Further to our intimations dated December 5, 2023, regarding temporary disruptions of operations at the Company's factory located at 97/1, 98/1 & 99/1, Rauthu Suramala (V), Thottambedu (M), District – Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh, PIN-517642 due to Cyclone Michaung, we wish to inform you that the impact of the cyclone has been brought under control.
