Poco F3 GT: Everything, plus a gaming twist

The Xiaomi offshoot brings on the next mid-range all-rounder and it's ready to play

t seems a long time ago since Xiaomi spun off the Poco brand. In actual fact, it was only in August 2018 that the F1 was launched, but in smartphone years, Poco fans have had a rather long wait for the next phone in the F line-up. There was an F2 but it wasn't the affordable formula that Indian users have come to expect, so it wasn't launched here. Now. we have the Poco F3 and that is quite an affordable package starting at ₹ 26,499 and is also distinctive in several

Muscular and heavy This time, the new F series

phone has a gaming twist to it. The design signals this straight off. The back on the carefully styled F3 GT is in a smooth matte finish with interesting lines and accents, including around the camera lenses paired with a notification lightt. It looks muscular and heavy duty without being in-your-face about it. There's Gorilla Glass 5 on the back and front — and a metal fram-

This device looks quite well built and premium, with a design that's distinctive without being flashy - at least not in its more subtle black colour-way. You could use it without a case but it is

also little heavy so isn't difficult for it to slip. Our review unit is the Predator Black, which suits it very well. The other colour is Gunmetal Silver which I haven't seen in person. What's

The F3 GT has a 6.67-inch Full HDR+ screen with the bezels all around optimised for gaming and a little dot in the centre for the front camera. Perhaps this should have been top left so it doesn't come into view while gaming, but it's small enough not to be a bother. The screen has a 120Hz refresh rate which should improve the gaming experience. The display is otherwise very nice and bright

(1,300 nits at peak) and supports HDR10+. The chipset used here is the MediaTek Dimensity 1200, quite the flavour of the month right now. It's perfectly fine for practiceverything. Some gamers report that the device gets stressed with the heavier processor-intensive games. Not being into any-

thing but the lightest games, this isn't something tested. The processor has choice of

three RAM and storage configurations - or rather, you do. The RAM used is LP-DDR4X and storage is UFS 3.1.

On top of Android 11, Xiaomi's MIUI 12.5.2 is optimised for the Poco brand. There's almost no bloatware, though there's a Cleaner app I would be highly wary of and the in-evitable and annoying Get-

Apps which must be tamed right away. This phone has a big 5,065mAh battery with 67W fast charging, more than any phone in India right now. It's not just a lot of battery power but also well-optimhandled to give batterv long life. There are lots of other things that show attention to detail has been paid.

sensor is on the power button - something I actually always welcome. There's IP53, dust and splash protection. It has JBLtuned stereo speakers and support for lots of formats. It's also a 5G phone supporting two bands. So a bit of an

Camera features

The main camera is a 64MP and with it we have an 8MP ultra-wide and a 2MP macro. The front camera is a 16MP. The cameras are fine. You get somewhat saturated images, although many like it that way. There's also some oversharpening which makes an image look artificial. One wouldn't recommend buying the F3 GT for the cameras but for all the other hardware chops together at the reasonable prices offered.

Realme Buds 2 Wireless: Noise cancellation on a tight budget

Shutting out the world is the strength of these comfy, inexpensive earphones

y the name you would think the Realme Buds 2 Wireless is a set of earbuds. That isn't the case. It's a neckband style set of earphones, not a hundred per cent wireless but of course with cables connecting the earbuds to the neckband. It's a familiar enough type of product but one that we are tending to cover less frequently as they tend to be so very similar, specially at the low pricepoint at which they can be bought.

The Buds 2 (as we'll call them for this review) cost just ₹ 2,299 and we might have skipped them except for the fact that they offer a few really nice things for their price.

But let's start from the beginning – what do they look like?

Sturdy and comfortable The Buds 2 neck-

band comes in a 'base' grey and a yellow-and-black. The one with yellow cables and black everything else is bound to be more funky and interesting, but the grey has its own charm.

The material used is some and is really quite classy. Neckbands flan tend to look every bit as cheap as they are, but this one doesn't. It's very sturdyfeeling and don't look like they'll damage easily, even the cables. They grey could get a little dirty though, so keep them or yourself clean!

These buds will work with any phone, not necessarily a Realme. It's comfortable to wear and very light. The only problem I have with them is that the cables tend to fluff up around my face and are always in my peripheral vision, sometimes in the way, sometimes tickling my face — not a

welcome intrusion, must say. The buds look big, but fit very comfortably. I didn't feel I needed to change the soft ear-tips for another size. The back of the earbuds are magnetic and snap together to turn the music off, which starts up again when you separate the buds.

As you don the neckband, the right side has a remote with three buttons. The other side, evening it out, is the battery. To map the buttons to their actions, you need to download the Realme Link app. Open it up and you'll find various settings you can make. The first of these is for noise cancellation, the most impressive aspect of these buds. You can choose full

ANC, transparency mode sort of softer synthetics or just normal, which is nothing in particular. The moment you wear these, noise of everything around you, the whir of a fan, the hum of various machines, the general consistent white noise of life around, becomes suppressed. This is not just from the seal of the buds, but their actual cancellation.

If you enjoy closing yourself in a bit and tuning out the world, these do a surprisingly good job. I did stop a moment to think back on how at one time, Bose was the only brand we thought could man-

age noise cancellation. And Bose products, which we barely see anymore, used to cost the earth. Well, for just ₹2,299 you can now actually have quite a degree of noise

regardless. The codecs supported include AAC, SBC and Sony's LDAC. You can map the but-

tons via the app, turn on game mode and choose to auto answer calls. Phone calls sound fine with these earbuds. The app has quite a bit more than similar ones do, actually. Connectivity is through

Bluetooth 5.0. The connect is held quite well and doesn't give problems beyond the expected. This product has IPX5 water

resistance. A splash or two won't hurt. Battery life is good enough and there's quick charging to top it up in any case.

During the guarter ended September 30, 2020, the Company has completed the initial accounting at fair value at the acquisition date and thus the comparative information for the quarte ended June 30, 2020 has been revised.

The Company has considered the possible effects that may arise out of the still unfolding COVID-19 pandemic on the Company operations and the carrying amounts of property, plant & equipment, intangible assets, investments, inventories, trade receivables, etc. For this purpose, the Company has considered internal and external sources of information up to the date of approval of the Standalone and Consolidated Financial Results. Based on the current estimates, the Company does not expect any significant impact on such carrying values. The impact of COVID-19 on the Company's Standalone and Consolidated financial statements may

differ from that estimated as at the date of approval of the Standalone and Consolidated Financial Results. Ellenbarrie to invest ₹250 crore in AP plant

Kolkata, August 11 Promoters of Ellenbarrie Industrial Gases Ltd, an integrated industrial and medical gases company, have re-acquired 51 per cent stake for an undisclosed sum from Air Water Inc, a Japanese industrial gases conglomerate.

The company, which has witnessed a surge in demand for medical gases in the wake of the pandemic, is investing ₹250 crore to set up a 600 tonne per day capacity plant at Kurnool in Andhra Pradesh for producing oxygen, nitrogen and argon.

The company claims to be currently debt-free.

Its existing production facilities are located at Kalyani, Uluberia, Kharagpur and Panagarh in West Bengal; at Visakhapatnam in Telangana; and Hyderabad in Andhra Pradesh.

Ellenbarrie, which clocked a turnover of ₹250 crore in FY-21, is expecting to double its turnover to ₹500 crore in the next two years.
