Bengal's ginger farmers reap profit as sales shoot during Covid-19 pandemic

Siliguri, Ginger growers in West Bengal's northern districts are reaping profits even as the local economy is hit by the lockdown with people buying more driven by the belief that the plant increases immunity against the coronavirus disease (Covid-19). In places like Siliguri, the biggest city in north Bengal, Jalpaiguri, Darjeeling, Cooch Behar and other parts, the sale of ginger has gone up over the last two months, with prices in wholesale and retail markets increasing rapidly.

In the retail markets of Siliguri town, ginger price ranged between Rs 145 and Rs 160 a kg on Monday. "The price I got from wholesalers

in Siliguri regulated market in the last one week ranged between Rs 68 to Rs 70 a kg," Jabardan Rai, a ginger farmer from Peshok, said. "The wholesale price in Siliguri would have crossed Rs 100 a kg had there been no restriction on movement of people. The big buyers from Delhi and Mumbai are not coming," Rai said. Raju Saha, a retail vegetable seller at Siliguri's Champasari market, said his sales have more than doubled in recent weeks.

"The demand has been on the rise and will rise further along with the price. At least 60,000 kg is sold every day," Haridwar Singh, a commission agent at the regulated market, said. Sunita Agarwal, a

Rajasthan HC rejects plea on BSP MLAs' merger



Jaipur, The Rajasthan high court on Monday disposed of a petition by a Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) legislator who questioned speaker CP Joshi's alleged inaction over the merger of all six Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP) MLAs in the state with the Congress last year. The decision came hours after the speaker upheld the merger while responding to the complaint by BJP leader Madan Dilawar filed in March, according to the lawmaker. Dilawar's petition in the HC sought a direction to the speaker to act on his complaint. The move is a

boost for the Ashok Gehlot led government which retains its tenuous majority in the house even as it fights a legal battle concerning the disqualification of a rebel group of 19 Congress lawmakers led by former deputy chief minister Sachin Pilot. In his petition filed in the HC on Friday, Dilawar said the speaker declared the six BSP MLAs — Sandeep Yadav (Tijara), Wajib Ali (Nagar), Deepchand Kheria (Kisangarh Bas), Lakhaneena (Karauli) and Rajendra Gudha (Udaipurwati) — as having merged with the Congress on September 18,

lawmakers merged their party with the Congress in the House. Earlier, Dilawar, the MLA from Ramganj Mandi constituency in Kota district, petitioned the speaker on March 16, seeking disqualification of the BSP MLAs under the 10th schedule of the Constitution (anti-defection laws). The speaker did not decide on the petition until Monday.

Around noon on Monday, Dilawar staged a sit-in at the office of the assembly secretary, PK Mathur. "The secretary told me that my petition had been dismissed. He told me that a detailed order will be provided on email. I am waiting for that," Dilawar said. Later in the day, a single-member bench of Justice Mahendra Kumar Goyal disposed of Dilawar's petition as the speaker had already decided on the MLAs' complaint. State BSP president Bhagwan Singh Baba said the state unit will inform party chief Mayawati about the court's decision. "The party high command will decide the further strategy," he said. At the time of the merger in 2019, Mayawati accused Rajasthan chief minister Ashok Gehlot of horse-trading. In 2008, too, six BSP

Online 'Qurbani Ke Bakrey' drums up sales on wheels

Lucknow, With open goat markets not functioning due to the Covid pandemic, Pashu Bazaar -- a dedicated website for selling goats from the Goat Trust -- has come up with a unique way of advertising its business. The Pashu Bazaar has sent out a couple of e-rickshaws with 'Qurbani Ke Bakrey' posters on them and their staff in the e-rickshaws, besides distributing pamphlets and rate list of their product, also deliver the goats at the door steps of people who have placed orders online.

For the past few weeks, these e-rickshaws have been doing the rounds of various parts of the city -- especially the Muslim dominated areas of Lucknow. They are inviting Muslims to buy 'certified' goats for Bakrid sacrifice.

guidance of the prime minister, is rapidly ramping up Covid-19 tests. On July 26, 1,06,000 COVID-19 tests were done in Uttar Pradesh as against just 72 on March 23. Tests are being done in the state via the RT-PCR, TrueNat and antigen-based techniques," he stated. He said at present, 40,000 RT-PCR tests are being done daily in the state, while 56,000 are done by the rapid antigen-based technique and 10,000 by TrueNat technique. He said technicians are also being trained continuously with the help of Indian Council for Medical Research (ICMR) and King George Medical University (KGMU) to ensure quality in tests. He also thanked PM Modi for providing through the ICMR a COBAS machine to Moti Lal Nehru (MLN) Medical College in Allahabad. He said the state government had set up a Covid care fund in the wake of the pandemic outbreak. "This fund is being used to set up RT-PCR labs in every medical college and zonal headquarter of the state," the chief minister said, according to the statement. The state's Covid care fund is being used to procure COBAS machine for KGMU and SGGPI in Lucknow and BRD Medical College in Gorakhpur which will boost the testing capacities at these places, he added. Earlier, speaking at the launch, PM Modi said India is in a much better position than other countries in the fight against Covid-19 as a result of "right decisions taken at the right time" and
