Chhatrapati Sambhajanagar, Aug 1 (UNI) The first Memorial Day of Prof. Prataprao Borade will be observed on August 5 at Mahatma Gandhi Mission University in Maharashtra, officials said on Thursday.

According to a statement, Ankushrao Kadam, Secretary of MGM, said that Prof. Borade was a trustee of Mahatma Gandhi Mission and the first principal of Jawaharlal Nehru Engineering College (JNEC).

He was a socialist thinker, industrialist and a professor popular among students, said Kadam, adding that MGM University would organize

several activities on the occasion.

From this year, MGM University has decided to confer the 'Principal Pratap Borade Memorial Honour' on JNEC alumni. The first honour will be conferred on acclaimed entrepreneurs, Shrikant Badve and Swapneshu Baser, Kadam said.

The award ceremony will be held on Monday at Rukmini Auditorium, MGM University. Chairman of Mahatma Gandhi Mission Kamal Kishor Kadam will be present on the occasion along with noted actor and MGM alumnus Sameer Patil who will be the chief guest of the programme, added Kadam.

NCP-AP criticises MNS for alleged attack on party MLA

Mumbai, Aug 1 (UNI) : The NCP-AP on Thursday strongly criticised Maharashtra Navnirman Sena (MNS) and its president Raj Thackeray for an alleged attack on party MLA Amol Mitkari and demanded to file a case against MNS chief.

Addressing a press conference here, NCP chief spokesperson Umesh Patil said that MNS workers allegedly tried to attack the party MLA Amol Mitkari but failed to do so and then smashed his car.

He said that an angry MNS worker smashed MLA Mitkari's car for

making a statement against Thackeray, but then the young man died.

"Such an incident should not happen to an ordinary citizen but if it happens to a member of the legislature, it is a matter of concern," he said while demanding that a case be filed against Raj Thackeray as main accused who encouraged this type of act.

He alleged that Raj Thackeray is also responsible for the death of Jai Malokar, an accused in this attack, who died of a heart attack.

The NCP-AP leader

blamed Raj Thackeray for creating a 'raada culture' in Maharashtra so the youth is more prone to unemployment.

Raj Thackeray is responsible for all this and for creating an army of unemployed youth, he alleged.

Provoking activists to carry out an attack resulting in the death of the youth is a crime of culpable homicide, he noted.

He demanded that Home Minister and Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis should immediately file such a case

as the law is the same for everyone, including Raj Thackeray.

Talking about controversial Pooja Khedkar, Patil tried to clear the picture on the issue, clarifying that Pooja Khedkar got the IAS job on the basis of bogus certificate was not correct.

Stating that an autonomous organisation like Maharashtra Public Service Commission has credibility in this country, but due to Khedkar's bogus certificate the name of this organisation has been tarnished, he added.

Take advantage of new Majhi Ladki Bahin Yojana: Dr Gorhe

Chhatrapati Sambhajanagar, Aug 1 (UNI) : Deputy Chairperson of the Maharashtra Legislative Council, Dr Nilam Gorhe, on Thursday described the launch of new Chief Minister's Majhi Ladki Bahin Yojana is meant for the honour of women empowerment and appealed women to take advantage of this scheme.

Speaking at a programme 'Chief Minister: Majhi Ladki Bahin Samman Yatra' organised in Paithan town of the district, she said that under this scheme, an amount of Rs 1,500 will be deposited by the state government in the accounts of the beneficiaries every month.

She further said that this scheme will benefit

women just as other successful schemes like 'Anandacha Shidha' and half-ticket travel in State Transport buses.

She appealed women to register for the Ladki Bahin Yojana in their villages to avail facility of this scheme.

Dr Gorhe said that on behalf of the government, health camps will be organised for women at the taluka level.

She announced that the Mahila Asmita Bhawan will be set up in Paithan taluka, where facilities for sports, recreation, library and self-help group meetings for women will be provided in this building.

Suspend responsible officer if traffic on Mumbai-Nashik Highway is not smooth : Pawar

Mumbai, Aug 1 (UNI) : Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar on Thursday directed Additional Chief Secretary of the Public Works Department to suspend the responsible officer if the vehicular traffic on the Mumbai-Nashik Highway is not smooth in the next 10 days.

Pawar said necessary measures should be taken on a war footing to relieve the citizens from the traffic jams caused by potholes along with works like subways and flyovers on the Mumbai-Nashik highway.

He said all kind of financial assistance required for this will be provided by the state government.

An official statement said a meeting was held under the chairmanship of Pawar in his committee room in Mantralaya regarding the improvement of Mumbai-Nashik highway.

Food and Civil Supplies Minister Chhagan Bhujbal, MLA Raees Shaikh, Additional Chief Secretary Planning Department Rajagopal Deora, Additional Chief Secretary Finance Department O.P. Gupta along with senior officials of the concerned department participated

through virtual mode.

The Mumbai-Nashik Highway is an important and major route connecting North Maharashtra with the state capital.

There is a huge vehicular traffic on this highway. At present, flyover works are underway at Asangaon, Washind and some other places on this highway. There are potholes on the highway due to rain. It is causing a lot of trouble to the motorists and the travel time between Nashik and Mumbai is taking 8 to 10 hours.

Passengers are taking more than double time for a distance of three hours, and they are facing financial and mental hardships, this is very serious and this highway needs to be repaired on a war footing. If the potholes on the highway are filled in time, the speed of the vehicles can be increased and time can be saved, said the Deputy CM. However, he said, it can be seen that the contractor of this highway has made mistakes. Officials of National Highways Authority, People's Representatives should conduct joint inspection and make videos of roads with potholes through drones.
