Reg.: <u>Scrutinizer's Report on Postal Ballot Notice dated 19th August, 2019 pursuant to</u> <u>the provisions of Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013('the Act') read with Rule</u> <u>22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014</u>

In terms of the resolution passed by the Board of Directors of Digicontent Limited [CIN: L74999DL2017PLC322147] (hereinafter referred to as 'the Company') at its meeting held on 31st July, 2019, I have been appointed as Scrutinizer to receive, process and scrutinize the postal ballot papers and e-voting in respect of Ordinary Resolution proposed in the Postal Ballot Notice dated 19th August, 2019 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Postal Ballot Notice')

I hereby submit my report on the voting on the Ordinary Resolution proposed in the Postal Ballot Notice as under:

- 1. The Management of the Company is responsible to ensure the compliance with the requirements of (i) The Companies Act, 2013 and Rules made thereunder; and (ii) SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, relating to postal ballot voting including voting by electronic means. Our responsibility as Scrutinizer is restricted to making Scrutinizers' Report of the votes casted by the members on the resolutions contained in the above mentioned Notice, based on the reports generated from Karvy Fintech Private Limited (Karvy), the authorized agency engaged by the Company to provide remote e-voting facility for e-voting and scrutiny of physical ballot received till the time fixed for closing of voting process.
- 2. The Company completed dispatch of postal ballot notice, forms/or electronic ballot and postage prepaid business reply inland letters on 23rd August, 2019, to its Members whose name(s) appears in the Register of Members / List of beneficial owners received from NSDL/CDSL as on 16th August, 2019.





- 3. The Members of the Company had an option to vote either through the physical postal ballot form or through the e-voting facility. Members opting for e-voting facility, casted their votes on the designated website <u>www.evoting.karvy.com</u> via Karvy.
- 4. As stated in sub rule 3 of Rule 22 of Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, an advertisement was published by the Company each in 'Hindustan Times' and 'Hindustan' (English & Hindi newspaper) on Saturday, 24th August, 2019, informing about the completion of dispatch/electronic transmission of postal ballot notices, to the Members along with other related matters mentioned therein.
- 5. All Postal Ballot Forms received upto Sunday, 22nd September, 2019(5.00 P.M.) (being the last date for receipt of the Postal Ballot Forms) were considered for my scrutiny. The particulars of e-voting done by the members of the Company during the period from 9.00 A.M. (Server time) on Saturday, 24th August, 2019 till 5.00 P.M. (Server time) on Sunday, 22nd September, 2019 by logging on online e-voting site of Karvy, were considered for my scrutiny.
- 6. Particulars of all Postal Ballot Forms received by the Company including e-voting on Karvy's platform, have been entered separately in a register maintained for this purpose.
- 7. Envelopes containing Postal Ballot Forms received from the members after Sunday, 22nd September, 2019 (5.00 P.M.) have not been considered for my scrutiny.
- 8. We did not find any defaced or mutilated ballot papers, as received from the Registrar & Transfer Agent of the Company.
- 9. At the end of the e-voting period, I have unblocked the electronic votes in the presence of two witnesses not in the employment of the Company, who have signed herein below.

- 10. There were none members who have voted through e-voting as well as physical postal ballot.
- 11. The physical ballot forms received and votes cast through e-voting were matched with the Register of Members/ List of beneficial owners of the Company as on 16th August, 2019.





- 12. The votes cast through physical ballot forms received and e-voting were scrutinized by me for verification of votes cast in favour and against the resolution.
- 13. The Postal Ballots and other related papers/registers and records will be handed over to the Company Secretary for the safe custody once the Chairman/Director considers, approves and signs the Postal Ballot Minutes.
