlet in Maharashtra last month, which will offer EV charging and battery swapping. It also finalised a pact with all-electric ride-hailing service BluSmart to set up EV charging infrastructure in India.



'India to reach 50% clean energy share, 500 GW RE capacity targets before 2030'

INDIA WILL EASILY achieve the target of 50% share of energy from non-fossil fuels and also the 500 GW renewable energy capacity before the deadline of 2030, said Union minister RK Singh. He said, "We are working hard towards the...target of 500 GW from RE by 2030. We had said we will do 40% (energy from non-fossil fuel) by 2030. We have reached 39%. We will easily achieve the 50% target by 2030. The prime minister has given the target till 2030, we will achieve...before that."

He added that the PM has increased the RE target by 50 GW to 500 GW to be achieved by 2030. "We will achieve that. It is not too much, a tall order. Wheream I? I am already at 200 GW (of RE)...So, I am already at 212 GW. So, getting to further let us say 300 GW by 2030 in a decade, I don't think that is difficult," he said. — PTI

Over half of nearly 7 cr unorganised sector workers now on e-Shram

MORE THAN HALF — 52.85% to be precise — of the nearly seven crore unorganised sector workers who have got themselves registered on the e-Shram portal so far are from the three eastern states of West Bengal, Odisha and Bihar.

As shown in the e-Shram dashboard, maintained by the labour ministry, West Bengal topped the list among all states with 1,70,54,364 or 24.52% of the registrations. Among the eastern states, registration from Odisha stood at 1,11,20,159 or

15.99% of the total. More than 85 lakh workers (12.34%) from Bihar have joined the portal.

The Centre had launched the drive to register all unorganised sector workers on August 26 aimed to create a comprehensive database of such a set of workers, and facilitate delivery of various welfare programmes and entitlements meant for them. However, of the total 6.95 crore persons registered under the portal so far, Uttar Pradesh has the second highest, after West Bengal, registration at 1,24,16,362 or 17.85% of the overall registration.

Launching e-shram on Aug-

ust 26, the Centre had said all of the 38 crore unorganised workers (as per the Economic Survey 2019-20) would be registered on the portal. It did not give any timeframe, though. Every worker registered on the portal will receive an accidental insurance cover of ₹2 lakh — ₹2 lakh on death or permanent disability and ₹1 lakh on partial disability.

Around 54.31% of the all the registered workers so far are from agriculture followed by 12.27% from construction and 8.59% are domestic & household workers. More female workers have registered than their male counterparts.

GFR rules tweaked to allow release of 75% amount stuck in construction arbitration

THE CENTRE HAS amended the General Financial Rules (GFRs), followed by the government departments and agencies, to give effect to a Cabinet decision permitting these entities to pay 75% of arbitral amount to contractors in the construction sector against bank guarantees in cases where the entities have challenged the arbitration awards. The Cabinet on August 30, 2016, and November 20, 2019, had considered the NITI Aayog proposals and approved measures for improved liquidity in the sector.

On October 7, 2021, NITI Aayog had asked the department of expenditure to incorporate decisions of the Cabinet regarding arbitration awards

under GFRs to facilitate release of funds stuck in litigation.

According to the revised GFR rules, "in cases where the ministry/department has challenged an arbitral award and, as a result, the amount of the arbitral award has not been paid, 75% of the arbitral award (which may include interest up to date of the award) shall be paid by the ministry/department to the contractor/concessionaire against a bank guarantee (BG). The BG shall only be for the said 75% of the arbitral award as above and not for the interest which may become payable to the ministry/department should the subsequent court order require refund of the said amount."

Further, it said the payment may be made into a designated Escrow Account with the stipu-



and the ministry/department.

If otherwise eligible and subject to contractual provisions, retention money and other amounts withheld may also be released against BG.

Challenge of the award, in most cases, defers the payment of the arbitral award pending the decision in challenge/appeal, which process then takes years to attain finality. This is seen to cause severe liquidity constraints in the construction sector as the large sums of money raised by contractors/concessionaires for execution of projects get blocked — stressing their balance sheets. The foregoing then causes a ripple effect throughout the financial ecosystem — directly impacting the repayment of debt to lenders, leading to increasing non-performing assets.

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CWC moves SC against Adani Ports SEZ

STATE-RUN CENTRAL WAREHOUSING Corporation (CWC) has moved the Supreme Court alleging that Adani Ports Special Economic Zone (APSEZ) has misrepresented the authorities so as to take away its 34 acre allegedly adjacent to latter's Mundra Port in Gujarat.

In its appeal, CWC, which is operating a warehouse comprising of two godowns with a total capacity of 66,000 MTs at the 34-acre plot, has challenged the unlawful inclusion of its land in the SEZ area. It has challenged the Gujarat HC Division Bench's order that asked to CWC to obtain approval or a waiver as a SEZ compliant unit from the competent authority in respect of its warehouse facility situated in 34 acre in question within SEZ Area developed by APSEZ. In case, CWC failed to get such approval within three months, the APSEZ was directed to acquire the land of the same size outside SEZ area for the construction of a warehouse facility within one year. The HC had also asked CWC to vacate and give possession of its existing warehousing facility and the land within three months after a new alternative arrangement was made by the APSEZ.

A Bench led by Justice BR Gavai while seeking response from

the ministry of consumer affairs, food and public distribution, APSEZ and others asked the parties to amicably settle the issue. Earlier attempts to amicably settle the row had failed as CWC had raised apprehensions that the alternative plot offered by APSEZ outside the SEZ was around 25 kms from its present godown was unsuitable and would cause considerable loss to its business. "Any loss from shifting to such alternative location would ultimately be borne by the public exchequer," it said.

Alleging that the HC has imposed "completely unreasonable and unconscionable conditions" which are bound to cause considerable loss to the public exchequer, CWC said that has been left at the mercy of APSEZ and the option to apply to the

Development Commissioner, APSEZ, is also likely to result only in a paper exercise since the department of commerce had already taken the view that there is no permissibility of denotification/partial notification of any area from the APSEZ.

"In an entirely impermissible manner, the HC has foisted unreasonable conditions on CWC, effectively compelling CWC to shift out of the SEZ area, for no fault of its own and only on account of the misrepresentation and unlawful application filed by APSEZ in contravention of the SEZ Rules, 2006," the petition stated.

"Even in other cases, similar notifications for exclusion/deletion of parcels of land from the notified SEZ area have been issued by the department of commerce. For instance, it had in October 2013, at the instance of RIL, de-notified an area of 708.13 hectares from its notified SEZ of RIL at Jamnagar in Gujarat, the petition stated.

CWC, which has been providing its warehouse for storage of food grains of Food Corporation of India and notified commodities such as cotton bales purchased by Cotton Corporation of India at MSP, etc, said that the land was leased to it in June 2004 by Gujarat Adani Ports and it had spent huge money to develop the land and its adjoining areas.

Borrowing cost for states falls sharply to 6.81%

AFTER SPIKING TO a record 7.02% last week, the borrowing cost for the states has declined sharply to 6.81% at the weekly auctions held on Tuesday, mainly because they raised shorter tenor funds and 37% less than notified.

Last week, the cost of debt for three states had peaked to the highest this fiscal at 7.02%, up 12 bps over the previous week, despite most of the notified states drawing down less or not participating in the auctions.

According to Ica and CARE Ratings, the reason for the lower cut-off at 6.81% was driven by the cut in the central excise duty and VAT by some states on petrol and diesel but left the spread between the 10-year G-secs and state debt widened to 64 bps from 61 bps last week, as the duty cut will cushion the inflation. The ₹17,000-crore GST aid was another reason for the lesser appetite for funds. Also, the share of the 10-year state bonds in total issuance in Q3 fell to 44% from 52% in Q2, leading to the massive drop in the cut-off. As a result, the weighted average cut-off decreased by 21 bps to 6.81%, led by a decline in cut-offs across tenors.

China challenge

The Pentagon's latest annual report to the US Congress on China contains a disquieting piece of information (and a satellite image) for India. It brings to light the building of a 100-home civilian village with the potential to double up as a military camp in a disputed region in Arunachal Pradesh. The report considers the so-called village as part of

'incremental and tactical' actions taken by China to lay claim to some areas along the LAC as its own. It is significant that China is turning more and more assertive and aggressive despite India's alliance with the US through the Quad.

It is baffling that India is in denial when China is flexing its muscles by putting up many permanent structures in areas where there were none. India is found wanting in taking a robust and proactive approach to PLA's attempts at annexing Indian territories. It is a paradox that the Modi government claims to be strong and at

the same time turns a blind eye to the reality of Chinese encroachments. Prime Minister Narendra Modi denied Chinese intrusion and gave China a clean chit which he should not have done. The contention that we are also building roads and bridges on the border is no great comfort when we have almost given up on the demand for the restoration of the status quo ante as in April 2020.
