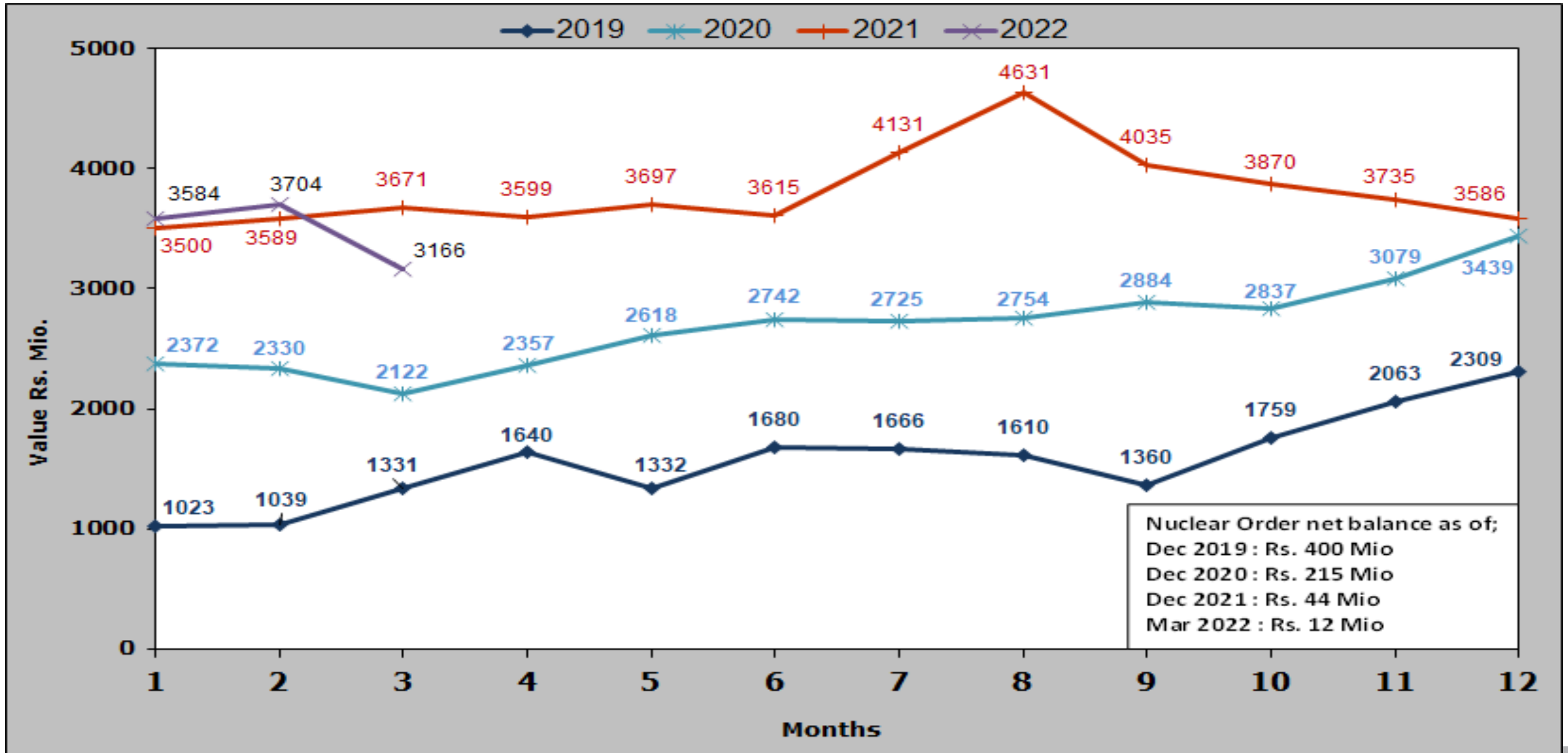

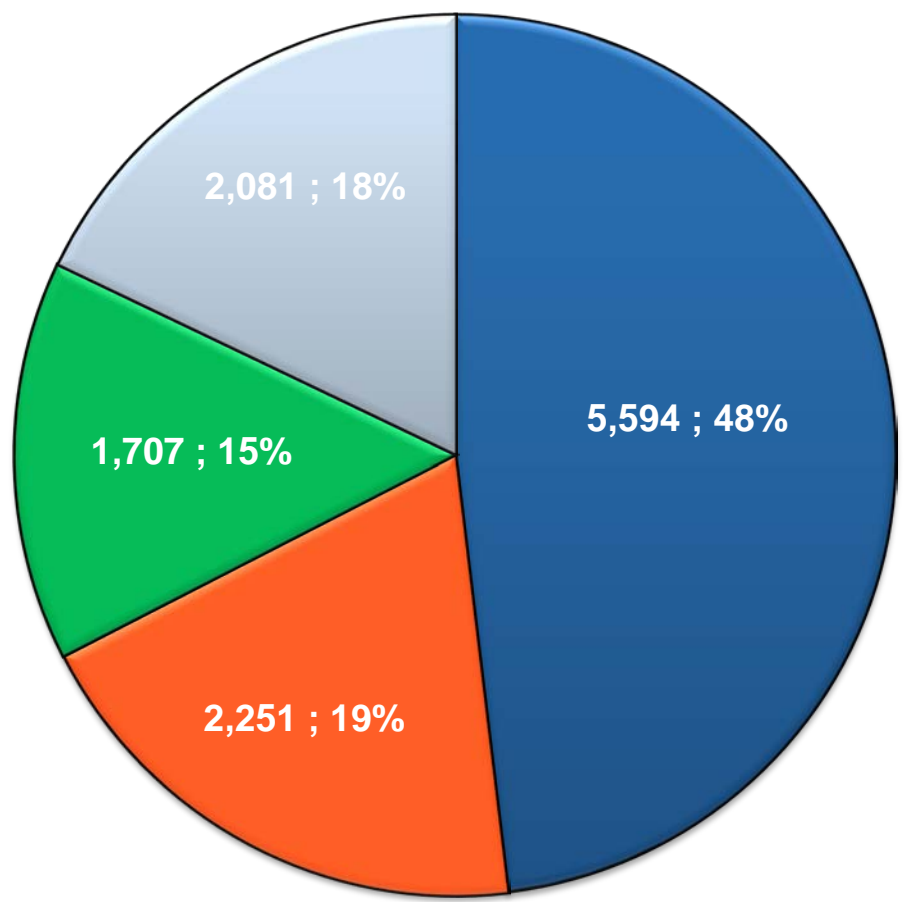
7. Net Financial Position – as on 10th May, 2022



8. Sales Turnover : Distribution of Domestic Business

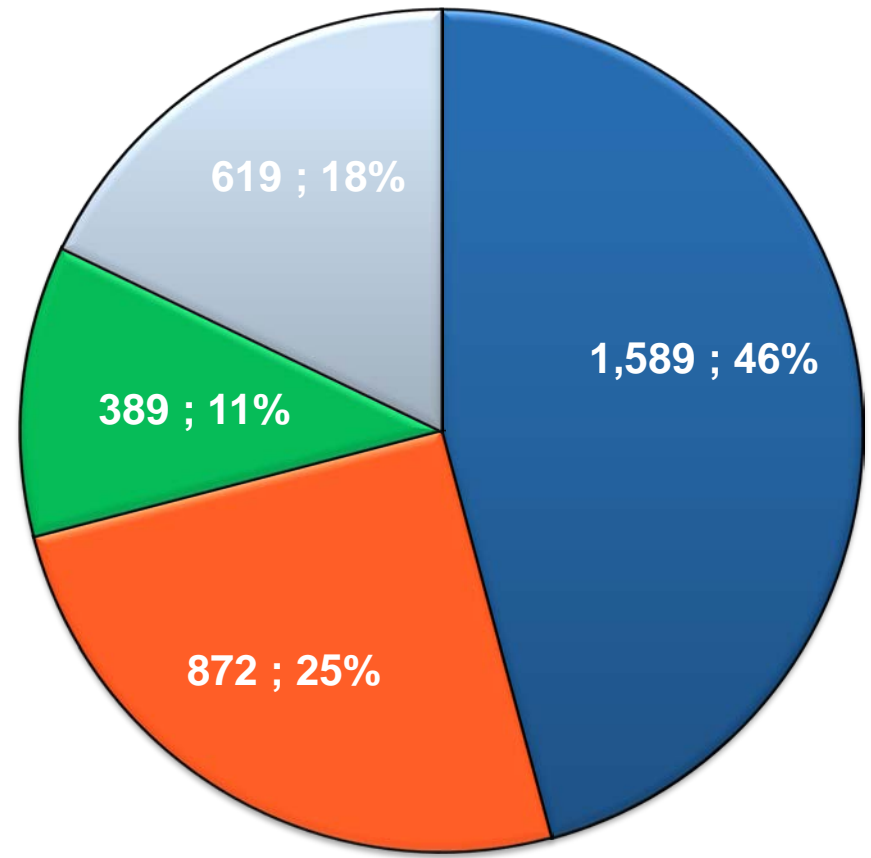

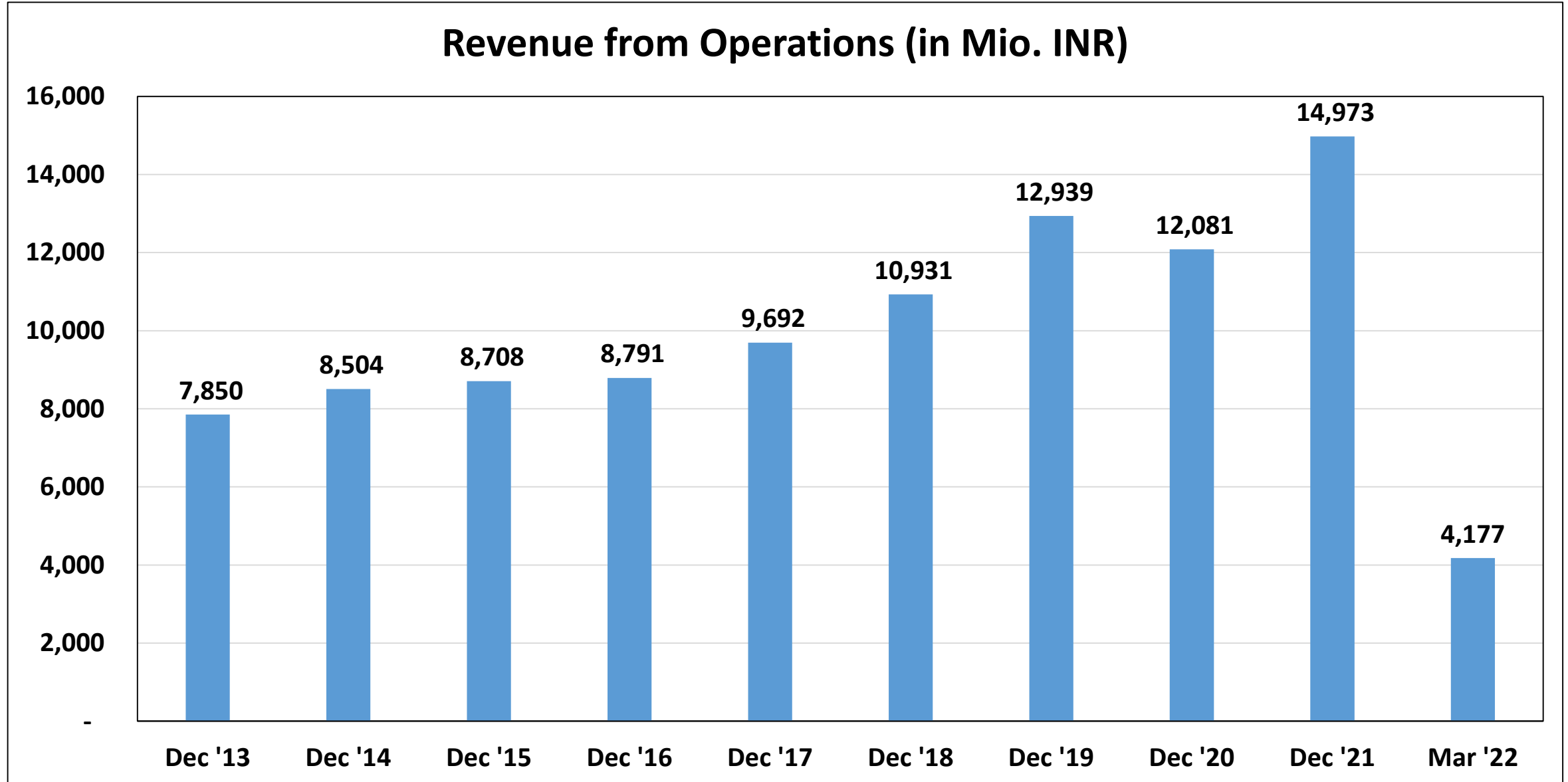

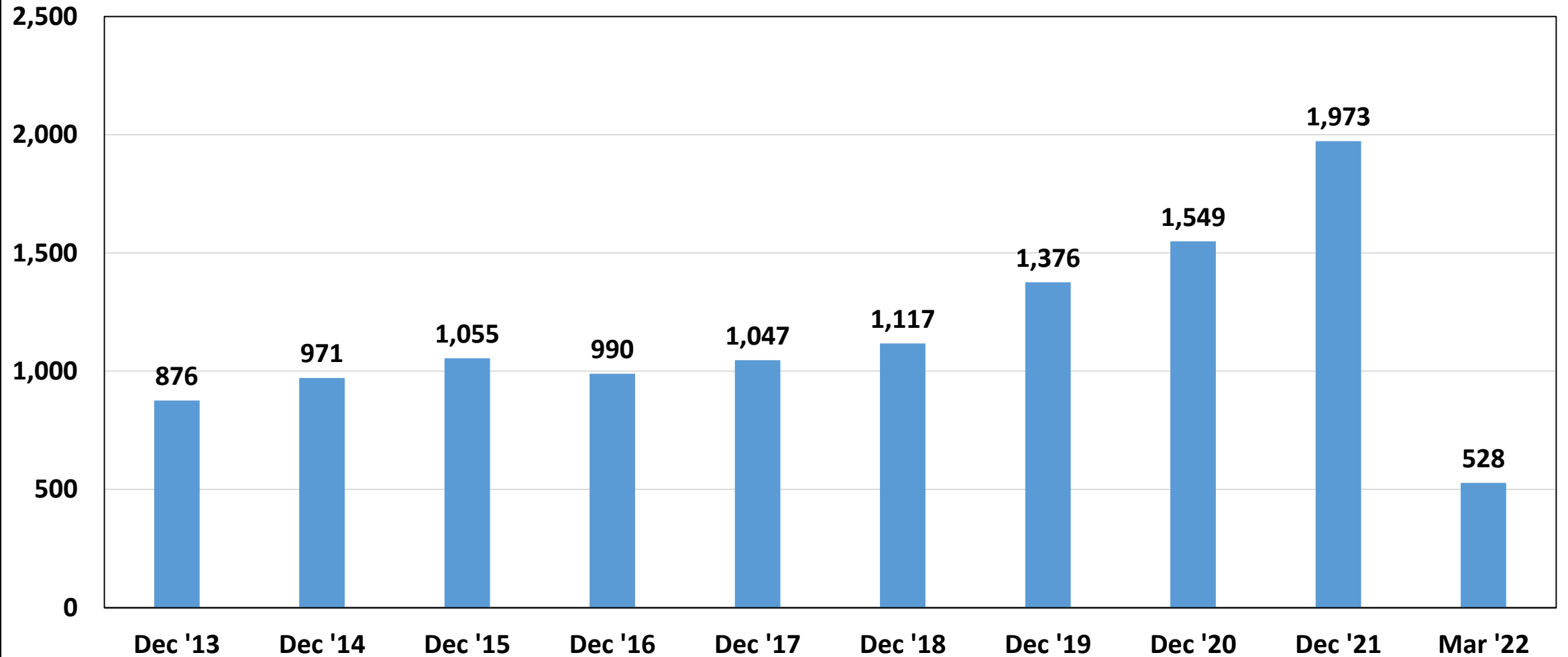

11. Revenue Trend



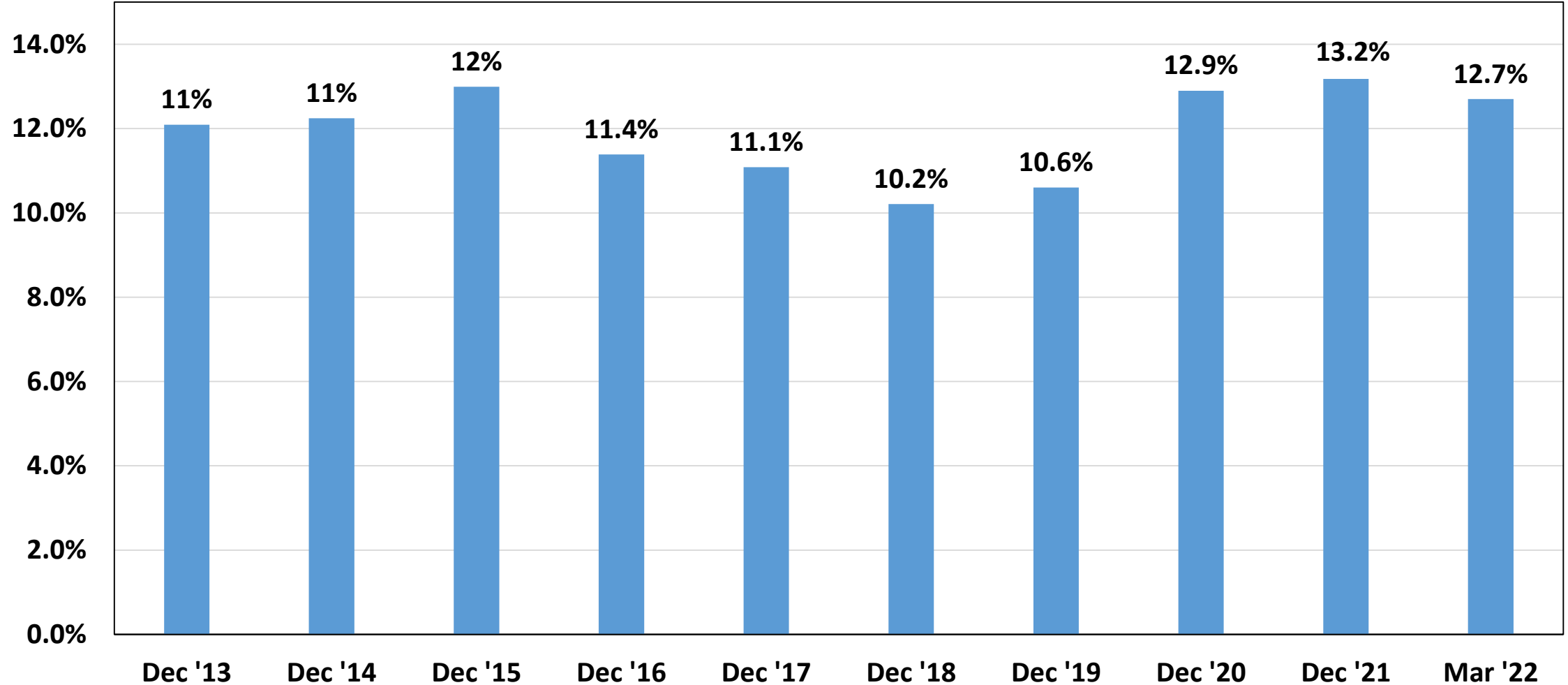
12. Profit & Loss Trend

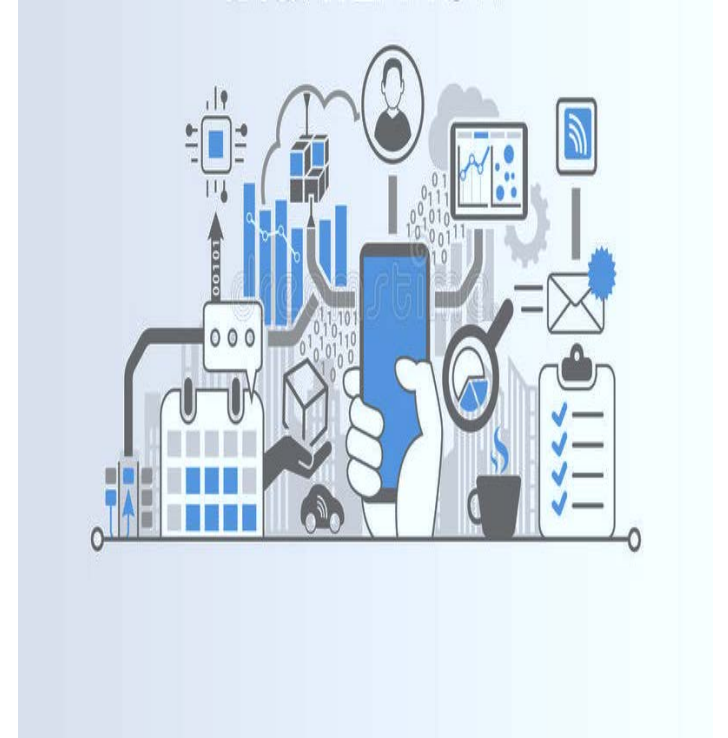

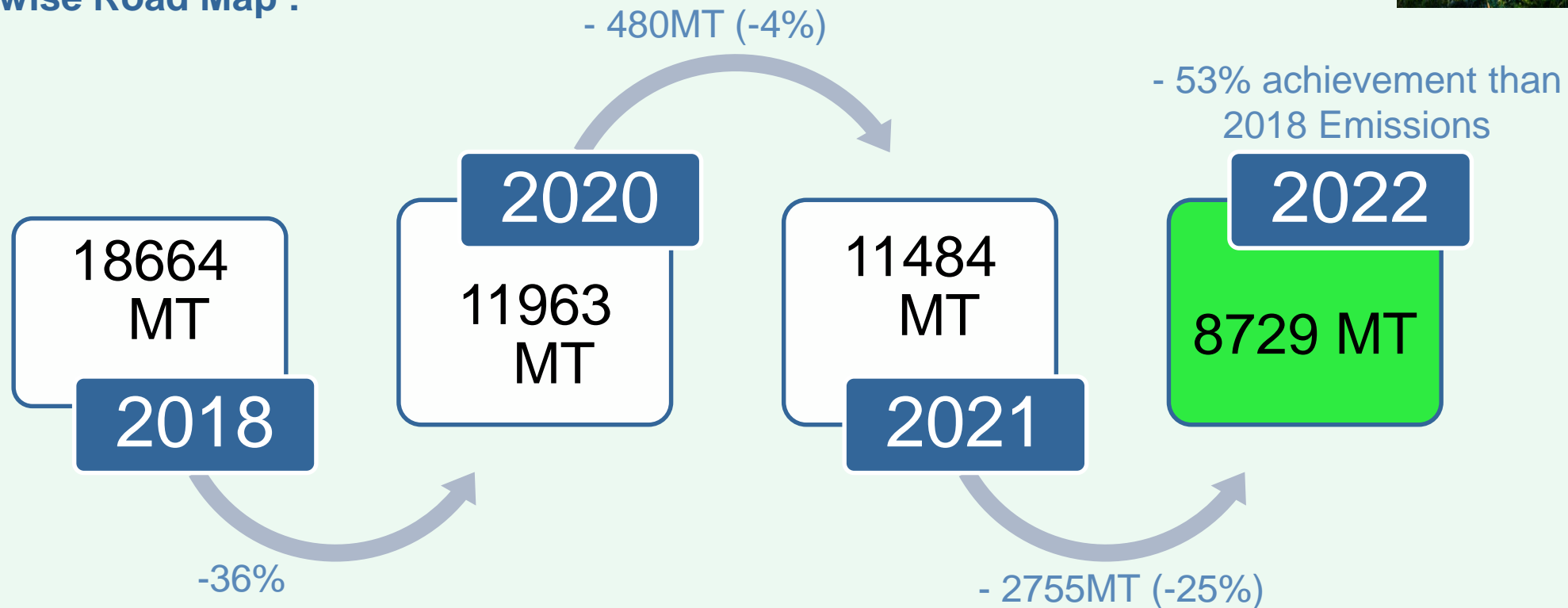

KSB net rises 25.91%

PUMPS AND VALVES maker KSB has reported a 25.91% year-on-year rise in net profit to ₹37.90 crore while sales rose 20.19% YoY to ₹444.60 crore during the December '21 quarter.

The company has seen a rise in demand for its pumps and valves from cement, steel, paper and distillery companies. Rajiv Jain, MD, KSB, and regional executive officer, KSB West Asia, said the market recovery had begun in the second half of 2021 and continues to date. Record orders were seen in January '22 and February '22, he said.

KSB plants were now operating with the entire workforce

back at work and this had boosted output, he said. Growth was seen in both domestic and export markets. Exports account for around 20% of the KSB revenues.

Aspart in orders was seen for flue gas desulphurisation (FGD) systems, which require slurry recirculation pumps. This demand was driven by the government mandate for reduction of sulphur content in the flue gas emission by 30-35% from the 2005 level by 2030. KSB has already bagged total orders worth ₹100 crore from National Thermal Power Corporation for the supply of giant slurry recirculation pumps in FGD plants to be installed across ten NTPC sites in India.

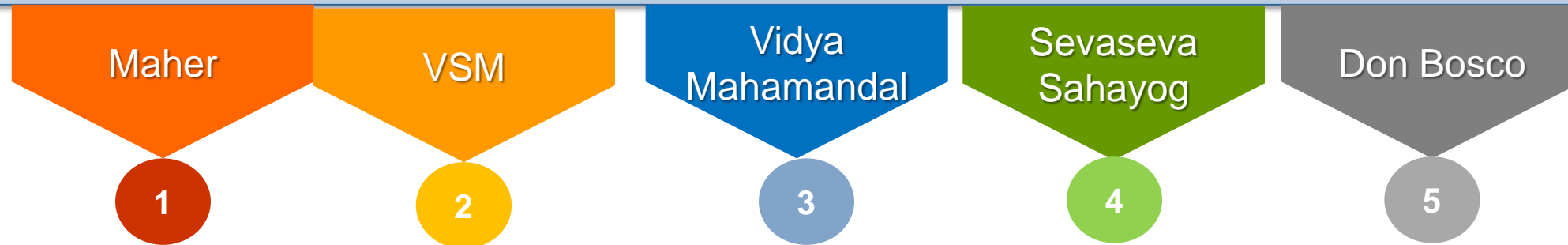

Update on Cyber attack:

Subsequent to the quarter ended March 31, 2022, the Company was informed by the parent entity, KSB SE & Co. KGaA, that the parent entity has encountered a cyber-attack on their IT systems in Germany. The Company's IT systems and infrastructure is part of the aforesaid IT systems. As an immediate measure, the parent entity had temporarily shut down all actual or potentially affected IT systems in a controlled manner for security reasons which led to temporary disruption in some of the Company's business services. The Company has put in place alternative control mechanisms in the temporary absence of the said systems. After taking all the possible necessary measures, the Company is in the process of restoring the said systems in a phased manner. Based on the preliminary assessment carried out (with the assistance of external specialist consultants) there is no impact on the interim financial information of the Company for the quarter ended March 31, 2022. Investigations are still on-going at the parent entity level.
